- Chapuis already have a farea for shade, so elderly and sick people should be given priority to use this.
- Chiefs nakamal we will erect a shade shelter with tarps. Paul will lead this with the volunteers led by Karl

**3. Chief Zebedee Apostolic church site with 59 people have been told they have to leave the site by court order (land dispute).**

- We will request for first priority in repatriation.

**4. Tent tagging, packing and storing**

- Paul to lead tagging and packing. Spray paint has been requisitioned from Finance yesterday.
- Luke is discussing with NDMO on storage. NDMO ask that we check with Red Cross on temporary storage until a long term solution is identified .

**5. Repatriation**

- There are currently two plans for repatriation – one from Penama province and one from NDMO. Still no official decision on repatriation from National Government but Council of Ministers is meeting today so expect formal policy direction later today.
- Four SANMA PWD staff will go to Ambae will assess sites on east and west Ambae as staging points for populations that can't go immediately back to their home villages.
- We will wait until the 2pm Cluster Leads meeting today to understand more on Government policy direction for repatriation.

**6. Shelter Budget**

**7. Assistance from Further Arts in community liaison**

- Tom Dick from Further Arts (FA) reported that this is a local organisation with a number of local volunteers trained in cultural media documenting and community engagement who have assisted in identifying neglected communities in Fanafo last week. They can assist further in assessment and evaluation. They have many photos and documentation of response. They have a team going to Maewo today and

Pentecost on Saturday.

- Chair endorsed the assistance of FA and asked them to include shelter and NFI assessment in their visit to Maewo, and to liaise with Coordinator on documentation.
