COORDINATION UPDATE

- Flood temporary taskforce led by OCHA, members are shelter, WASH, and SMWG. Mission to the North was successful yesterday.
- Preliminary assessment of the coastal sites finalized in the middle area by BLDA, still waiting the update from CRS on their assessment in Khan Younis.
- Working closely with the site management WG- a list of remaining sites needing verification is shared, partners are encouraged to use the list and the SMWG tool for the sites they are assessing to save efforts and do not overlap.
- The ABC mission to Gaza was conducted successfully last week, NRC Silvia participated representing the Shelter cluster
 - Shelter Priority in North: SOKs, Toolkits, Tents
 - NFI priority in North: Blankets, Clothes, Mattresses
 - Priority target groups – flood prone areas, CCs, areas affected by military activity, Newly displaced, those living in damaged homes

COORDINATION UPDATE

- ICCG assessment mission to Khanyounis is planned today, Emma from Acted is participating on behalf of the cluster.
- Very few trucks came in to the FR this week so there's a big backlog. No prioritization of the FR trucks was made last week due to the remaining backlog from the previous weeks.
- Work currently being worked on:
 - Site prioritisation
 - Damage figures
 - Interaction with MoSD
 - Branding policy
 - There's a new flash appeal coming – be ready!
 - HF fast track
 - 5ws – next deadline for updates is 30th September
 - Website

FENCE ROAD

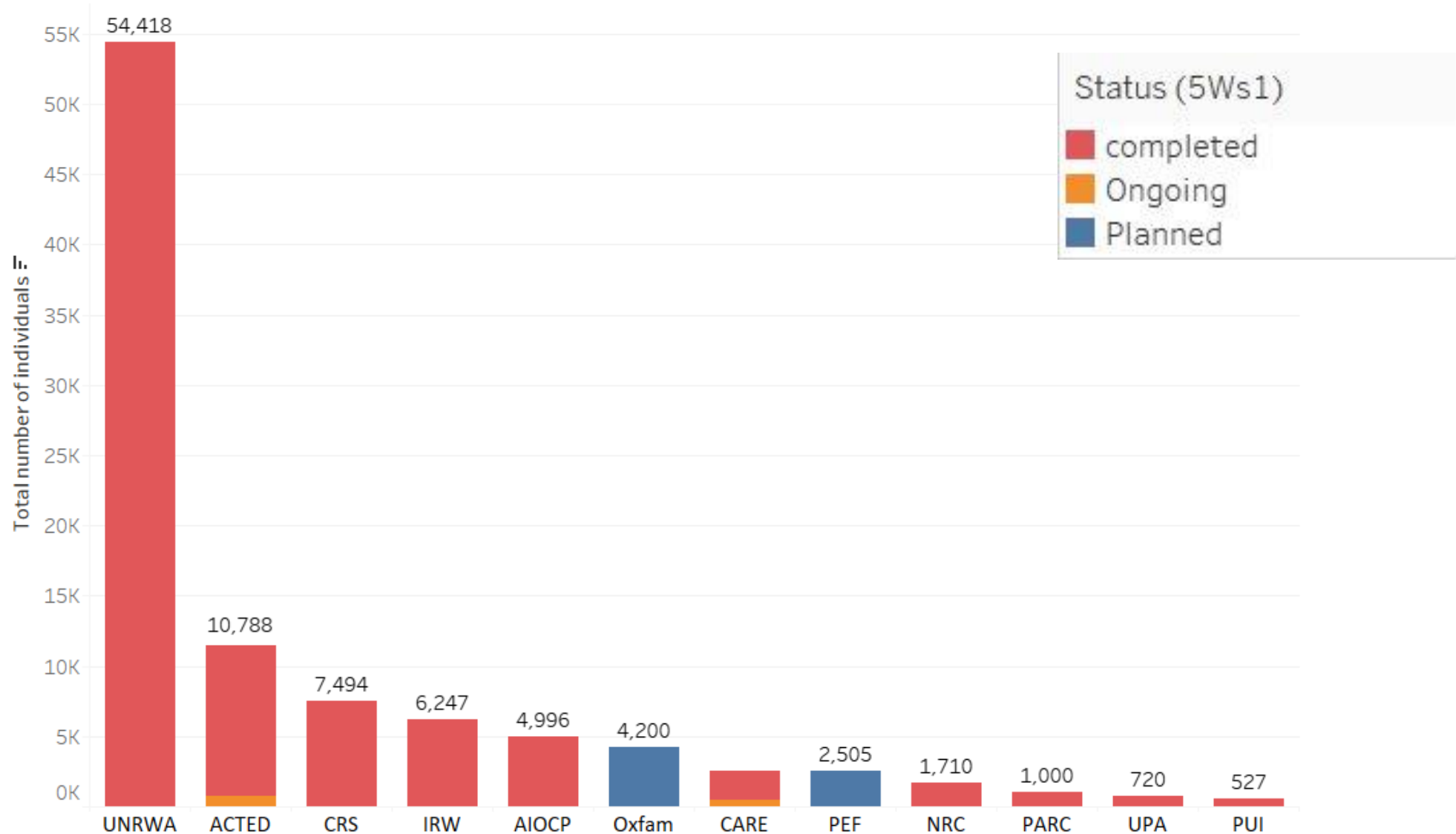
- There is a lack of goods coming on through Kerem Shalom
- The fence road movement is a temporary option used to clear the backlog currently in Al Arish.
- As per OCHA inter-cluster prioritization guidance, fence road is used for prioritized items that are more susceptible to looting and theft.
- Shelter will be prioritised due to the urgent need for winterisation – **the more we can prove we have items to get into Gaza, the more trucks we can ask for.**
- Also working on moving items directly from Jordan on the JHCO.
- Timeline:
 - Tuesdays - clusters submit prioritised partner items
 - Thursday – clusters meet to agree priorities for following week

