Introduction and comments on previous meeting minutes	<p>Following previous meeting minutes from November, the SAG discussed the need to improve sector visibility and review information products produced in addition to looking into capacity building needs as part of their work plan for 2017. Furthermore, UPO has submitted their assessment conducted in Nertiti and Golo localities in Jabal Marra which will be shared with partners.</p> <p>Lastly, the sector has once more extended an invitation to partners interested to join a given Technical Working Group, for those interested to contact Doa’a Abdel-Rahman for further details.</p>
Strategic Advisory Group	<p>The Terms of Reference (ToR) has been validated, with the work plan for 2017 to be developed. The sector asks partners to read the ToR for their reference. For the Technical working group to begin their functions in January 2017.</p>
Multi-year Humanitarian Response Plan	<p>A mid-year review of sector achievements was completed and shared with partners (see attachment for reference).</p> <p>In preparation for the multi-year work plan, significant consultations took place at the HCT level and with respective counterparts – HAC, to draft the strategy and strategic objectives. Planning for the multi-year Humanitarian Response Plan (HRP) has been extended by the government for the time and both the 2016 HRP and Humanitarian Needs Overview have been rolled over at the request of the Government. Note, there is little difference in beneficiary figures in numbers of refugees, returnees and protracted IDPs. The HNO narrative will be the same, and will be reviewed at a later stage.</p>
field prioritization for	<p>The SHF prioritization for 2017 was conducted at all the field levels</p>

<p>2017 SHF allocation</p>	<p>at the the sector level and area-ISCG level. The area prioritised was only in South Darfur (Kass and Gereida localities), and West Darfur (Kerenik, Geneina and Beida localities).</p> <p>The Sector coordinator reiterated the need to ensure that response for new displacement is given priorities especially to National NGOs as frontline responders.</p> <p>Partners identified the following localities to be included:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. South Darfur –Shattaya locality has a high number of returnees who are in need of assistance. IN addition to Otash and Kalma IDP c amps which have a large load of protracted IDPs. 2. Kordofans and Blue Nile states: the sector has not responded to NFI needs of IDPS but should prioritise the location as there are partners who can conduct the distributions and monitoring. (Kordofans partners: IOM, Hamam al Salam, and AORD, Ahlam Elsigar, Hamam El Salam – Blue Nile: Jasmar, AORD, Labena, and ADRA). <p style="text-align: center;">***</p> <p>Action point:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. For the Sector Coordinator to redraft the prioritization list to reflect other location added and circulate to partners.
<p>Sector Updates: Security/ population movements /assessments / response</p>	<p>The Sector Coordinator requested that implementing partners provided an update on the Security and Population movement. Comments were as follows;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • IOM: Distributions of communal shelter was conducted in Sortony – Kabkabiya Locality and bongo camp - Tawilla in North Darfur. Furthermore, a rapid assessment is planned for South Kordofan, with an aim to distribute some 1,500 NFI kits. Lastly, IOM completed registration and verification of new arrivals, IDP, returnees in Um Dukhun locality in Central Darfur - covering ten villages. The mission report will be shared. Another mission is planned for Sudanese in South Kordofan. • NCA: Emergency shelter was distributed to 350 HH in Nertiti in central Darfur, in complementarity to NFIs distributed by the Danish Refugee Council. • SAG: some 200 emergency shelter are planned to be constructed for vulnerable households in three villages in Um Barru after need assessment that was conducted. • Hamam Al-salaam: National NGO operates in west Kordofan with other sectors with some experience in NFI distribution during the flood seasons in Khartoum and the Kordofans. • SORC: SH funded project in Nertiti has been completed. • AORD: update about movement, some 2,000 IDPs people have moved from Adham locality to Tadamun locality. The locality also hosts refugees from South Sudan. • UPO: An assessment was constructed in East Darfur three month ago where 1,400 people were identified to be in need of NFIs in Sheira and Edain, the request for items from the core

	<p>pipeline is still pending. Secondly, 200 shelter materials have been distributed for protracted IDPs in these localities. Lastly, an assessment was conducted with HAC, and line ministries in Nertiti Central Darfur. NFIs were prioritized among other sectors, with around 400 households currently seeking refuge in schools in both Nertiti and Tur.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • ADRA: no updates. • Ahlam ElSigar: NFIs were distributed in November in Nevasha to South Sudanese in Khartoum, in addition to distributions (from organizations stock) in Babanosa, Muglad and Meram in West Kordofan. • Labena: some 1,500 households received some 250 blankets and plastic sheets, in Golo in East Jabal Marra in September. • Sanad: Blanket and plastic sheets were distributed to some 1,050 households in Damazine, Blue Nile State. In addition to 1,000 mosquito nets in Zalengei West Darfur. • GFO: An assessment is planned in South Darfur to Shattaya locality in January. • UMCOR: Two shelter project have been completed in Kario Camp or South Sudanese refugees in East Darfur, some 900 shelters was constructed through UMCOR and completed with SHF funds for an addition 300 shelters. • TGH: <p>Discussion:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Partners commented for the need to have closer coordination at the field level to avoid overlaps in NFI distribution. Coordination in Um Dukhun locality was highlighted by partners. TGH confirmed their work in Abu Garadeel where an assessment targeted returnees and vulnerable populations. The need for the RRR section to follow-up with partners and cross-check registration and various assessment conducted by partners. <p style="text-align: center;">***</p> <p>Action point:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 2.
