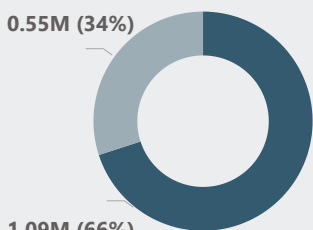

### SITUATION OVERVIEW

Ukraine is facing its second winter after the start of the full-scale war which has caused widespread destruction of homes, massive displacement and devastated vital infrastructure, including energy, water and heating systems, leaving millions of people vulnerable to the upcoming winter. The shelter cluster partners are responding to the diverse winter needs, prioritizing the support in front-line communities and regions, ensuring that winter assistance is provided as close as possible to the people in need. The response is focused on provision of solid fuel heaters, winter clothes and nonfood items kits, as well as insulation of homes and provision of cash and voucher support to meet energy needs.

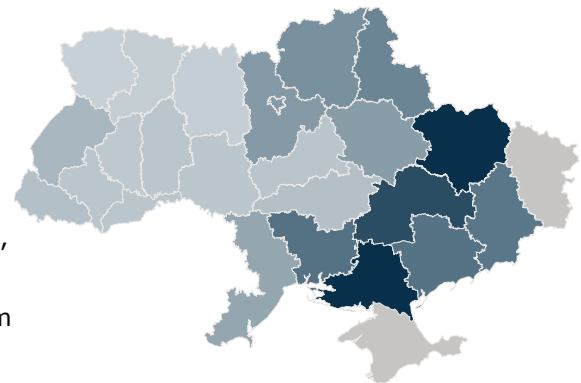
### RESPONSE

- Provision of winter heaters
- Support for winter energy needs (cash or solid fuel)
- Provision of winter clothes & NFIs
- Distribution of generators
- Insulation of substandard houses
- Rental support

### CHALLENGES

- Rising prices, especially energy costs, strain already impacted domestic economies.
- Winter poses power outage risks from attacks or electrical stress in various regions.
- An escalation in hostilities may lead to further population displacement during colder periods.
- Logistics and market access limits the possibility of cash based response in some areas close to the frontline.

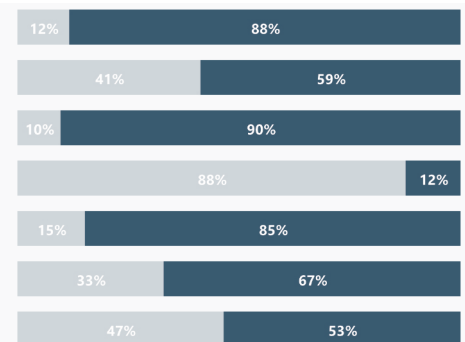
