



HIGHLIGHTS

- **Humanitarian Needs Overview [HNO] 2024:** People in need of essential Shelter and NFI assistance across Syria during 2024 stands at 6.8M and 6.2M for Core and 5.5M of Winter items. The shelter needs have slightly decreased and the NFI have remained similar compared the high of 2023, due to earthquake.
- **Multi-Sector Needs Assessment [MSNA] 2023:** Key findings include: Estimated 38 per cent of the population living in housing/ apartment (finished or unfinished) are living in partially safe or unsafe conditions.
Lack of access to **electricity (24 per cent)**, **insulation from heat and cold (22 per cent)**, and **leakage from roof and ceiling (20 per cent)** are the major shelter adequacy issues.
50 per cent of the population experiencing **Housing Land and Property issues**.
Approximately 10 million people are without sufficient and appropriate winter clothing, safe and/ or sufficient heating devices to maintain living space and personal warmth.
- **Activity based costing:** Syria operation would be adopting activity-based costing for Humanitarian Response Plan [HRP] 2024 and henceforth. SNFI sectors estimate 1.59M people should be targeted with essential shelter assistance requiring US\$ 254M and 2.4M and 3M people to be targeted requiring US\$ 299M.
- **Contingency Plan:** To address the immediate needs resulting from continuous violence in north and eastern Syria, an estimated 60K people need SNFI assistance requiring US\$ 11.6M in Deir-ez-Zor. Due to ongoing hostilities across the frontlines in north and eastern Syria more than 54K are in need of urgent assistance requiring US\$ 10.6M. Escalation of violence across the region is exacerbating needs.

RESPONSE

- **Achievements:** Shelter and NFI partners have been able to reach 0.9M and 1.3M people respectively with essential Shelter interventions and Core NFI provision.
- **Funding:** At the end of Q4, partners secured USD 99.6M and USD 82M for shelter and NFI responses resulting in a funding gap of 53% and 73% respectively.

GAPS / CHALLENGES

- **Economic hardship:** Deteriorating economic situation, fluctuation in commodity prices and severe shortage in power supply has resulted in increase in the cost of response, especially shelter rehabilitation activities.
- **Critical funding gap:** Vulnerable people may continue to adopt negative coping mechanism unless additional resources are not made available to sector partners to enable provision of critical shelter and NFI assistance.

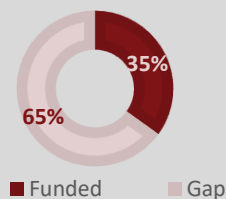

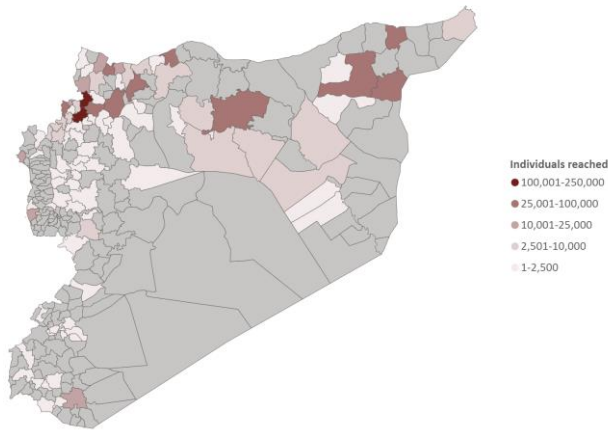

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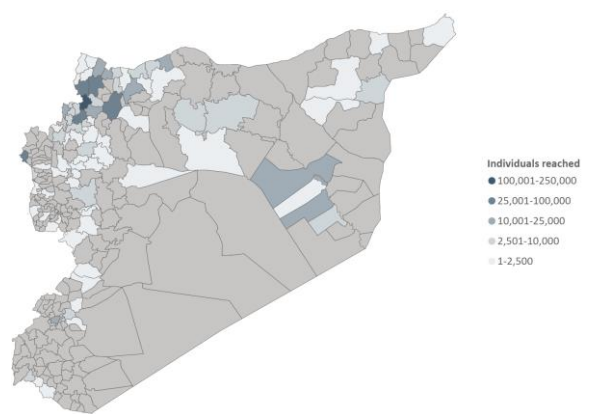

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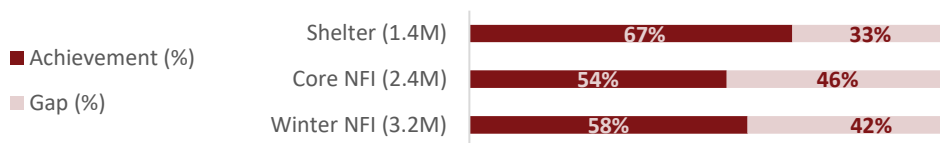
Individuals reached with shelter activities, by subdistrict



Individuals reached with core NFI activities, by subdistrict

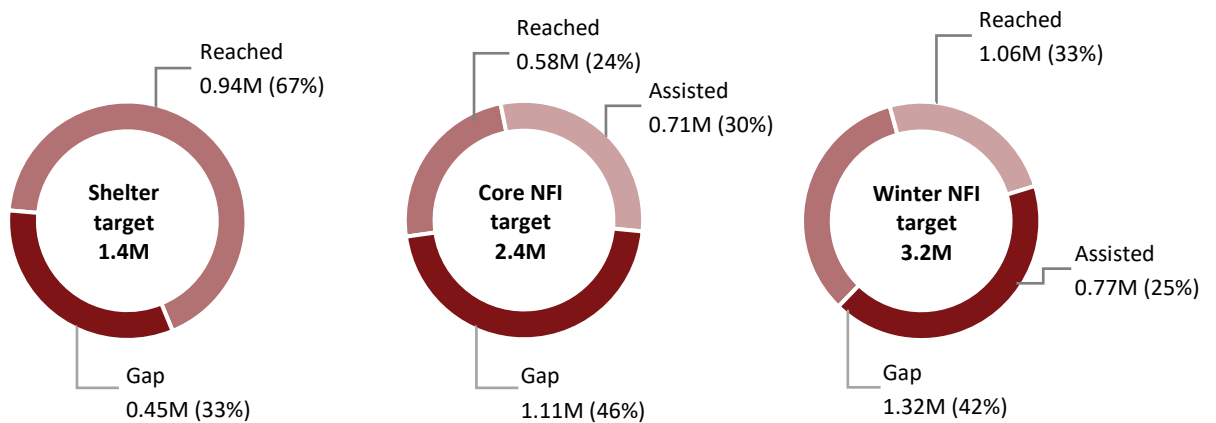


COVERAGE AGAINST HRP 2023 TARGETS* (% OF INDIVIDUALS REACHED)