FENCE ROAD

- Partners must submit their SRFs and truck details as usual to Logs Cluster
- Partners must submit their fence road truck details by **TUESDAY AM** for the following week so that the Logs cluster can collate and share with the ICCG.
- The cluster is working on a way to plan further in advance, and we will let you know once this is finalized
- Recently we have only been able to put forward tents and SOKs, and bedding sets—please let us know what you have to be moved into the fence road.

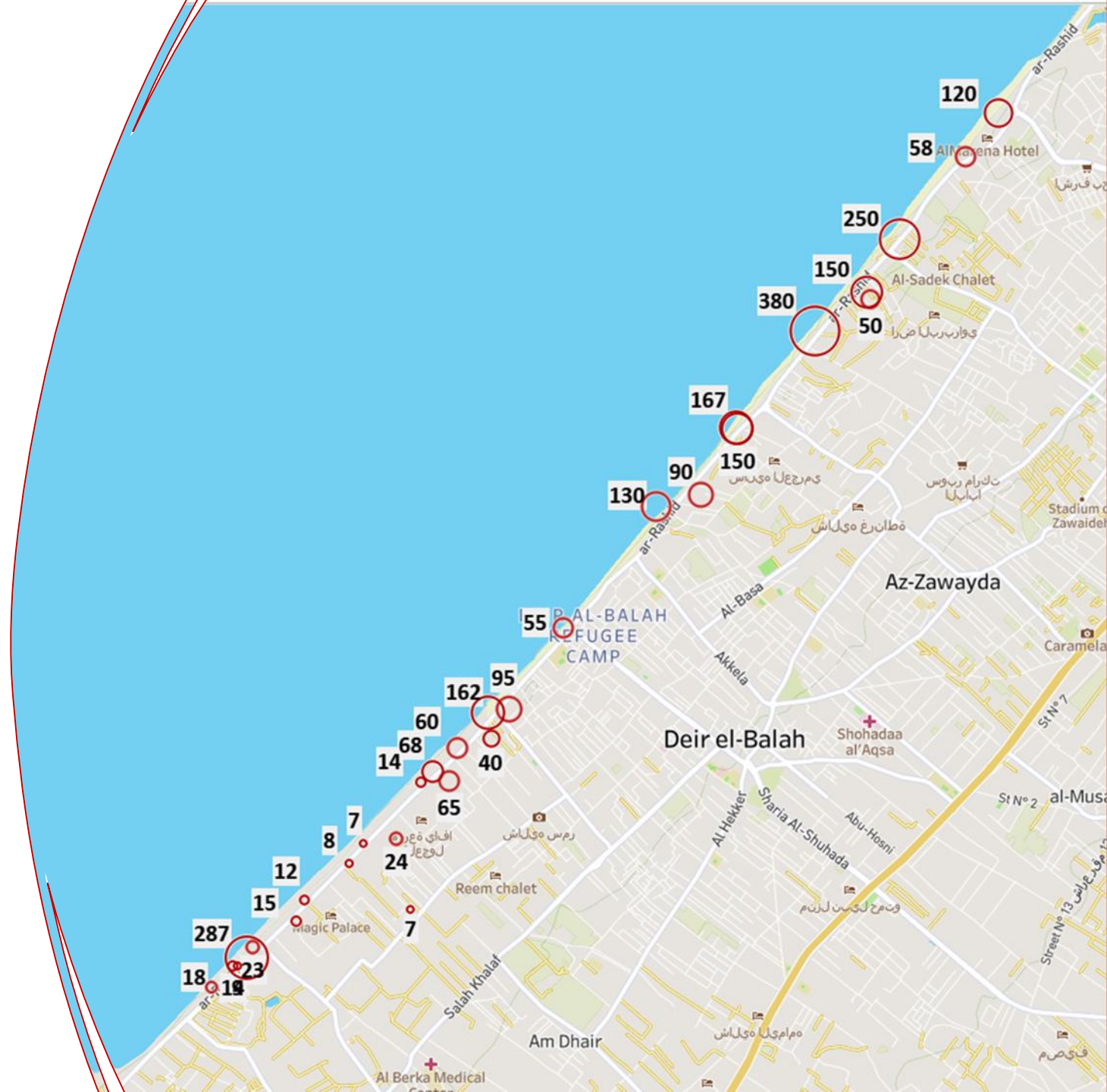
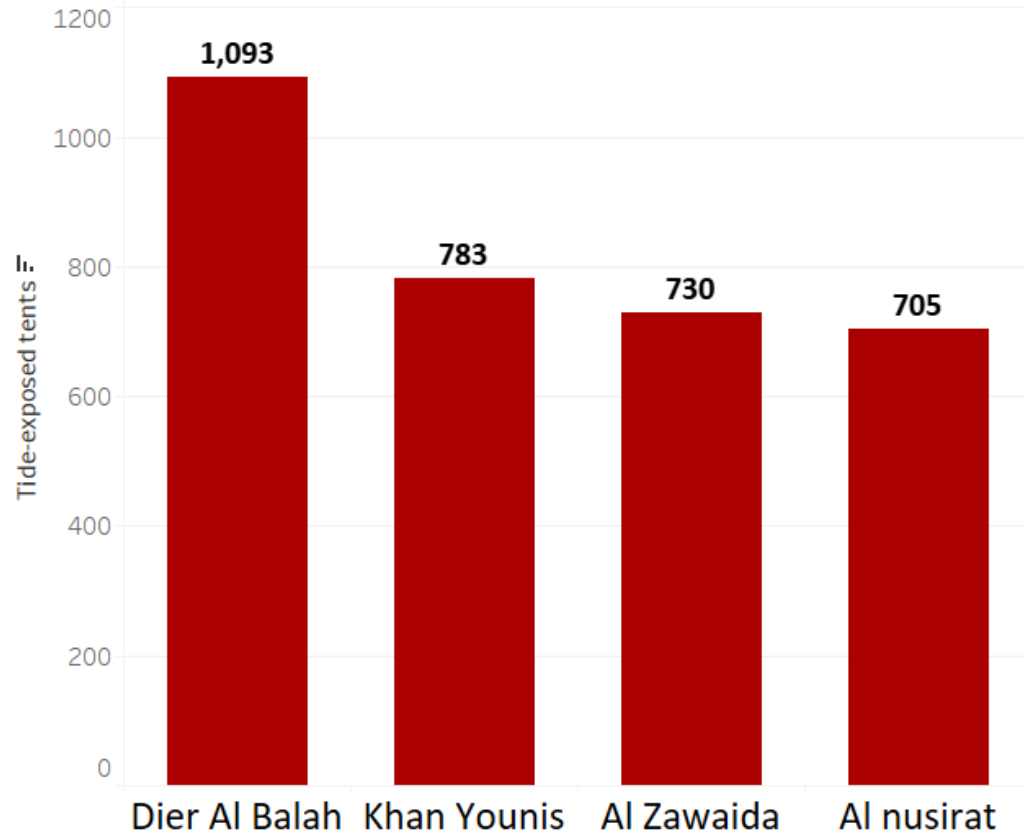
