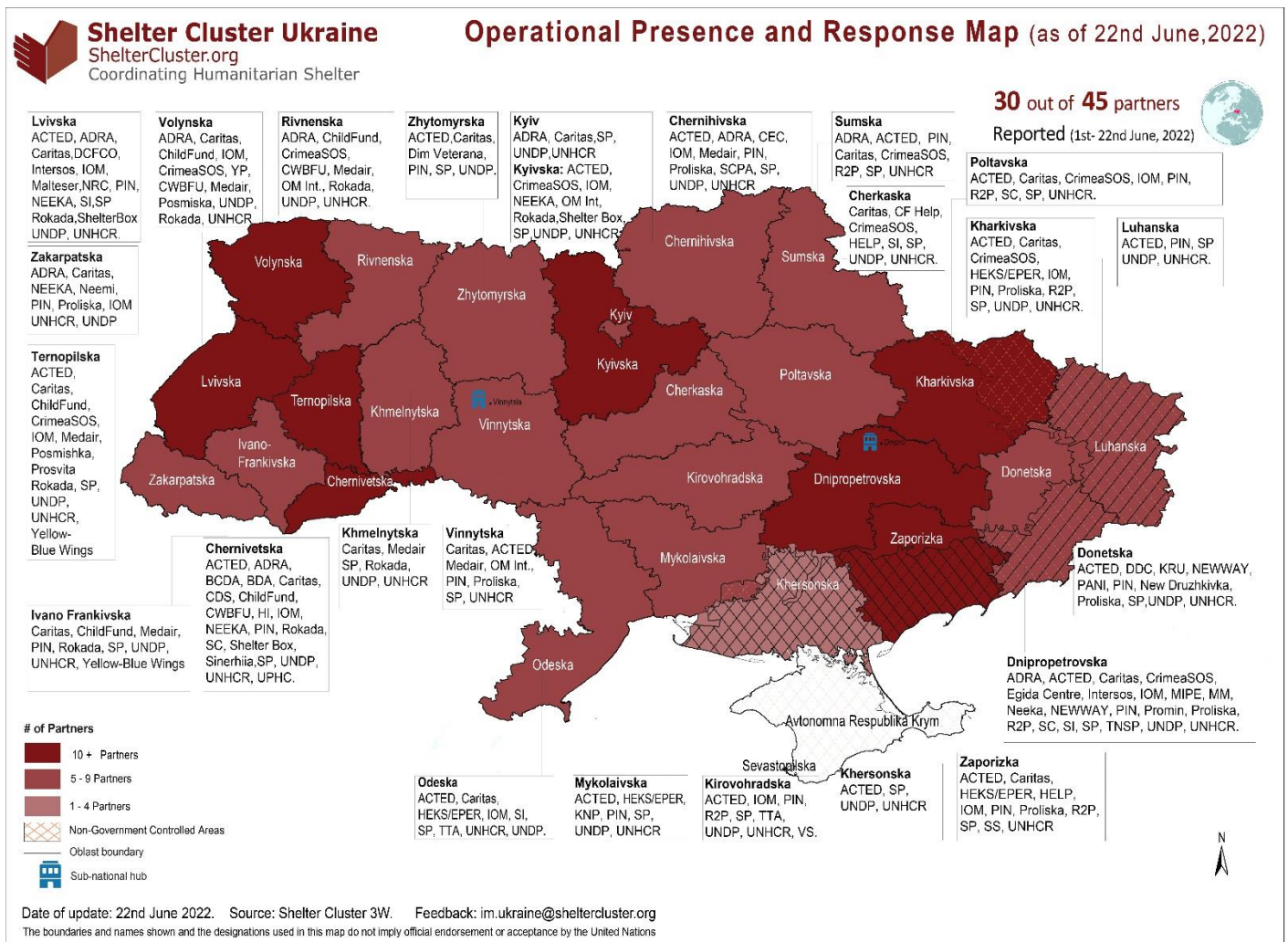

1. Response updates

SC Partners operational presence: as of 22nd June 2022



- **778,154** persons assisted by the SNFI cluster partners since 25 February, 2022.
- **196,405** assisted people with NFI kits in collective centers
- **455,915** assisted people with NFI kits at household level
- **77,977** assisted people with shelter kits

2. Partner updates

- **Intersos** - Currently doing assessments in Poltavaska and Vinnytsia oblasts. Distribution of 510 HH kits planned for next week in Vinnytsia oblast
- **SC** – Delivery of NFIs is being done through partners, DDC, Posmishka, Global Synergy, Help Ukraine. Direct procurement of NFIs ongoing.
- **Shelter Box** – There was a break in the supply chain due to absence of trucks and drivers but the issue has been resolved.
- **Care Germany** is working with IRF and are planning to scale up Shelter activities, including winterization.
- **Dnipro sub-national cluster co-chair**: noted that there is a growing number of organizations willing to undertake shelter activities in the Dnipro sub-cluster
- **Central sub-national cluster coordinator** – Currently collecting data of CCs and partners. Updated CCs data from Zakarpatska authorities. Sub-national coordinator will engage local authorities for more information.

3. TWiGs update

- Discussion at the Damage assessment TWiG focused on using the SC Kobo account as the common account for all SC partners. Partners were also requested to provide volunteers to verify machine data on damaged houses.
- CCs committed and potential for assessment should be registered in the CCs database, TWiG member can request for the access to it.

4. Updates from housing family support programme

- **Lidiia Kuzmenko (UNHCR)** noted that government is planning to introduce amendments to the current framework to ensure that compensation is available to hosts who shelter IDPs from temporarily occupied territories and those under active fighting as well as those whose houses have been destroyed. Updated list of locations has been published.
- **NRC, Ukrainian Red Cross and UNHCR** are working with government on this programme. 100% of the families were covered by the three organizations during the reporting week.

5. Collective Centres

- SCC shared updates on committed and non-committed CCs updates.

6. Service mapping training

- The SC team is planning to conduct service mapping training on 7th July in English and Ukrainian at 12:00pm.
