HRP vs. Non-HRP in 2021

1. Partner's profile:

- Partner should be an active participant of the Shelter Cluster at the national, sub-national and/or governorate coordination levels.
- Partner should have proven record of consistent reporting in the dedicated platforms (ActivityInfo, the UN-OCHA Financial Tracking Service, and the Shelter Cluster and UN-HABITAT war-damaged shelter reporting tool).
- Access to the proposed geographical areas, or the possibility to expand presence with minimum investment are a requirement.

2. Programs' requirements:

- clear approach and methodology used to select beneficiaries, including the **socio-economic vulnerability criteria (SEVAT)**;
- in line with the recommendations, technical guidelines and policies developed by the Shelter Cluster.

3. Intervention requirements:

- Carried out through priority Shelter and NFI activities in the **46** prioritized districts, **will be considered as contributing to HRP 2021**

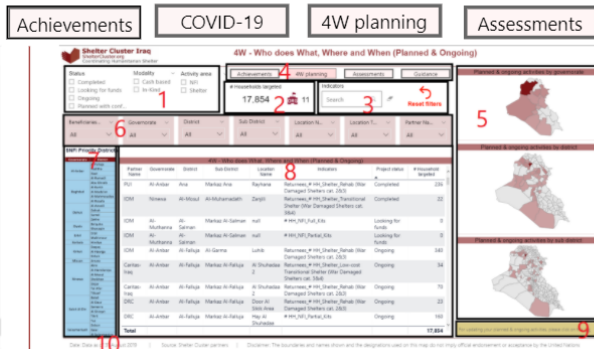
Guidance on how to use the dashboard



(Achievements page)

This page shows achievements to date, completed activities reported by partners in 2019.

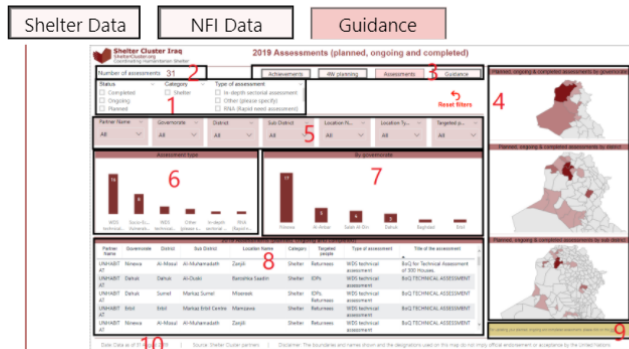
- (1) Displays the Cluster PIN and HRP Target for 2019.
- (2) Shows the total number of people reached with services by partners as of the last updated date in the top right-hand corner, based on partner reporting into the Activity Info database.
- (3) Click one tabs to toggle through the three pages of the dashboard and to access the guidance page.
- (4) Heat map showing the concentration of beneficiaries reached in the three main geographical/admin levels.
- (5) The light red boxes are filters that help you filter the data to find specific information. Data can be filtered by achievement data/visuals based on Plan (HRP and Non HRP), Location levels (Governorate, District, Sub district, Location name), Beneficiary type, Partner name, Month, Funding Agency, Main Sector (NFI or Shelter) and Modality.
- (6) Presents an overall summary of the shelter response thus far in 2019, including planned, ongoing and completed activities.



(4W planning page)

This page is meant for partners to report their planned activity, and to provide an update on ongoing activities to help partners improve their coordination.

- (1) Please use these filters to visualize data based on Status, Modality and Activity area
- (2) Shows the number of HHs targeted for support so far in 2019, and the number of partners reporting planned and ongoing activities thus far[PB1] Shows the number of partners reporting planned and ongoing activities and how many HHs are going to be covered with those.
- (3) Using the search bar, you can search for planned and ongoing programming based on indicators. (e.g. Cash for shelter will show all planned and ongoing cash for shelter programs).
- (4) Click one tabs to toggle through the three pages of the dashboard and to access the guidance page.
- (5) The heat maps display the concentration of partner activities by governorate, district, and sub-district, and numerical information can be found by clicking on the map.



(Assessments page)

This page is for partners to report on their planned, ongoing, and completed assessments. This way partners can know if another partner has planned an assessment for an area in which they are working or planning to work, and partners can avoid repeatedly assessing the same populations.

- (1) Use these filters to visualize data according to status, category and type of assessments reported.
- (2) This figure shows the number of assessments reported.
- (3) Click one tabs to toggle through the three pages of the dashboard and to access the guidance page.
- (4) The maps show where partners have conducted assessments at the governorate, district, and sub-district level.
- (5) The light red boxes are filters that can be used to display data based on location (geographical/admin levels), partner name, and the targeted population group.

NEEDS ANALYSIS

As per the IOM-led DTM report, **1.22 million IDPs** and **4.83 million Returnees** have been identified across the country, from Jan 2014 to December 2020. The number of IDPs continues to decrease (from 2.6 million as of Dec 2017 to 1.22 million as of Dec. 2020), while the numbers of returnees has increased (from 3.2 million, end of Dec 2017 to 4.83 million, end of Dec 2020).

