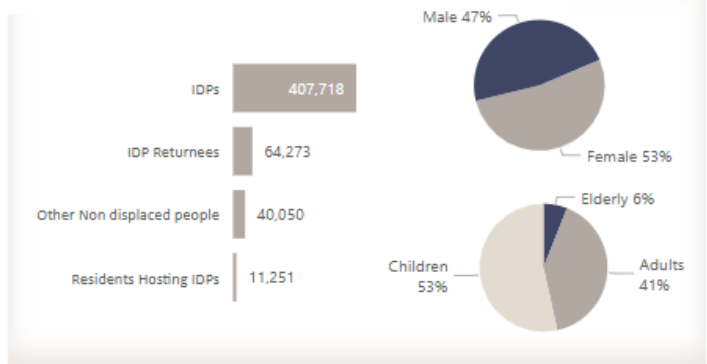

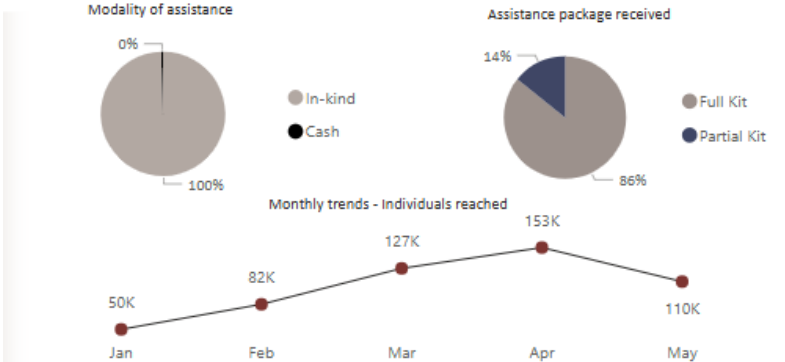

## Profile of beneficiaries (Population group & age breakdown)

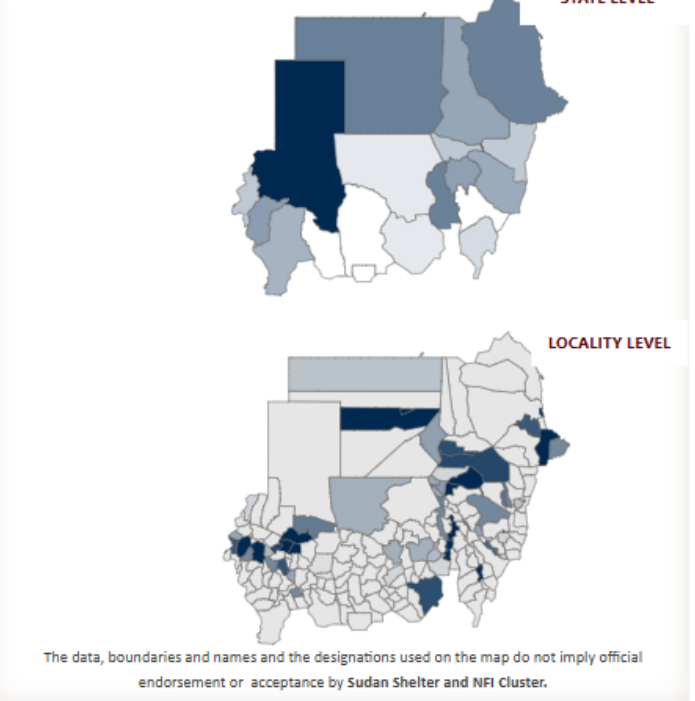

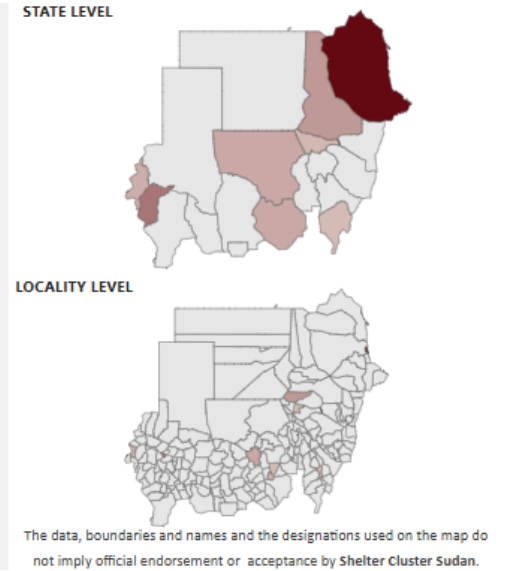

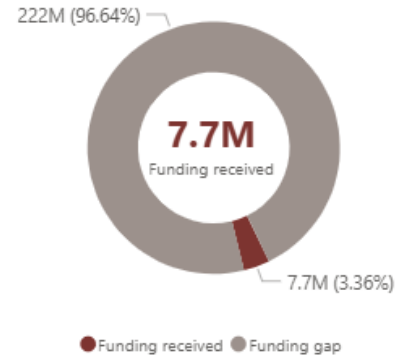

## — SITUATION UPDATES (KASSALA STATE)

### Key Needs/Highlights

- With the upcoming rainy season, where IDPs gathering sites and the host community of Kassala are prone to floods, Shelter and NFI kits will be needed. It is important to start the prepositioning.
- UNHCR estimated that over **3,000** new asylum seekers at the reception center (and others who continue to arrive in Girba) are in need of Shelter and NFIs.
- HAC, UNHCR, and the High Emergency Committee are addressing a shelter-related challenge for **76 IDP HHs** that were relocated from schools and other public institutions in Kassala town. It is agreed to coordinate between IDP returns and relocations to make good use of vacated tents.

### Response

- By June 20, 2025, UNHCR completed the distribution of **4,306** NFI kits (of **6,200 planned**).
- Of **6,200** planned NFI kits, UNHCR awaits the delivery of **1,400 NFI** from PS: 800 for IDPs at West airport GS and **600** for refugees to be relocated from Khartoum to Kassala
- From IOM, SOLD, IDP-led organization, distributed **1,000** NFI kits on 15 - 18th June in Kassala.

### Challenges

- Due to funding constraints, many Shelter and NFI Cluster members do not have items to distribute. This significantly reduced the level of staff morale, and many NGOs terminated the contracts of their staff.

## — SITUATION UPDATES (GEDAREF STATE)

### **Key Needs/Highlights**

- As per the most recent DTM, 533,899 IDPs are still in Gedaref
- Anticipated flooding due to the upcoming rainy season in IDP and refugee sites
- Rainy Season Preparedness Plan developed and shared with OCHA: Only 1.3% of the plan is currently funded for refugees and IDPs.

