1. Review of previous meeting action plans

Update on the status of the last action points as follows:

2. Information Management updates

5Ws reporting action points: IM team provided update on points which were raised and reached consensus during the 5Ws reporting workshop. The person who attended the CCM and the person who filled/entered the data on the 5Ws are different. In order to pass the message for the concerned person it was decided that all partners should assign a focal person to enter, verify and validate the entered data. The IM team and the focal person will have a meeting once in a month to verify and endorse the data.

To avoid double reporting and counting, the workshop attendee agreed on who to report to the national SNFI cluster. The project holder will report on behalf the implementing partners and IM team to make sure partners visibility in SNFI cluster products.

The issues related to the ReportHub are under discussion and the system admin is working on resolving the issues. The IM team will check and update partners on the status. Alternatively, the excel version of 5Ws might use whenever there is failure.

5Ws data cleaning: The IM team found discrepancies, double reported, under reported issues on the reported 5Ws. The cluster decided to clean the whole 2019 distribution. With this effort, all the partners are communicated. All most all partners cleaned their data and sent back to the cluster.

FTS: The cluster's funding rate is now at 14.6M USD, great change from what is reported in the last CCM. The cluster encouraged partners to upload all 2019 sector specific funding to the website.

3. TWiG Update

The TWiG is established to manage duplication of SNFI and WASH NFI kits. The objectives are developing a multi sectoral kit and to have operation map on areas of both sectors are working. The first meeting was last week, and it will take place twice a month. The team

- validated the ToR.
- GOAL for Wash and NRC for SNFI are elected as a co-chair

The first draft will be ready on October 7 and by the end of the 3 months, the multi sectoral kit and operational map will be available. All partners are encouraged to participate on the TWiG and send their PDM reports to the cluster.

It is also recommended that to merge the TWiG with the CCM.

4. HNO 2020

OCHA lead the analysis. The HNO 2020 will be multi-sectoral analysis. The analysis considered four consequences. Emergency shelter and NFI falls under the first consequence, Critical problems related to physical & mental wellbeing. Access to basic shelter services like partial and shelter construction will fall under the second consequence, Critical problems related to Living standards. The cluster is working closely with OCHA on the HNO 2020 data analysis and will share the findings and the report with partner once completed.

5. Regional update

East/West Wellega and Benishangul Gumuz

The West Wellega authorities currently allow access to the IDPs. OCHA and ZDRMO estimate that there are 14,500 returnees in Nejo and Kiltu Kara woredas. Reportedly 3449 IDPs are still in displacement, because of vulnerability and age issue. This IDPs didn't receive any support. The cluster has the resource but couldn't reach the needy because of the access issue. NRC allocated 5000 kits.

Challenge:

- Partners don't conduct PDM
- Duplication of kits. The same kit is distributed to the same people twice while some people get nothing.

Dawit from NDRMC proposed to support the returnees on the return areas otherwise they will go to the IDP sites in which there is no support. If resource is an issue, partners are asked to mobilize resources from their internal funds to these areas. It is also proposed to contact partners who are working on these areas. NDRMC is distributing food to Kemashi zone.

Somali region:

- 200 HHs relocated from Qoloji, government constructed permanent shelter
- Reintegration is done. Shelter and infrastructure have impact on the reintegration
- GU 2019 delayed, drought is expected in more zones, especially in Shabelle
- CERF 5-6M is allocated for Wash and Shelter Activities to FAO
- Rapid flood assessment conducted, drought and flood happened in the zones
- CERF for secondary displacement and EHF for flood and natural disaster are allocated funds

Dawit asked if the drought is the cluster's priority? Because they might have their own coping mechanism like moving with their shelter and NFI. The cluster coordinator, Yodit replied Somali Region is pushing to give priority for the climate induced.

GAP

1) Reintegration/relocation issue, but the sub-cluster was not the part of the process

West Guji and Gedo:

The number received from Kebele/Woreda are different from while the partners verify. There are IDPs in Gedo not recognized but partners are working on their own way to solve this issue. WVI will give cash support from the consortium for the Chirricu IDPs. Joint targeting in three woredas has been completed.

GAP

- 1) Lack of coordination and harmonization from number of loss and damage.
- 2) Only ANE is willing to support in Birbisa Kojoa
- 3) Partners are encouraged to keep the allocation to reduce overlap

- 4) Lack of coordination between zonal DRMO and the cluster. The sub-cluster and DRMO developed operation plan and allocate partners. But, DRMO they don't want to follow the plan and partners will go as per the DRMO.

The cluster coordinator requested for NDRMC support. The zonal DRMO called partners for a meeting without a presence of sub-national cluster.
