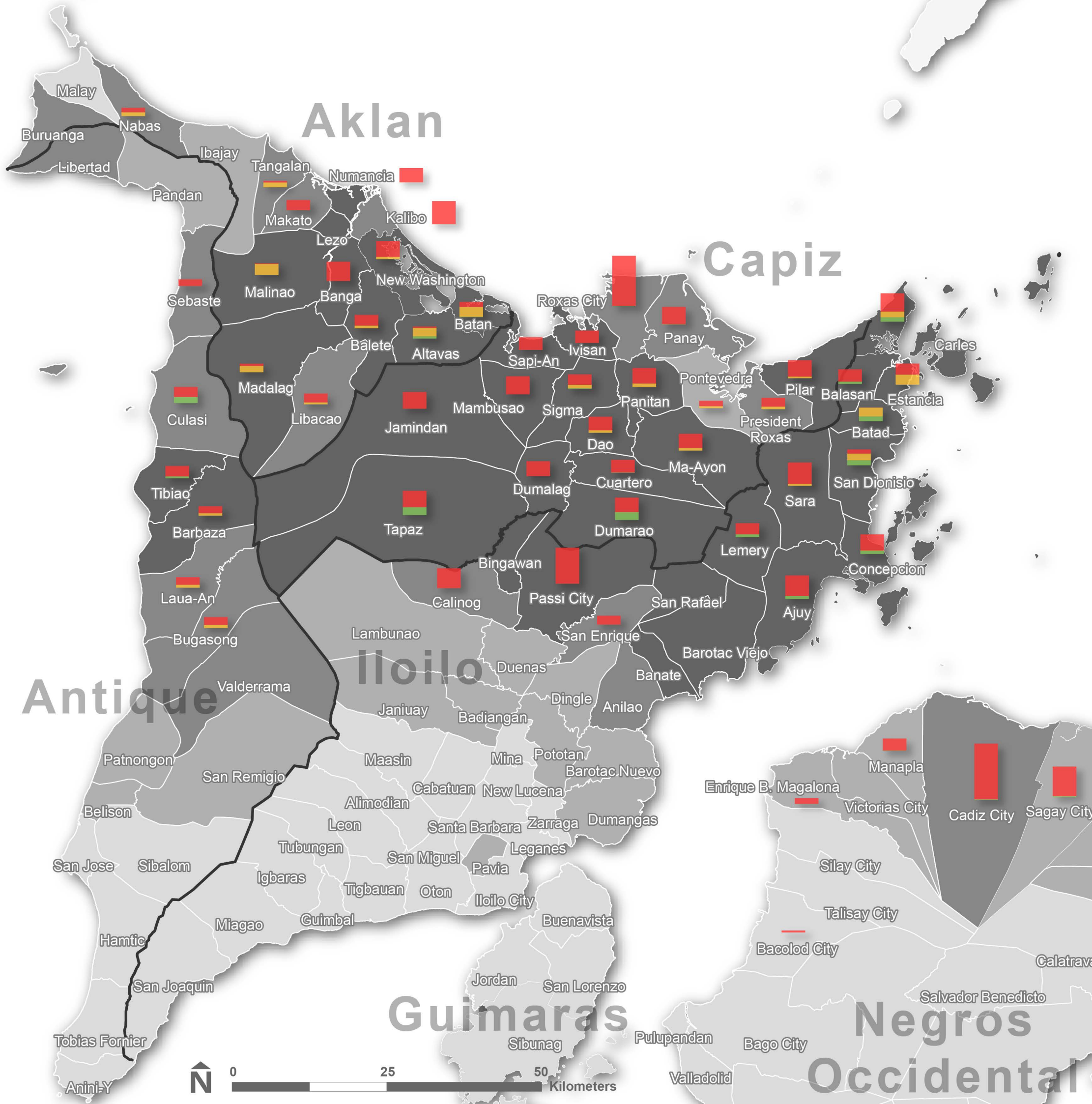


Supporting Self Recovery of Shelter in Region VI (Roxas)

Emergency shelter solutions: tarpaulins and fixings (minimum 1 per household), plastic sheeting and fixings, or tents.
