Action points from last meeting

- **Shelter sector** to check if there is damage data on neighbourhood level (of building level)?

In progress, AFAD is waiting for contested assessments to be finalized to release the data.

- **Shelter Sector to work with Protection Sector** on map of assistance and gaps that may emerge – and utilise Protection Sector resources that have some work done on this matter.

Map will be presented today – for comments.

- **Partners** are invited to support Hub coordination by acting as Shelter Sector Focal Point.
- **Shelter Sector** to check HH reached numbers in Activity Info – if it is correct and if it includes items provided directly to AFAD (not distributed directly by partners).

Yes – AI includes items provided to AFAD (so not directly distributed by the partners).

- **Shelter Sector** to contact Global Shelter Cluster support for HLP support.

Issue will be considered by HLP Working Group. HLP focal point from GSC can be involved if needed.

- **UNDAC – OCHA** to confirm with AFAD if container delivery to rural areas (individual homes) is a broader process? **DONE – it is a wider process also confirmed in Maras.**
- **Shelter Sector** to check if there is public information on vacancy/occupancy rates in Adiyaman or broader. **Not found yet – in progress.**
- **Shelter Sector** to follow up with OCHA regarding AFAD's specs for shading kit and damage data at district level. **Reached out to AFAD (via OCHA) – still waiting for their response.**