### **Response**

- Completed distribution of 920 ESK to IDPs relocated from schools
- Ongoing construction of 265 emergency shelters by SORR (SHF fund) in Abunaja 4 RC
- UNHCR through SORR completed distribution of 4,835 NFI kits in refugee camps
- Ongoing distribution of NFI kits to 600 HH including those relocated from Khartoum

### **Challenges**

- Severe funding gaps affecting most humanitarian actors
- Delayed approvals affecting the implementation of the SHF project

## — SITUATION UPDATES (BLUE NILE AND SENNAR STATES)

### **Key Needs/Highlights**

- Total number of IDPs in BN is 400,971 INDs - DTM.
- Influx of refugee returnees , about 30,000 INDs and more en route.
- Total number of IDPs is 99,119 INDs, and 174,346 INDs recorded as IDP returnees - DTM

### **Response**

- ACTED distributed tents and NFIs to 83 new arrivals Ethiopian refugee HHs.
- CAFA distributed 3000 NFIs kits to refugee returnees at two gathering sites.
- CAFA planning to pitch 450 tent for refugee returnees.
- Human appeal planning to distribute 1000 NFI kits to RR - funded by IOM

### **Challenges**

- Insufficient resources to accommodate the large influx of returnees in Blue Nile State, particularly with regard to shelter provision.
- Inability to extend humanitarian assistance to Sennar State due to constrained resources and a lack of operational partners
- The impending rainy season is expected to significantly worsen the humanitarian situation.

## — SITUATION UPDATES (NORTH, SOUTH AND WEST KORDOFAN STATES)

### **Key Needs/Highlights**

- The influx of IDPs in North Kordofan continues to arrive Sheikan locality and Bara from W&N Kordofan due to the ongoing conflict.
- New IDPs in SKS eastern corridor is ongoing a number of IDPs being arrived at Abu Jubaiha from Different localities due to the conflict between SPLM&RSP and SAF.

