4. Regional Updates – Return and the cluster response	<p>Somali Region</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Kalafo and Mustahil woredas of Shabelle zone affected by seasonal flood. Biruk [NRC] has mentioned that this flood situation come across every year. Around 2000 HHs are affected, Access is the issue because of the flash flood. Partner's Update <ul style="list-style-type: none"> IOM : Going to support 1300 HHs supported in Shabelle. Targeting done and stocks available. Last year's caseloads. In the next CCM IOM will tell us that Same people or new people. NRC : Going to distribute Cash for NFIs for additional 200 HHs in Sitti zone next week. Belg assessment will start soon. Coordination meeting will be on Monday or Tuesday. 11 zones will be covered. Focus will be on food and Agriculture cluster. Rest cluster will do the Desk review and contribute. NDRMC : Daawa zone needs support. There is a huge need but very less support. 48000 HHs in need. Bridge is open from Liben to Daawa ut due to Rainy season access will be the issue soon. ICRC : Multipurpose cash distribution in Moyale, Daawa, Somali. Supported 2500 HHs. Commercial bank used for Cash transfer. Mobile phone transfer 	Same People or New People	IOM

For rest of the HHs they have used Direct Bank Transfer through agreement with the bank.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Biruk mentioned that now is the time to respond in Hudet and asked partners to prioritize this area.○ IOM : Going to do Cash transfer in Somali region. Assessment is finalized. Will share it next week. Somali micro Finance will be potential agency for Cash Transfer. <p>West Guji – Gedee</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Cluster presented Return plan summary. Also mentioned advocacy issues and operational challenges in West Guji and Gedee.○ Gap analysis were presented and ESNFI and Shelter target and gap were presented.○ For ES/NFI 75% of total Returnees targeted and for Shelter Loss and damage report were used and those HHS took as a Rehabilitation Target. <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Partner's Update<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ UNHCR : mentioned that they have changed in the targeting strategy.○ 850 Shelters in 2 kebeles if Gedee and West Guji. 250 HHs to support in Kercha with ANE.○ IOM : 3547 HHs will be supported with ESNFI in Kercha and Gedeb Woreda○ In 2nd Phase 350 Shelter Construction in Kercha○ 1100 Kits are going to be distributed in the Returnees site in Kercha○ Will provide Cash for Shelters and also they have team of carpenters if needed.○ Christian Aid : 92 Shelters to be built in Kercha woreda in 2 Kebeles. They have issues in Targeting.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ From Gedeo zone they have shifted support to Kercha woreda. ○ Shelter design is not the same for all the partners. ○ Biruk has replied that now we have the Shelter Technical Advisor, so we will have the standard Shelter Design per region. ○ For these 92 HHs shelter, Christian aid to identify HLP issues. ○ Dawit from NDRMC mentioned that UNHCR, IOM, Christian Aid are planning to support in Kercha woreda and need to share their support areas with each other to avoid duplication. ○ GOAL : West Guji need of Tarpaulin and Gedeo zone in need of Shelter support. Shelter support needed to their original houses so no need of new design. It is just a repair Shelter support needed for burnt houses. They are not facing HLP issues. Local Market does not have capacity for Shelter Kits. ○ Dawit from NDRMC mentioned that learn from the Amhara and other regions that how to overcome with these issues. ○ Biruk has mentioned that Repair Kit package and full package need to be define. ○ Max from OCHA has mentioned that how does it fit with the Ministry of Peace standards? How many CGI sheets needed. Biruk has replied that 25 CGI sheet need for the standard shelter support. ○ Dawit asked Shelter Technical Advisor to share the TOR and then they will provide the feedback. ○ Cash Working Group has also suggested that SOP draft is in the process. It will be share once it finalized. ○ UNHCR : for 850 HHs Return package moved to Kercha. 100 Full construction package. ○ Lost & Damage assessment report will be finalized next week. Response needed immediately.○ Limited support provided in the region and it is one of the neglected areas.○ Lack of Information and Advocacy issues are noted in the areas.○ Voluntary return is also a debatable issue. <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Partners' Update<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ NDRMC : 32609 HHs in East Hararge and 8703 HHs in West Hararge are in need of the ESNFI response. NDRMC are going to cover 50% HHs and support them Plastic Sheet.○ Total 70000 Plastic sheet are going to this region. 30000 sent to East Hararge and 7000 sent to West Hararge.○ So, partners can think of Cash for NFIs.○ NDRMC will share their response planning report so partners can check and plan accordingly.○ NRC : Planning to support 2000 HHs with ESNFI and local government asked them to distribute in the 8 Woredas. So, there is a big need everywhere in the area.○ IOM : planning to distribute Cash for Rent.○ GOAL : planning to support in West Hararge from OCHA funding.