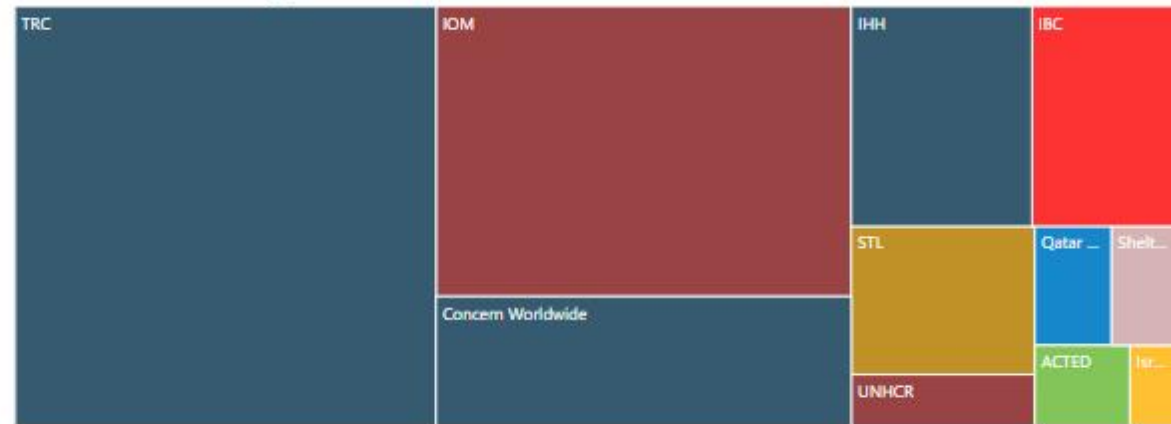

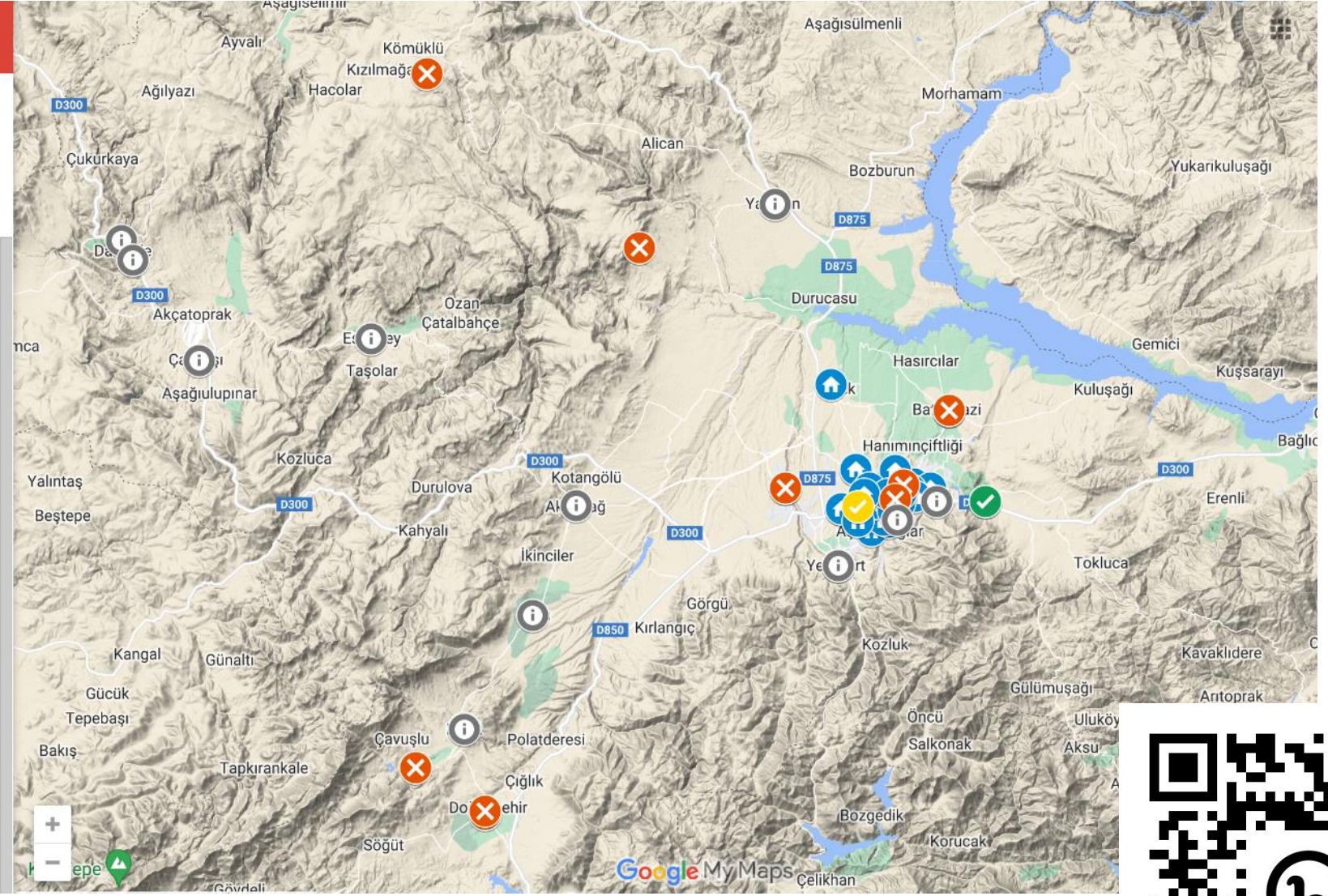

Update from Shelter Sector

- Partners are looking for referral regarding locations to distribute NFIs.
- Hatay Hub: large part of Antakya was declared is announced to be under urban renewal program. Consequences are being clarified.
- Question: are there any towns or villages that are “no build zones” in Adiyaman?
- AFAD in Hatay is using iftar in the tent cities to provide information in assistance available and answer the questions (after the iftar in the large tents in formal camps). Have partners observed similar sessions in Adiyaman?

Update:

- Number of formal tent cities is dropping according to AFAD data (35 last week, down from 46 previous and 51 two reports ago).
- Container cities 10 currently – planned is 29 in total.
- 19 formal sites are remaining, after 10 were closed mainly because of the impact of the floods.
- People were moved to container cities and remaining tent cities.
- Site Profiling for neighborhoods with dispersed shelters
- Referral Tracking Tool

Heavy Damage*

Moderate Damage

*The category of heavy damage includes buildings that are heavily damaged, that are collapsed, or that need to be demolished

Confirmed

Unknown

Homeowners

This includes homeowners with buildings in "no build zones". It is unsure what happens to the land that is owned in "no build zones".