### **Response**

- UNHCR through IAS/LM has distributed 2500 NFI kits in SKS respectively to Abu Jubaiha 1000 HHs, Al Rashad 1000 HHs and Al Abbasiya 500 HHs for the IDPs.
- UNHCR through IAS/LM has distributed 1500 NFI kits in El Obied NKS for the new IDPs.
- SCI has distributed 1,220 NFI kits for the IDPs in Abu Jubaiha and El Rashad SKS for the IDPs.

### **Challenges**

- Rainy season approaches with high demand for the NFIs and Shelter, especially for the IDP who has poor shelter and the new IDPs with very low cluster capacity in the Kordofan region.

## — SITUATION UPDATES (NORTH DARFUR STATE)

### **Key Needs/Highlights**

- El Fasher is still under siege, with no access, and the IDPs escaped on foot for a number of days to reach Tawila, approximately 80 KM from El Fasher.
- The continuous arrival of the IDPs in Tawila from El Fasher, and then some of the IDPs departed to the other locations in Darfur.
- Milit and Al Malha received a considerable number of IDPs from the triangle borders due to the ongoing conflicts.

### **Response**

- ARC has 1,310 Emergency Shelter kits currently being distributed in Tawila for the new IDPs, with kits provided by IOM.
- DOFDAR has a planned distribution of 1,500 Emergency Shelter kits in three localities, each locality will receive 500 shelter kits from IOM.
- UNHCR has planned 3,500 NFI kits for El Fasher through the organized convoy from OCHA and 1,000 Family tents for Tawila, plus 600 NFI kits for Dar El Salam.
- SCI has a plan for 500 emergency shelter kits to support new IDPs in Tawila.

### **Challenges**

- The need for shelter and NFIs in NDS is huge, especially for new IDPs in Tawila.

## — SITUATION UPDATES (WEST AND CENTRAL DARFUR STATES)

### **Key Needs/Highlights**

- The new arrival of the IDPs from ND in Daba Naira CD continued on a daily basis.
- The IDPs arrived in March and April 2025 from ND to Daba Naira CD needs to be relocated from their current residence due to the approaching rainy season, as their current location is prone to floods.
- Nertiti CD also received some IDPs from Zam Zam camp and are in need of Shelter and NFI support.

### **Response**

- UNHCR through SORR has distributed 1,250 NFI kits for the new IDPs in Daba Naira.
- SCI has 450 shelter kits in Golo and 1,150 NFI kits in Daba Naira for the IDPs in CD.
- UNHCR has a plan for 1,250 NFI kits for the IDPs in Geneina WD.

### **Challenges**

- Rainy season is approaching, and NFIs are a crucial need during the rainy season because the IDPs are often living in inadequate shelters.

## — SITUATION UPDATES (SOUTH DARFUR STATE)

### **Key Needs/Highlights**

- The IDPs continued to arrive in SD from El Fasher and different states of Sudan due to the ongoing conflicts, and living with the old IDPs and with the residents in different locations in Nyala and other localities of SD.

### **Response**

- UNHCR through SORR has a plan to distribute 1,250 NFI kits in Nyala Jonoub and another 800 HHs, while in Geraida 450 HHs are focused on new IDPs.

### **Challenges**

- The shelter and NFIs needs are huge, especially as it coincides with the rainy season for the IDPs who live in the gather sites.

## — SITUATION UPDATES (EAST DARFUR STATE)

### **Key Needs/Highlights**

- Khazan Jadeed is the reception center for the IDPs who are coming from different states to ED during the last month in Khazan Jadeed witnessed about 15,000 individuals of the IDPs arrive from Zam Zam camp, and 2,200 HHs are coming from different parts of Sudan.
- Ed Deain is also witnessed a large number of IDPs arriving from different parts of Sudan.

### **Response**

- UNHCR through WV has a plan to distribute 946 NFI kits in Khazan Jadeed and 1,500 plastic sheets to the new IDPs in Shea'aria locality.
- UNHCR through WV has distributed 1,000 NFI kits for the IDPs in El Firdous locality.
- UNHCR through WV has a plan to distribute 1,000 NFI kits for the IDPs in Cairo IDPs camp Ed Deain locality.

### **Challenges**

- Shelter and NFIs are needed with huge gaps in ED.

