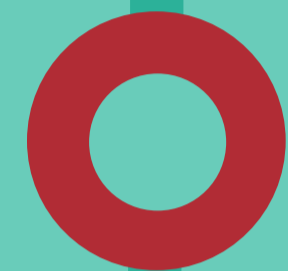

## Military Coup effects on SNFI operations

- SNFI activities delayed but the sector in general not as disrupted as some of the other's that rely on national systems
- Shelter cash assistance affected due to lack of bank liquidity
- Increase in fuel prices and restriction movements led to price hikes of certain construction materials, due to increase in transportation costs



## Port Sudan closure effects on NFI supply chain

- Low supplies of certain items such as blankets and mosquito nets
- WFP/ UNHCR exploring the Egypt route
- Port opened for the month of November, however NFIs still not released due to large backlog



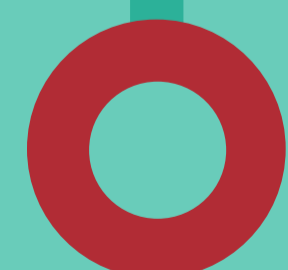
## Renewed inter-communal conflict in Jebel Moon - West Darfur

- Renewed intercommunal conflict erupted in Jebel Moon locality on 17 November 2021 between Misseriya Jebel and nomadic Arab tribes
- At least 4,200 displaced, plus many casualties and injuries, destruction of villages, harvested food stocks, livestock and other livelihood assets
- Inter-agency assessment is planned for as soon as security situation allows - tentative dates for this assessment are 28 November and 1 December



## Flooding in Al Salam - White Nile, due to Jebel Aulia Dam filling

- Three out of the seven camps on the western banks of the White Nile have been affected by the routine filling of the Jabel Aulia Dam
- Over 1,000 people displaced - shelters have been destroyed and road access cut which is affecting the delivery of food and humanitarian assistance



## Ethiopia emergency preparedness efforts

- Babikri camp under development - capacity 20,000 for mixed ethnic groups i.e. Qementis, while Fau 5 was deemed not suitable
- Additional camp capacity - Village 6 in Blue Nile as well as in Shagrab, Kassala for Eritrean refugees
- Gedaref - 8,000 NFI kits prepositioned, 10,000 tents airlifted