- 17% of those IDPs are in camps, while 78% are currently in private settings (in rented accommodation or with host families), 8% remain in critical shelter arrangements (unfinished/abandoned building; school/religious buildings and informal settlements).
- 95% of the returnees are in their habitual residence, 1% in private settings while 4% live in critical shelter arrangement such as informal settlements, unfinished and abandoned buildings, schools, religious structures.

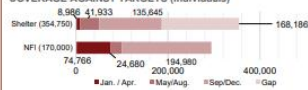
CURRENT CLUSTER INTERVENTIONS (1st Jan. – 31st Dec. 2020)

- Out of the overall SNFI Cluster target of 524,750 individuals, **294,426 (173%)** have been assisted with NFI kits; **186,564 (53%)** have benefited from shelter interventions.
 - 133,369 people living in camps and informal settlements have been reached with NFI kits; **94,893 people** have been provided with emergency shelter interventions.
 - 69,464 people living out of camps have been reached with NFI kits; **46,123 people** have been provided with emergency shelter interventions.
 - 91,873 returnees have been reached with NFI kits; **45,548 people** were assisted with either emergency repairs of War Damaged Shelter (WDS) or provided with Sealing-off Kits.

GAPS / Constraints and Key Critical Issues

- Between October and December 2020, 16 IDP camps have been suddenly closed by the government, causing close to 30,000 IDPs to move to out of camp settings. Rapid Response is ongoing to reach new arrivals from camps with shelter and NFI assistance. Over 3,000 HHs in 5 governorates will be targeted by 4 Partners through HRF funding.
- The Shelter Cluster has just completed the 2021 Humanitarian Need Overview (HNO) and the sectoral Humanitarian Response Plan (HRP) for 2021.
- IDP camps with established facilities for COVID-19 quarantine and isolation have now been closed. Establishment of quarantine and isolation areas in remaining IDP camps in Dohuk and Sulaymaniyah is still in the process.
- Shelter Cluster Iraq is engaging with the recently established Durable Solutions Task Force to address wider issues for the Housing Sector, transitioning to development/stabilization activities, etc.

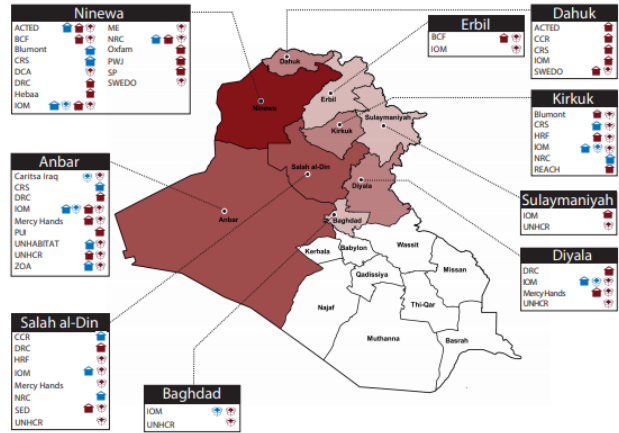

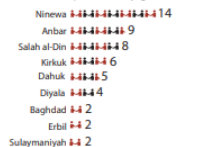

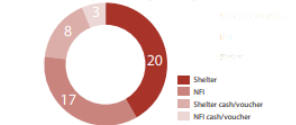
Partners reporting in Activity Info

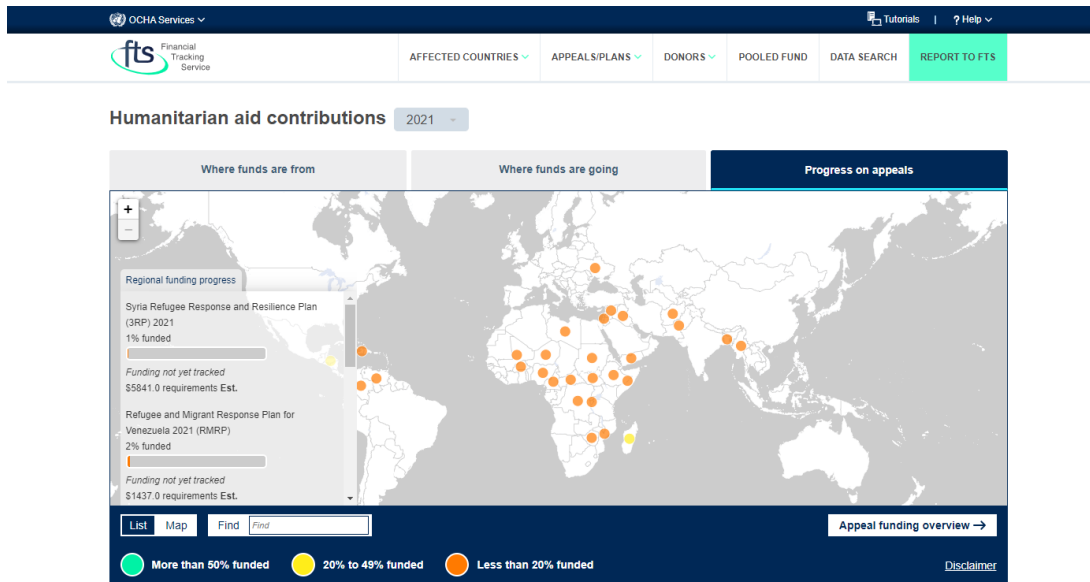