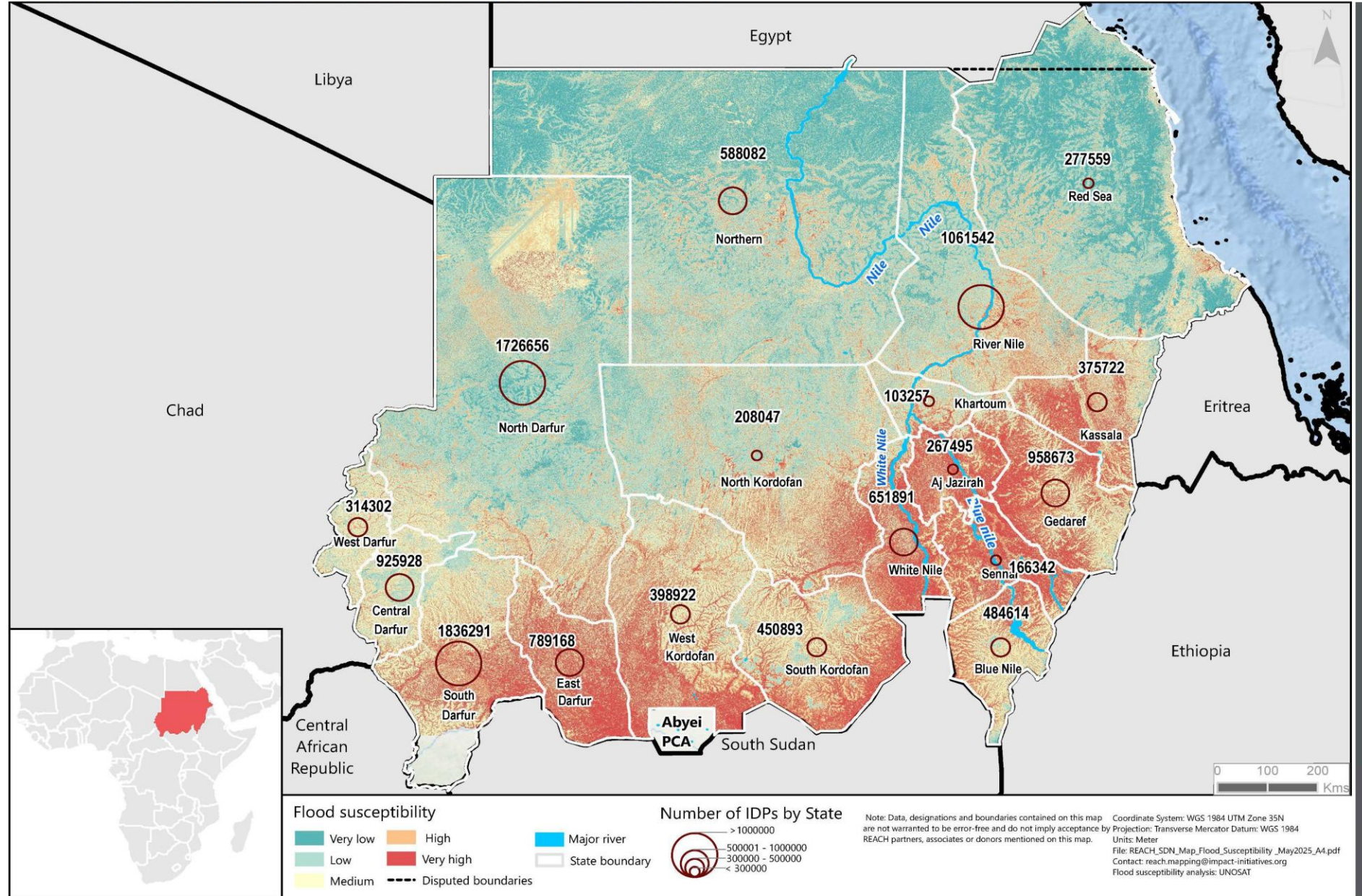

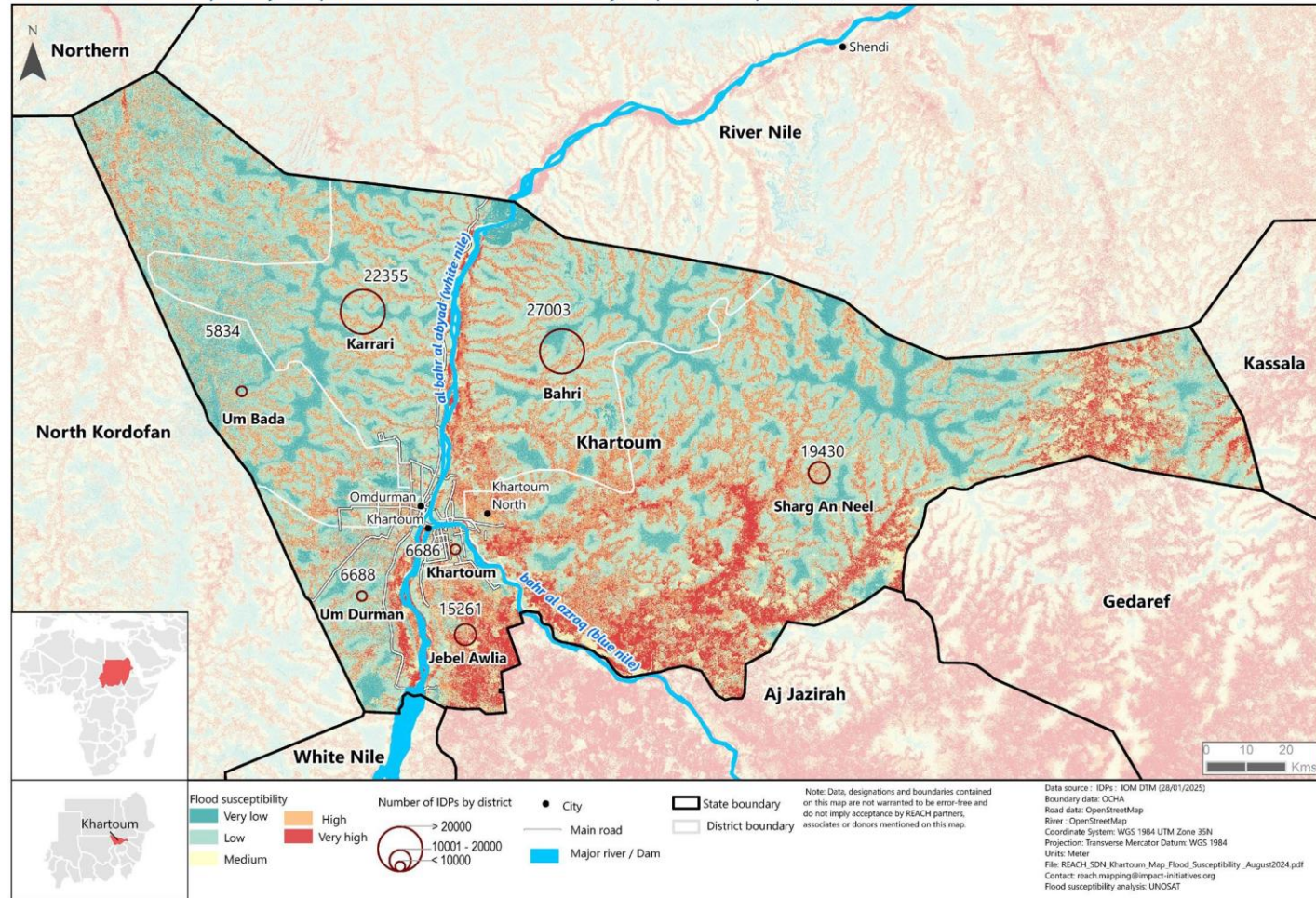