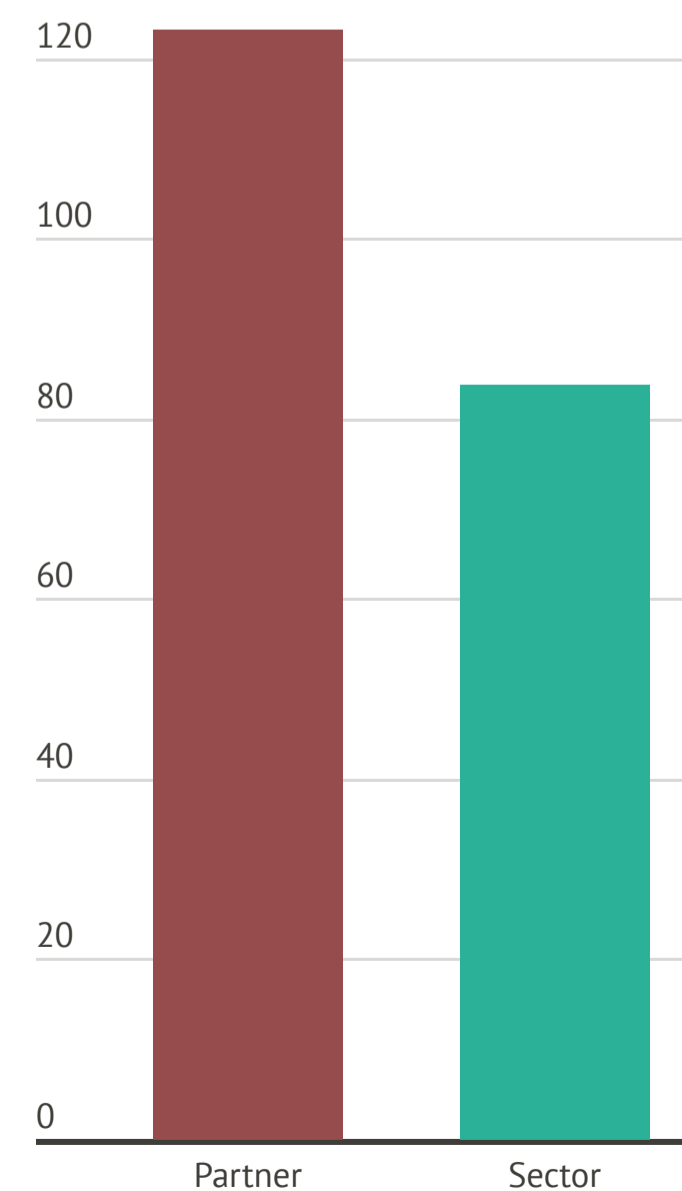

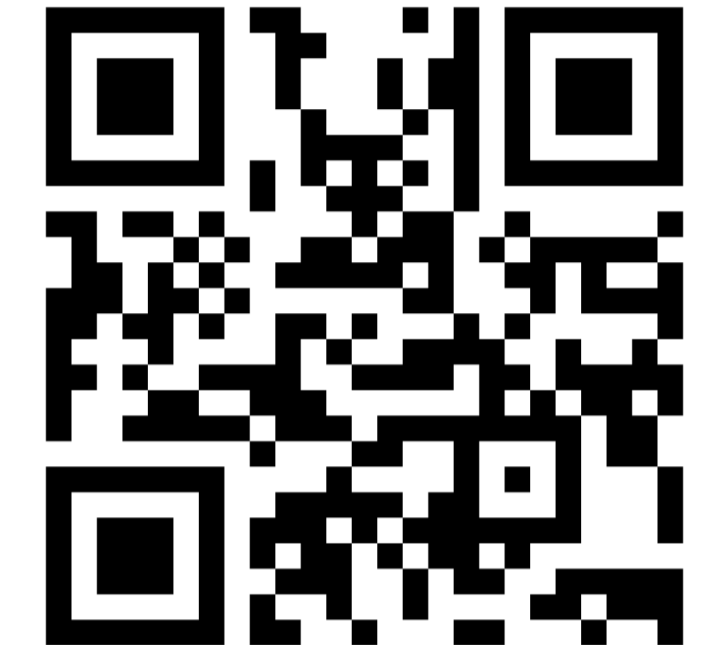

## ToR - Terms of Reference

Share the burden of coordinating cluster processes, including planning, analysis and reporting

Enhance NGO engagement as well as strengthen linkages with field locations and sub-national FP coordination

Expected to contribute resources (human and financial) to support cluster coordination and activities

MoU will be established between the Cluster Lead Agency and the Co-Chair NGO

Co-Chair will be selected transparently by other cluster members

Co-Chair has to commit to fulfil the responsibilities of the role

## Selection Criteria

Engagement in the cluster meetings and cluster activities so far - attendance, response to request for information, etc.

Capacity to second staff to the cluster as well as allocate budget to fund cluster activities

Comparative advantages in access and coverage of the response

Past experience as a chair/co-chair in conflict contexts

### ToR - Terms of Reference

Guide the cluster, in a consultative and collaborative manner, with policy decisions, strategic direction and coordination mechanisms

2/3 UN Agencies, 2/3 International NGOs, 2/3 National NGOs - depending on interest

Meetings will be held on a need only basis, or quarterly at minimum

Meetings may be called by the Cluster Coordinator, Co-chair or at the request of a SAG member, as appropriate

Observers of the SAG shall include other Cluster Coordinators, donor representatives, OCHA, etc.

SAG Co-chair members can be rotational by agreement of all SAG members and on a rotational basis not exceeding 6 months

### Selection Criteria

Engagement in the cluster meetings and cluster activities so far - attendance, response to request for information, etc.

Members of the SAG should be willing to champion specific activities due to their specific knowledge, experience and interest

Members of the SAG would be required to actively participate in 80% of the meetings held during the year for them to retain their place for the following year

# Coordination Arrangements

Technical Working Group (TWiG)

## ToR - Terms of Reference

Established/ ToR provided by SAG to work on technical designs, guidelines and standards as well as ensure compliance

Chaired by the Technical Coordinator

Thematic with limited life-span since they disband once the outputs defined in the TORs have been achieved

Suggested group size: 12-15 members

Ideally should be a bottom up approach with field based TWiGs feeding the national level ones

## Selection Criteria

Engagement in the cluster meetings and cluster activities so far - attendance, response to request for information, etc.

