### Participation criteria:

- The image has been taken by the contributor, or the photographer is appropriately credited;
- It has been taken in the context of a humanitarian emergency, within the past 10 years;
- It has not been published elsewhere (or if so, there is no restriction in using it for this competition);
- Each submission comes with a caption that explains its location, context, subject and date;
- Image data files can be created with any digital devices including smartphones and digital still cameras;
- Format/Resolution: JPEG / min. 240 dpi resolution. Each image should be saved in the .jpg/.jpeg format with a medium to high quality.
- Images should be at least 3,000 pixels in length.
- The author allows the Global Shelter Cluster to use the picture(s), if appropriately credited. Copyright will still be held by the author.
- Where photographs are of clearly identifiable individuals, permission for use should be obtained.
- Logos and other branding/visibility materials should not be excessively represented in the pictures.