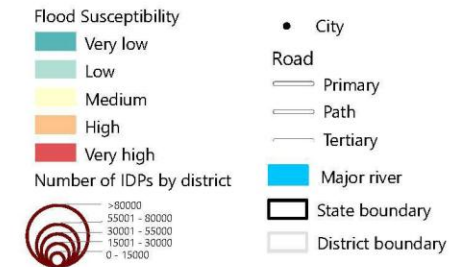
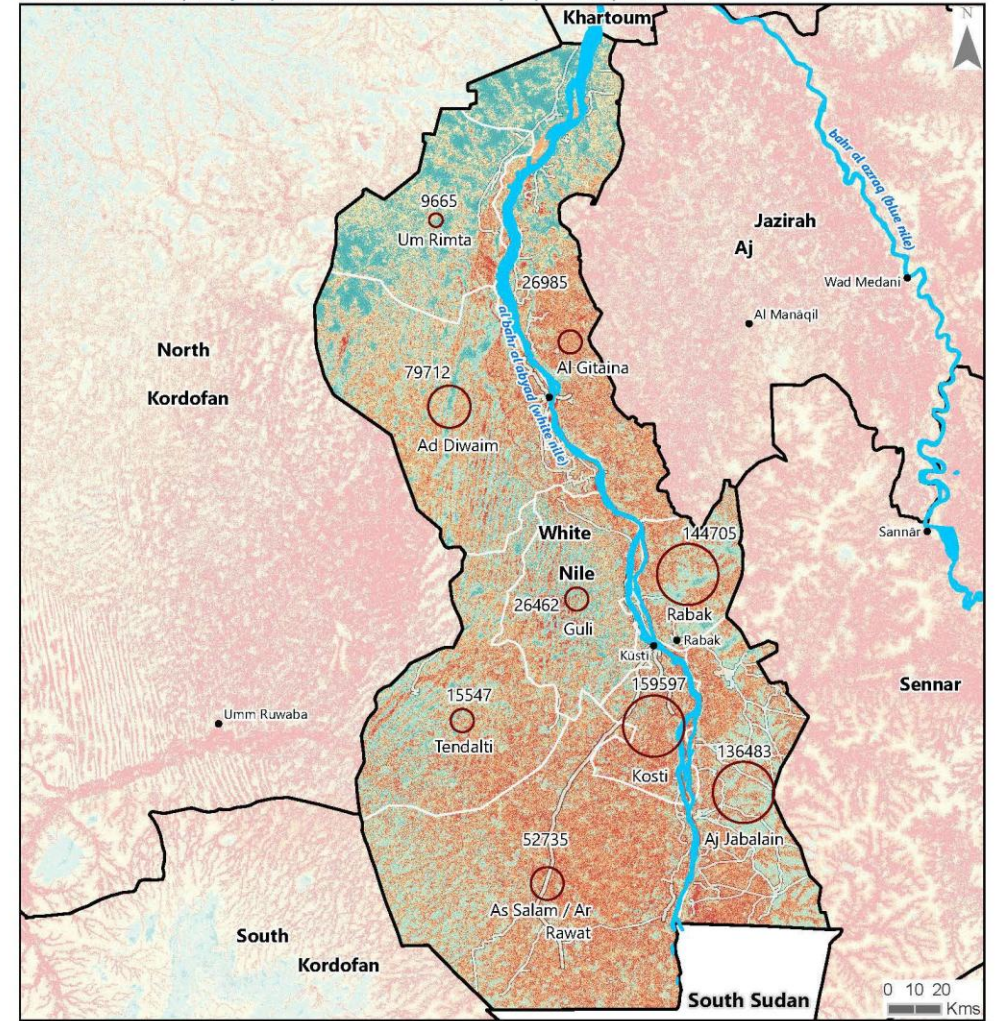
Khartoum State: # IDPs per locality

