

Pakistan - % change in flood inundation per district

as of 21st September 2022

Comparing the flood extents between 14-21 September 2022, to the maximum flood extent as of 31st August 2022, the 84 "calamity declared" districts have seen a 40% decrease in flood inundation area.

From 70,724 km² at its peak, the flooded area as of 2nd September stands at 41,881 km².

Flood inundation level have decreased by 90-100% in 15 districts, decrease by less than 30% in 20 districts, while one district, Jamshoro, seen a slight increase.
