1. Update from the Shelter Cluster on the CCCM working group (10AM DOMBE)		
<p>IOM CCCM checked one by one every resettlement site to verify which ones are the partners working in every sector in every resettlement site. There is a general lack of education, protection and health partners. Only CCCM, WASH and SHELTER are quite actives, mainly WASH. Compared with Dondo and Nhamatanda resettlement sites, IOM CCCM said Manica is much less covered.</p> <p><b>IOM CCCM is sharing on 25 August a report with the list of all the Resettlement sites and the partners actives in every sector.</b></p> <p>It is flagged that in Matarara families are sick because of the humidity on the tents.</p> <p>IOM SHELTER will do a Matarara assessment as part of the general assessment that they have just started in the 28 resettlement sites (one team composed by 10 people has been deployed in Dombe for 10 days). <b>Mucombe, Muoco and Nhamissisua, Nhahemba 2</b>, are flagged as priority for IOM SHELTER to start the assessment.</p> <p>It is flagged that some of the resettlement sites are EMPTY and they are NOT FAMILIES living there. It is raised the question to SDPI <b>“are they coming back to the resettlement site later on when the services will be provided?”</b> SDPI said that in some cases the families didn’t move because they didn’t have shelter assistance, but this needs to be clarified.</p> <p><b>SDPI Sr.Jemusse asked for the list of the places where is not families living, as he only knows about Chiruca and Muoho.</b></p> <p><b>IOM ask SDPI to provide the list of the HH that will move to each resettlement site, to cross check with the list of the partners working in the field, that claim they are much less HH really living on the resettlement sites.</b> For instance, for Mutassa, the official number seems to be 42, but they are only 18 families living there.</p> <p>SDPI informed that the “batelao” will start next week to work from Dombe Missao to Zichao and this is going to facilitate a lot the work in the communities of the other shore of the river.</p> <p><b>Chiruca, Javera, Magaro, Manhamdure, Muoco, Mutassa, Ngurue, Nhamissisua and Zibue are still now the resettlement site in the worst condition in all sectors because they are hard to reach.</b></p> <p>It is flagged that some families didn’t receive enough support as they are polygamous families with 5-6 wives, and only the man was registered as head of household. IOM SHELTER will register from now on every woman as a HH.</p>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Sussundenga district, in Posto Muoha, ( Minas Gerais + Muoha )</b> were reached by DTM, but they won't become a resettlement site. <b>Any partner can go and assess?</b></li> </ul> <p>There are affected communities in Posto Dombe outside of the resettlement sites that didn't receive any support, as the support is focused on the resettlement sites. This communities where o Wash Cluster is working are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Muriro, Mapira, Muranga, Machiri, Nanhemba 1, Muchamba, Njote and Muvoase.</b> IOM SHELTER will assess there if they still have the capacity after covering all the 28 resettlement sites. <b>Any other partners available to do assessment there?</b></li> </ul>

<p><b>4. Update on Dombe Resettlement sites.</b></p> <p>IOM continue the risk assessment and site planning on the 28 resettlement sites and will share the final report with advice about the risk of some of the resettlement sites. SDPI informed that for them all the 28 resettlement sites are safe, except Zibue, where they have some concerns.</p> <p>SAVE THE CHILDREN asked SDPI to provide an official later stating that Mechisso is not a flood prone area and they said they will do next week.</p>	<p><b>Action</b></p> <p>Follow up with CCCM and SDPI</p>	<p><b>Responsible</b></p> <p>Shelter Cluster roaming coordinator</p>
<p><b>5. Update on partners emergency projects</b></p>		
<p><b>Save the Children</b> finished distribution <b>last week in</b> Mechiso and Mutassa and they will cover in the next 2 weeks Zichao, Manhadure, Zibuia, Gurue, Chiruga, Magaro (to check if they already received from a different partner) and. Nhamisisua.</p> <p>Save the Children t were supposed to distribute 2 months ago 2 tarpaulins + toolkit + kitchen set per family from CARE material, but these distributions were delayed. It is confirmed by CARE (Melvin) that they can assist 2303 HH with 2 tarpaulins, 1 tool kit and 1 kitchen set. These materials is supposed to arrive on the next 2 weeks</p> <p>IOM SHELTER is reviewing the unmet shelter needs in the 28 resettlement sites (for instance, the families that only received 1 tarp, the polygamous families that received as they were one family, etc). They are providing:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>o 2 tarps</li> <li>o 6 wooden poles</li> <li>o 2 bundles of Bamboo</li> <li>o 1 tool kit for every two households</li> <li>o Solar lamps and blankets</li> </ul> <p>Both IOM SHELTER and SAVETC are facing the problem of founding resettlement sites that are EMPTY, with not families living there. So far, <b>CHIRUKA, MUOHO, JAVELA and ZIBUIA</b> are reported to be empty. IOM SHELTER and SAVETC to provide the list of the resettlement sites that they know are EMPTY to Mr Jemusse to analyse what is the reason and make a decision.</p> <p><b>As SAVE THE CHILDREN and IOM are the 2 partners that will be working in shelter in the resettlement sites a high coordination between them, CCCM and Tomas Jemusse is required</b></p>	<p><b>Action</b></p> <p>IOM / SAVE THE CHILDREN to send the list of the resettlement sites that they found empties to TOMAS JEMUSSE and KERRY CCMC to analyse what is the reason a make a decision.</p>	<p><b>Responsible</b></p> <p>SAVE THE CHILDREN + IOM + SHELTER CLUSTER+ IOM CCCM</p>
