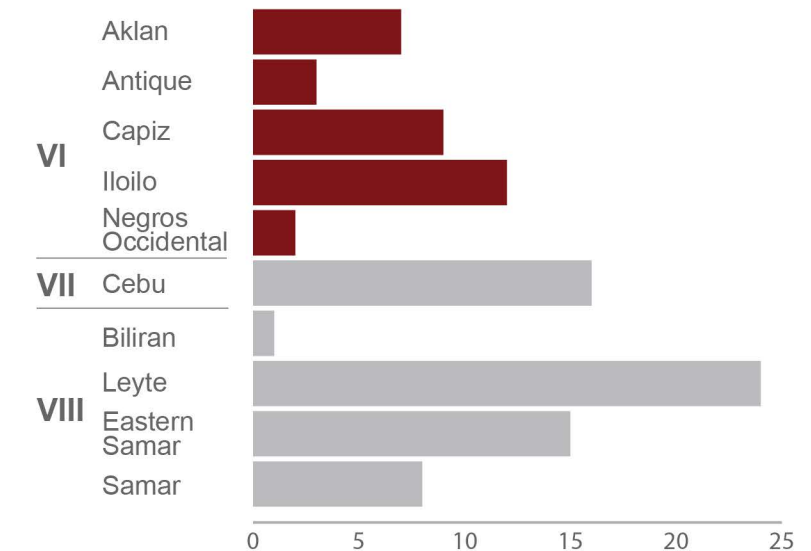
This map depicts data gathered by the Shelter Cluster about agencies who are responding to Typhoon Yolanda.

Any agency listed may have projects at different stages of completion (e.g. completed, ongoing or planned interventions).

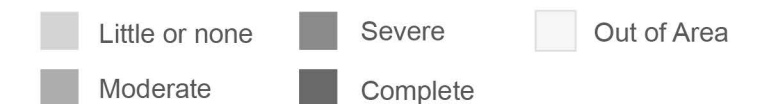

Damage density is a proxy indicator for the proportion of damage based on a 2013 projected population, estimated average household size (4.7) and estimated households damaged (DSWD).
