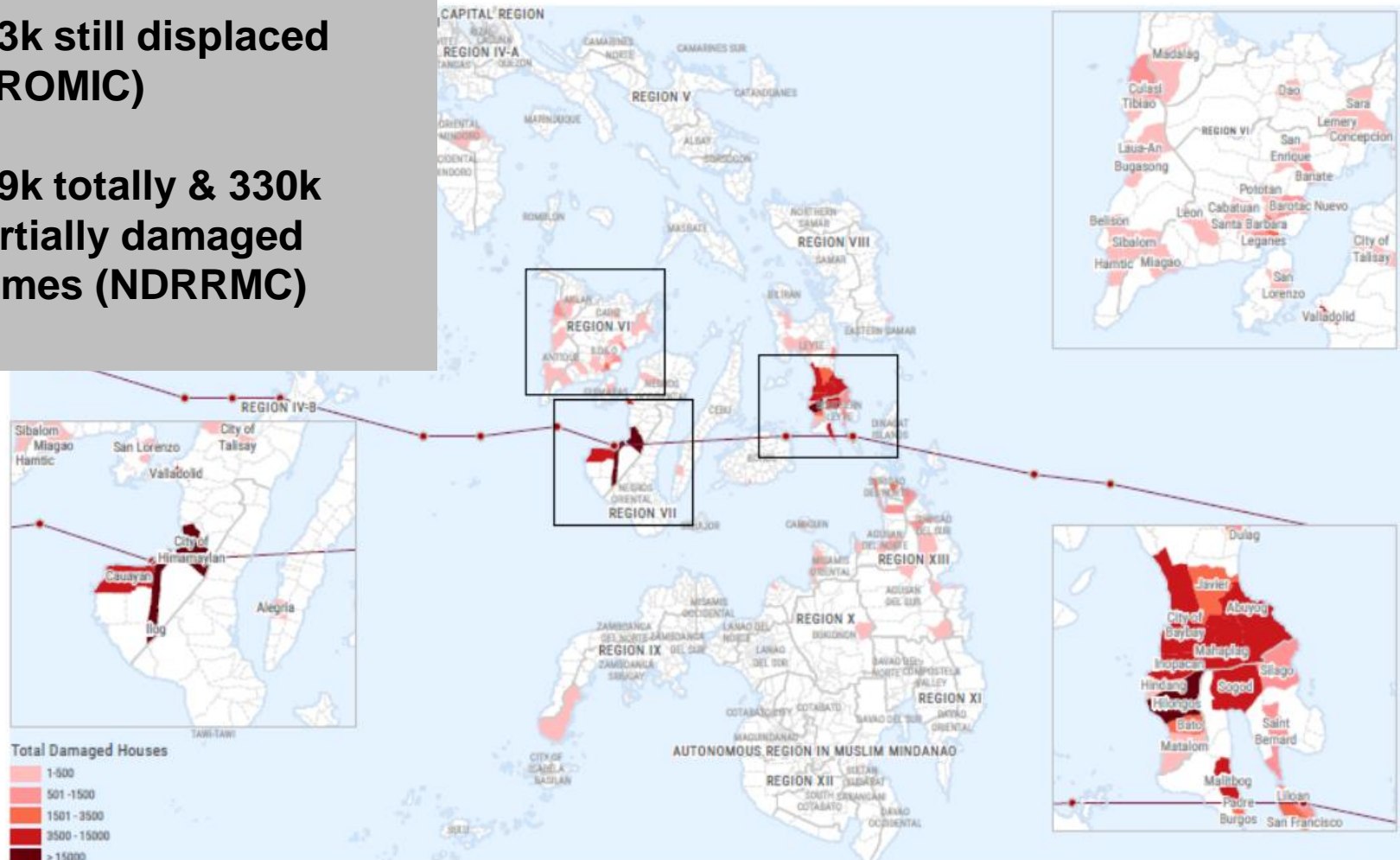

Situation Overview

As of Dec 26th:

- 523k still displaced (DROMIC)
- 149k totally & 330k partially damaged homes (NDRRMC)



Situation Overview - impact

NDRRMC data 26/12/2021

- 4 million persons affected across 11 regions (9 +2)
- 478,953 houses totally or partially damaged

- **When:** Status (planned, ongoing, completed), start date, end date

4Ws indicators

- Standard indicators
 - # of people benefitting from shelter assistance
 - # of shelter kits distributed
 - # of people benefitting from NFI assistance
 - # of NFI kits distributed
 - # of common structures and/or shelters constructed or rehabilitated
- Other indicators? Other activities?

HNP Strategy Key points

- Overall, 530,000 persons require USD 107.2 M
- Emergency shelter is a priority, targeting 90,000 persons, requiring USD 15 M in priority regions VIII and XIII
- Shelter response should address related Protection, Inclusion, PSEA, environmental consideration and COVID transmission.
- Cash and voucher where possible, link to Multi Purpose
- Large scale dissemination of BBS, all levels

UN has allocated unprecedented USD 12 million from CERF

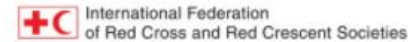
Key messages on shelter

Background

The following fact sheet and research memo have been developed to provide quick and key information of the legal and procedural context relating to Housing, Land and Property (HLP) within the target country. They are intended to inform programming and emergency responses, especially those involving shelter interventions. A rapid understanding of the tenure landscape in each country context will assist in delivering stronger and more equitable responses.

The HLP mapping project has been undertaken by Aliens lawyers, using templates developed by the Australian Red Cross (ARC) and the International Federation of the Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies (IFRC). All of the research has gone through a verification process with in country lawyers and/or country experts.