Homeowners with buildings that are not registered on land title

Renters

Financial

10.000 TL as support payment (one-off per household)

5000 TL for owners monthly for 12 months

15.000 TL support for relocation (one-off)

3000 TL rent support for renters monthly for 12 months (in this case, relocation to container is not provided)

Reconstruction and repair

Loan is provided with reduced interest rate

Housing

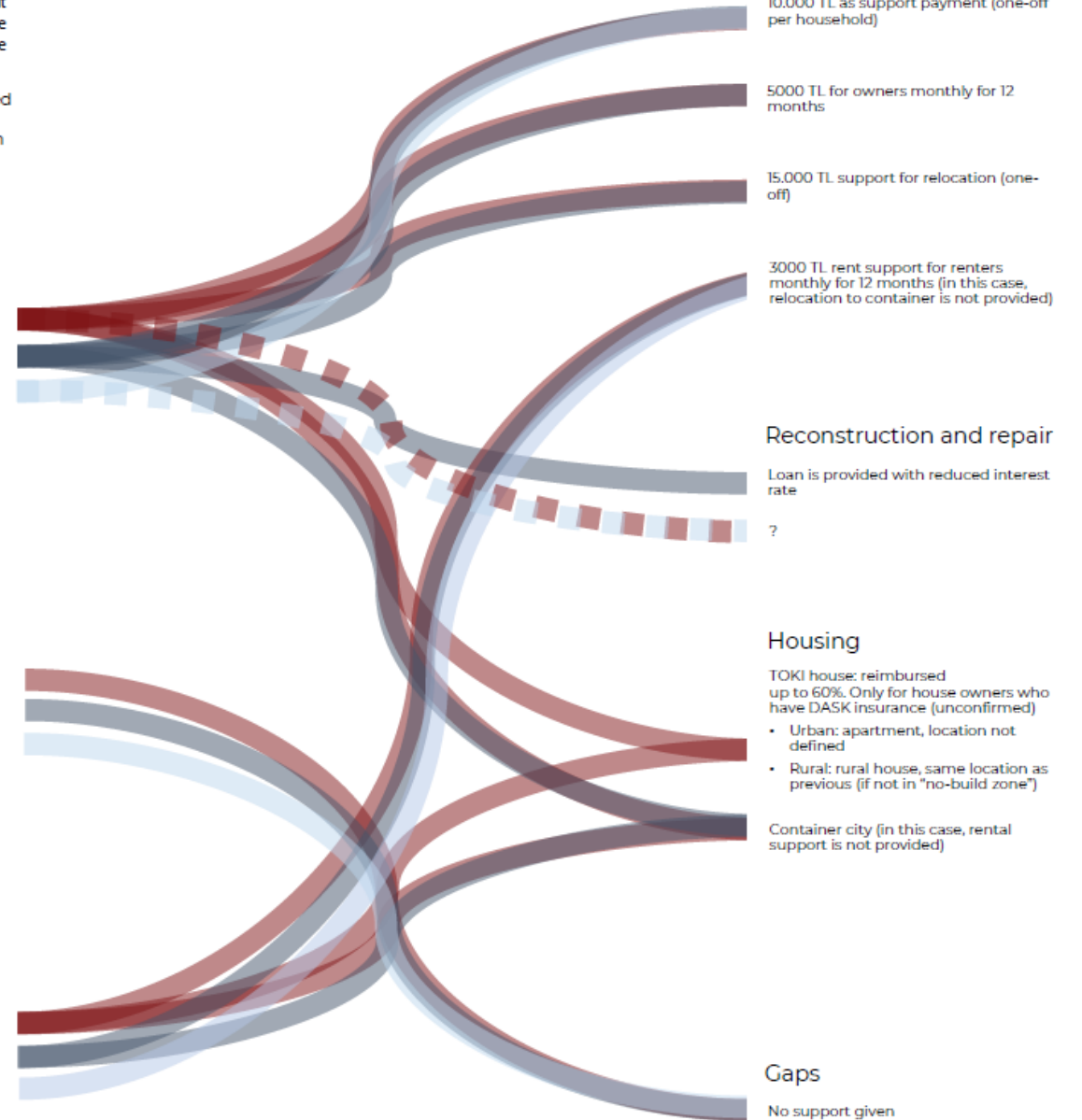
TOKI house: reimbursed up to 60%. Only for house owners who have DASK insurance (unconfirmed)

- Urban: apartment, location not defined
- Rural: rural house, same location as previous (if not in "no-build zone")

Container city (in this case, rental support is not provided)

Icon	Type	Cost Comparison	Description
	Household Shade		<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Shading kits distributed at HH level• Can use standard Emergency Shelter Kits (ESKs)• HH led initiative but with technical support if needed
	Tent Shade		<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Fixed shade over whole tent• Can be constructed in rows, steel columns, concrete foundation• Shade netting is lighter and less affected by high wind
	Community Shade		<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Shade provided in available space per block or unit of tents• Multi-purpose use• Male / female areas depending on community wishes

