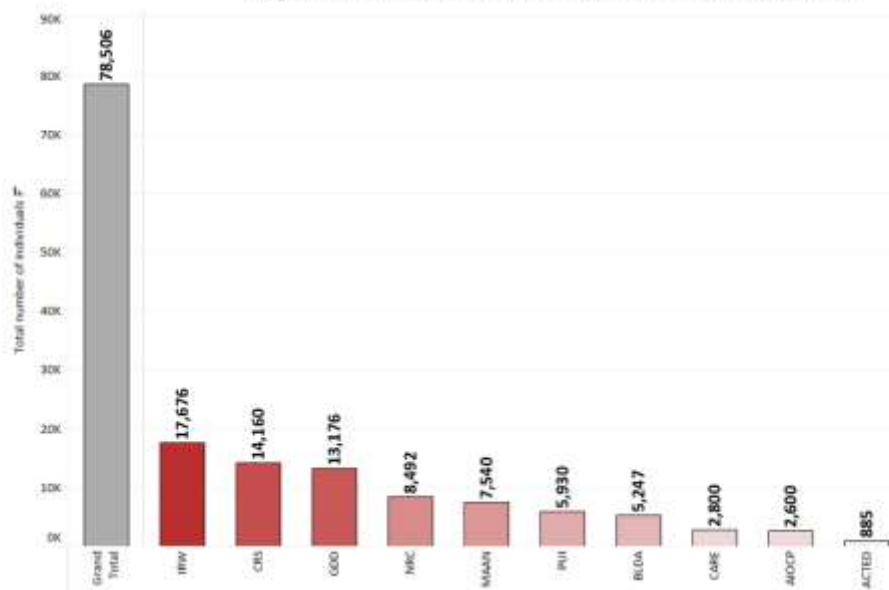
- The logs cluster is requesting to ensure that all items have preclearance from COGAT before sending it for prioritization.
- Still prioritizing SOKs, tents then bedding sets and winter clothes kits.
- Flour Sacks – no sacks available at the moment
- Until now, the majority of the requests to enter wooden framing kits were denied by COGAT. **Partners are requested to share the information of the denied requests with the cluster. Only will be collected and consolidated for advocacy purposes.**
- Northern Gaza (realistically Gaza City) – fuel? Operations?
- **Please keep us updated of your response in the North on daily basis, (no later than 3:00 pm) to feed in the North situation daily update and to the JHOC meeting.**
- Assessment in the North – we are aware that we need to have a better understanding of needs, any ideas of how this could be done?

- Looting – please also complete the Loss Report KOBO so we can have an update on what partners are losing – we’ve had two responses since August and we know there is more looting
- **Energy:**
 - We shared the KOBO for the humanitarian energy survey – please do complete it. There can be more than one response per agency
 - Enumerator training for IDP survey this week and starting to sample 17th onwards
- Sealing off damaged buildings – meeting held with partners who are doing this last week – guidance document will be produced. If you are doing this please let us know

159,000 Housing unit totally destroyed Gaza Strip

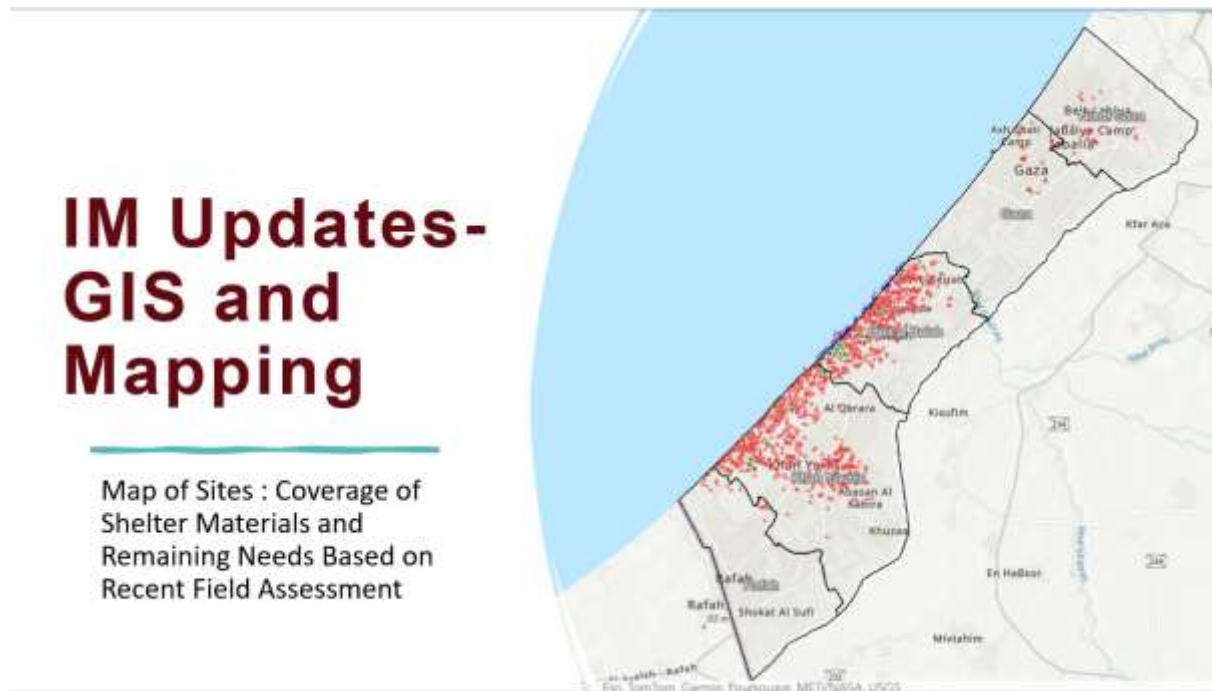
83,000 Housing unit severely damaged Gaza Strip

PEF Presentation:

Palestine Environmental Friends Association provided a presentation on one of their projects implemented recently titled “Providing basic shelter and non-food items to IDPs in makeshift sites at Khan Younis governorate”, funded by the OPT Humanitarian fund.

The project aimed at distribution of season-appropriate bedding sets and lighting source, in addition to the provision of essential season-appropriate clothing to 520 IDP households in Khan Younis makeshift sites during the period June to November 2024.

The presentation consisted of description of the project objectives, outputs, activities, statistics, and lessons learned.
