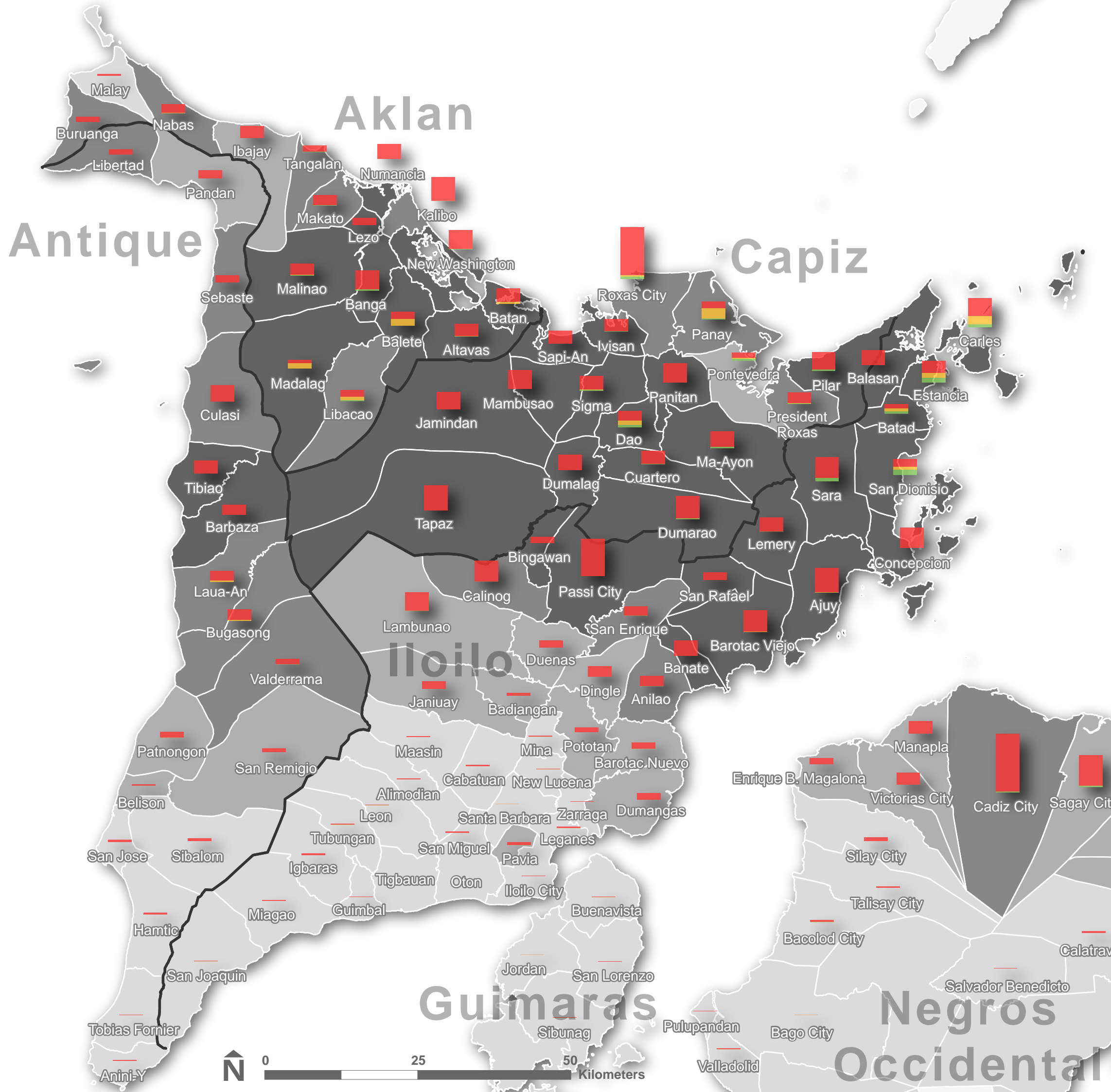
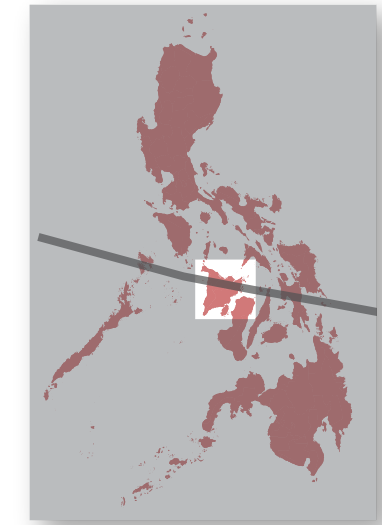


Supporting Self Recovery of Shelter in Region VI (Roxas)