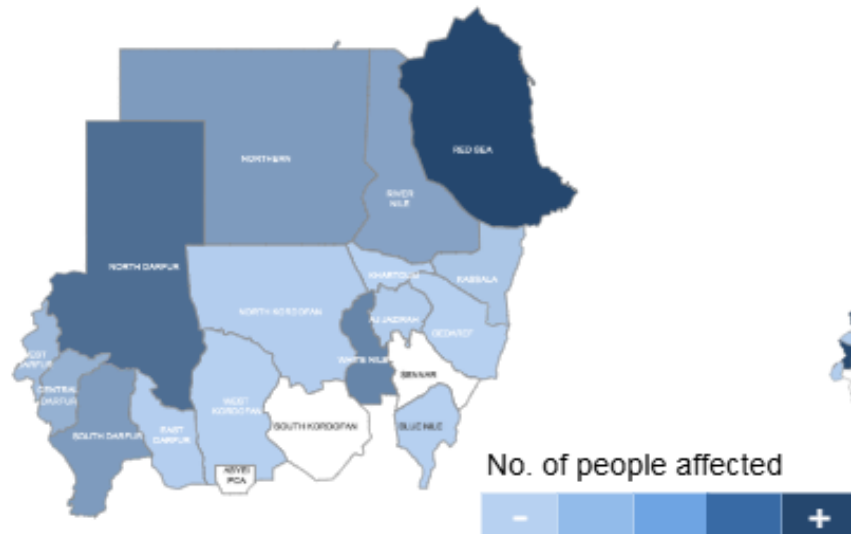

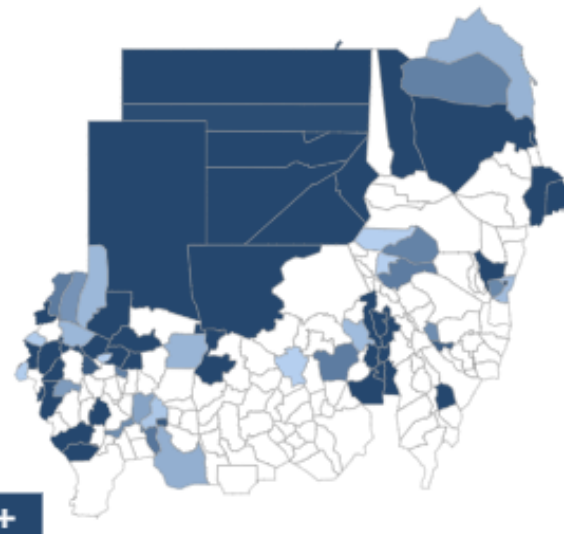

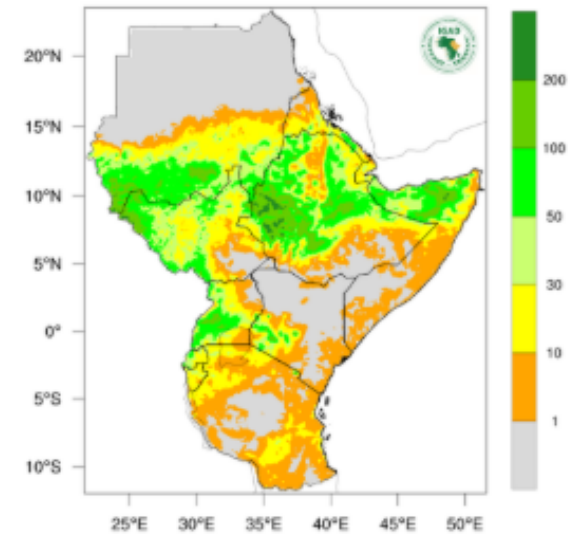
People affected per state