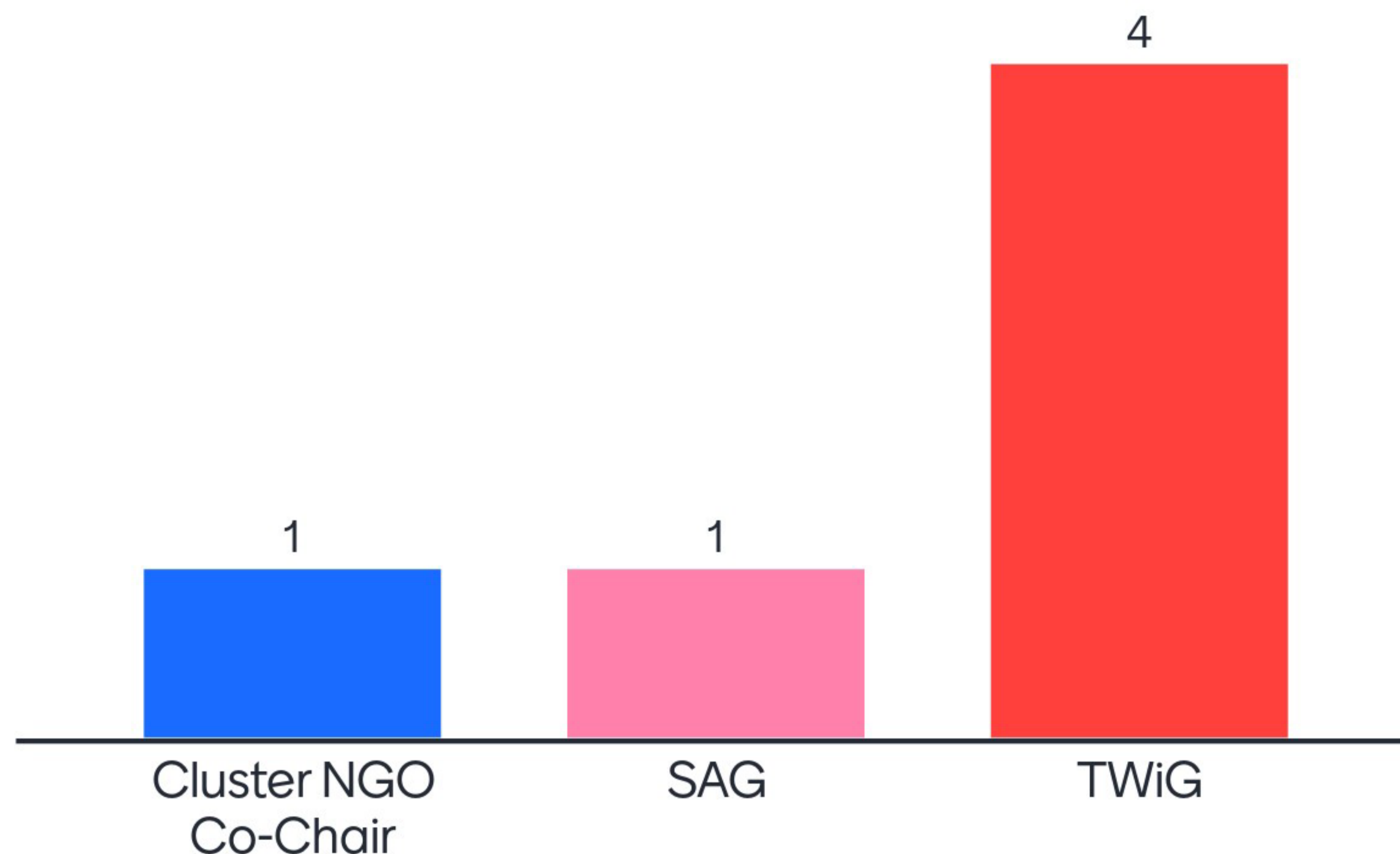

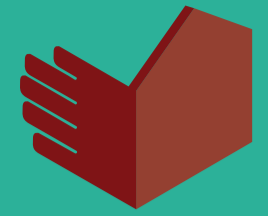
