2. Gaps field validation: key informant assessment

Pre-crisis vulnerability and building damage severity analysis → prioritization and gaps

Does this make sense? Are the outcomes still relevant?

Triangulate this data by conducting a rapid, top level, qualitative key informant assessment

2. Gaps field validation: key informant assessment

Objectives

1. Triangulate the pre-crisis vulnerability index
2. Triangulate the building damage severity index
3. Identify remaining gaps

Area of interest

Focusing on the 32 priority municipalities
(Bohol, Cebu, Palawan, Southern Leyte, Surigao del Norte, Dinagat Islands)

2. Gaps field validation: key informant assessment

Respondents

Key Informants:

- Aiming for 3 KI per municipality
 - Local authorities
 - Community leaders
 - Focal points NGO/Red Cross
 - Other
- Identification of KIs to be done by partners

2. Gaps field validation: key informant assessment

Data collection

Key Informant Interviews

- Questionnaire
- Interviews take max 10 minutes
- By phone (or where possible in person)

- Partners support requested in conducting the interviews