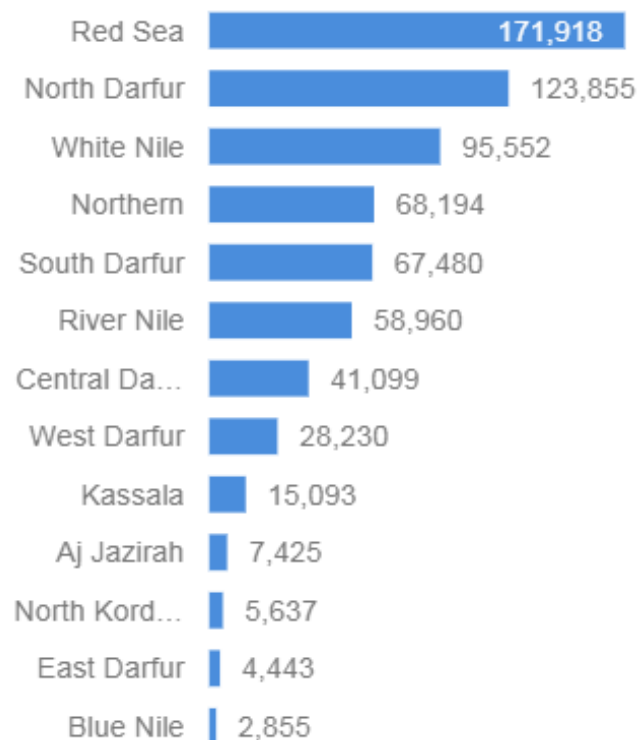

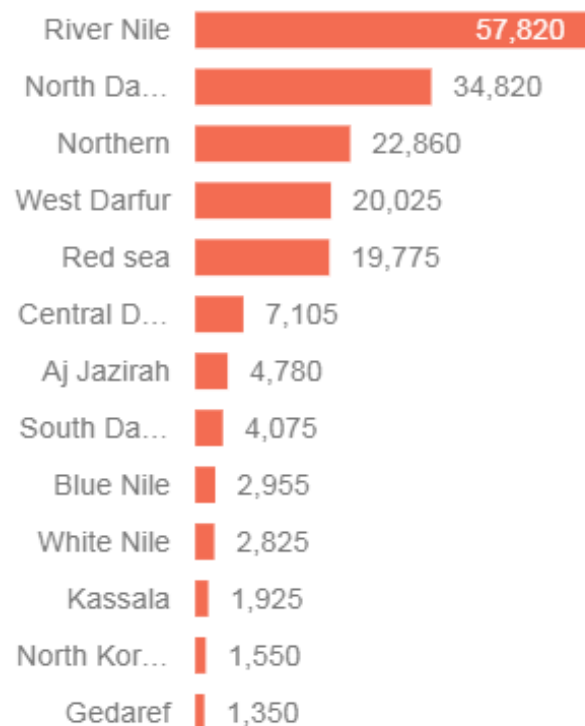

People displaced per state | locality

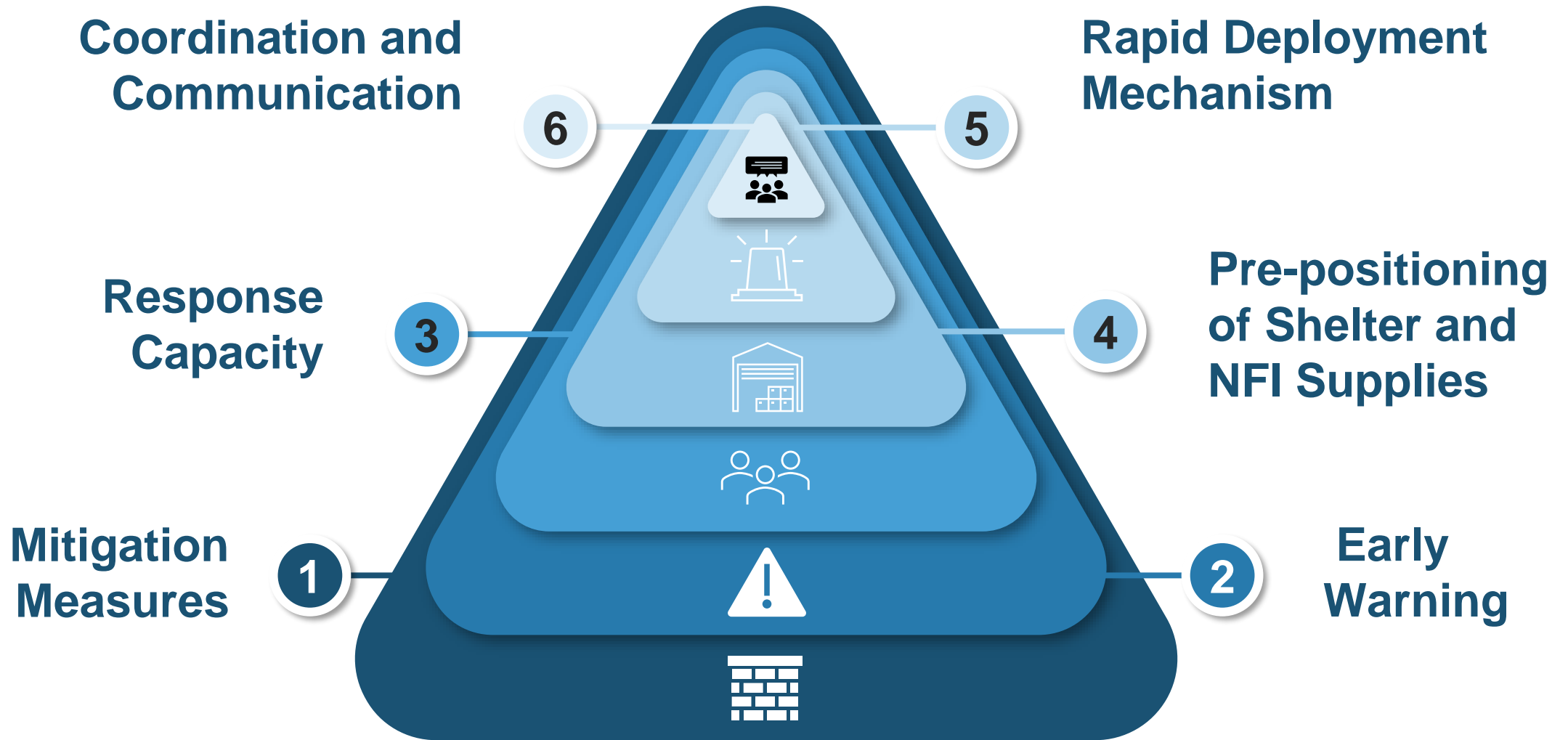
