### Update from TSS

**Main needs:** WASH facilities, hygiene kits, protection

There are on-going efforts to move people towards container sites and container cities are being built. Families with vulnerabilities are being prioritized. A total of 9,942 individuals live in the container sites with 85% occupancy rate.

**Site visit observations:**

Ekinozu: There is no formal site in the district, people are mainly staying in informal settlements. Hygiene kits and WASH facilities are the main needs. People cook their own food, therefore dry food is a continuous need. Moreover, some people try to put locks to their tents as they have certain safety concerns.

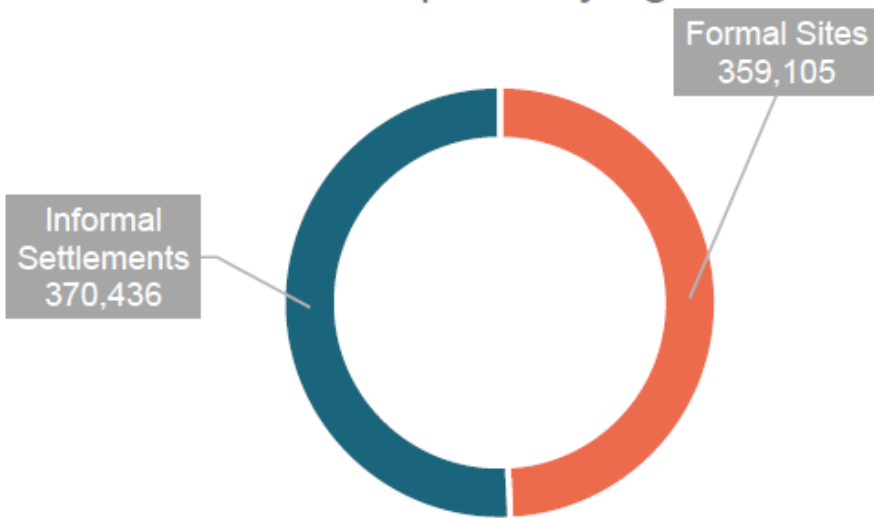

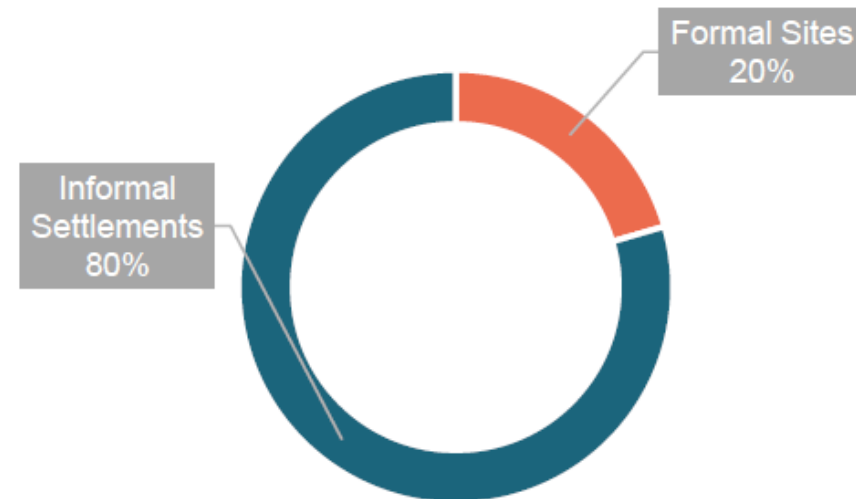

Highest ratio of informal sites to formal settlements, however overall populations are similar between the two

Kills in 47% of informal settlements reported the need for water while shelter was a higher reported need in formal sites - 43% of formal sites reporting.

## DTM Round 1 (last week data)

- New data available in [DTM dashboard](#)
- Ongoing process to produce final report, meantime:
- In Maras, **665** sites/settlements/neighbourhoods reported needs
- 717,422 people staying in these locations.
- 553 are informal sites and 544 are tents or makeshift shelters.
- 350 sites report need for more NFIs and 146 need for additional bedding.
- This **does not** mean this is an actual number of people sheltering or complete list of needs assessed
