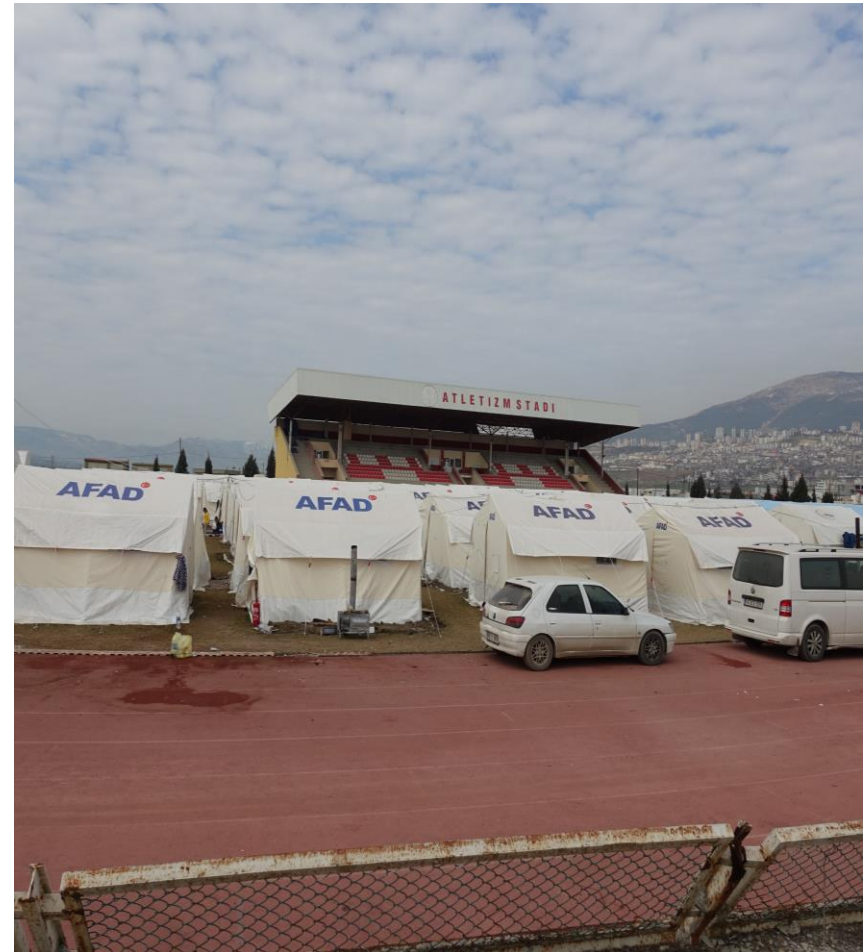

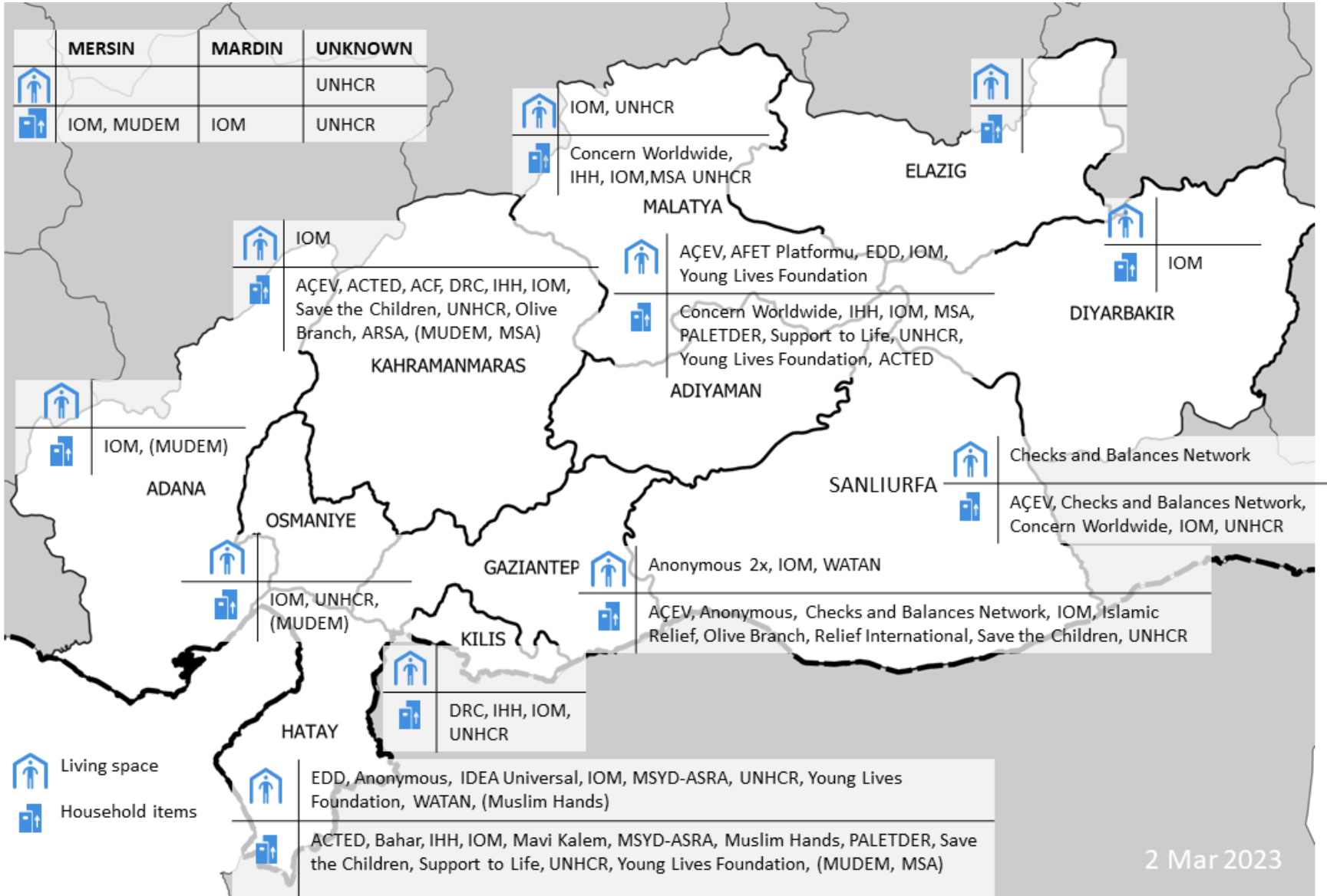

Situation update

- 45,089 deaths (27/02)
- 115,000 injured people (24/02)
- Official figures stand at 168,700 buildings heavily damaged as of 25 February, with 564,447 apartments (28/2)
- An estimated 2.7 million people are displaced in the region, 1.1 million outside
- Top provinces; Hatay (774K), Maras (489K), Malatya (320K), Adiyaman (307K), Gaziantep (252K) [source: IOM]

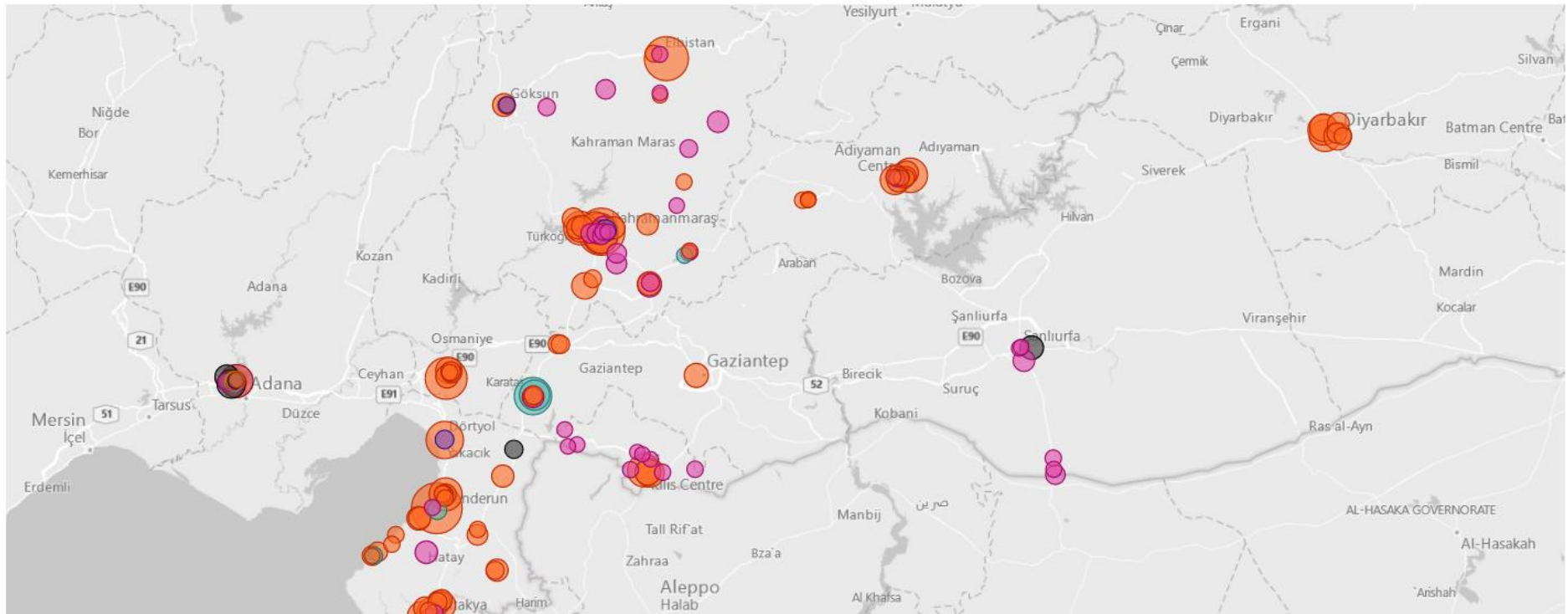

MIRA update

- Data collection finished (466 interviews), analysis ongoing, report expected end of this week. Most districts are well reached (≥ 3 interviews), females and pwd underrepresented.
- Shelter is (by far) the highest priority need. NFI's the third. [In this district what are the three highest priority needs of the population affected by the disaster?]
- On average 32% of the houses are deemed uninhabitable. [Approximately what percentage of houses / private dwellings have been damaged or destroyed in the district?]
- Displaced living mentioned in tents – 50% of respondents, host families – 50% of respondents, temporary accommodation centres – 31%, public buildings – 26%, outside – 19%. [Where do displaced persons live? Multiple select]
- Top shelter needs and challenges are additional tents, cash, not enough shelters, not enough space in shelters, no bathing facilities.
