3. Endorsement of Shelter Cluster 4W template.

Shelter cluster presented a 4W template based and successfully tested in previous disasters, aiming to harmonize and facilitate both SC / OCHA reporting.

The template contains inputs related with OCHA reporting and other inputs aiming to Inform the shelter response as Cluster.

Shelter Cluster partners (Jansen / LWR, Kim /IOM, Arcadio /CRS) are focal point for this subject. They reported that DHSUD fixed an amount of PHP 5000 to support damaged houses (regardless of level of damage). LWR share a PHP 20.000 BoQ for a basic shelter. Partners to discuss if this amount is enough or agencies could top up government support.
