**RESOLUTION NO. 2014-12-169**

**A RESOLUTION ALLOWING RESIDENTS OF BRGY. 88, 89 AND 90, THIS CITY, TO REBUILD THEIR HOUSES ON SITE BUT OUTSIDE THE 40-METER "NO DWELLING ZONE"**

**WHEREAS**, several thousands have been made homeless in Tacloban City in the aftermath of Super Typhoon Yolanda;

**WHEREAS**, in Barangay 88, covering Costa Brava to the airport, Barangay 89, part of Baybay, and Barangay 90 in Payapay, greatly devastated by the typhoon surge, surviving residents now living in make-shift homes or tents, have expressed that humanitarian organizations are willing to help rebuild their homes on condition that they be allowed by the City;

**WHEREAS**, the City has enacted Ordinance No. 2013-12-15A, prohibiting dwelling within 40-meter from the shoreline or the "no dwelling zone" to ensure safety of the people from typhoon surges and has identified areas of Bagacay and New Kawayan, both in the north, as resettlement areas but the area is not big enough to accommodate several thousands left homeless, including residents of Barangays 88, 89 and 90;

**WHEREAS**, this Honorable Body is granting the residents of said barangays to rebuild their homes on the following conditions/comments 1.) the residents should sign an undertaking that they would vacate the area once the city government is ready to provide their permanent resettlement and, voluntarily evacuate upon the instance of the City on heightened storm warnings/typhoons 2.) that rebuilding of homes by humanitarian organizations should be expressed in a multi-party agreement, the City being one of the parties 3.) that the rebuilding of houses is outside the 40-meter "no dwelling zone" and, 4.) asking private owners to allow the rebuilding of temporary shelters in their lots;

**WHEREFORE**, on motion of Honorable Jerry S. Uy, duly seconded by all Honorable Members present, the Sangguniang Panlungsod

**RESOLVE, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED**, to allow residents of Barangays 88, 89, and 90 to rebuild their houses on site but outside the 40-meter "no dwelling zone" with the aforementioned conditions/comments;