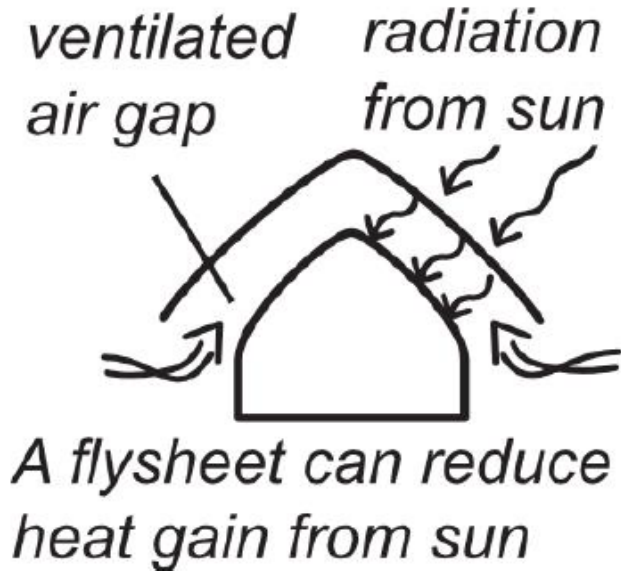

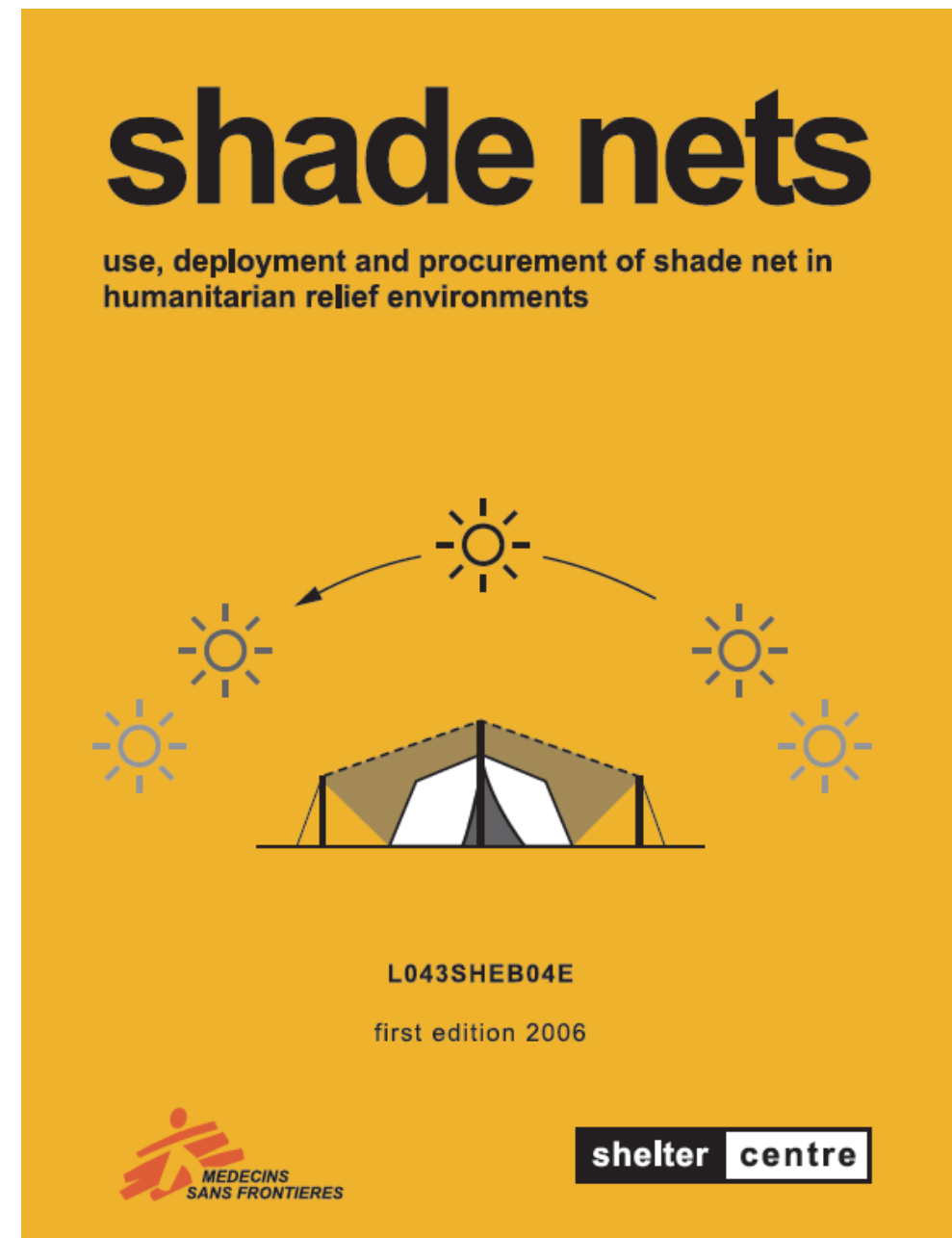
- *“Yes, we need this! Useful !”*
