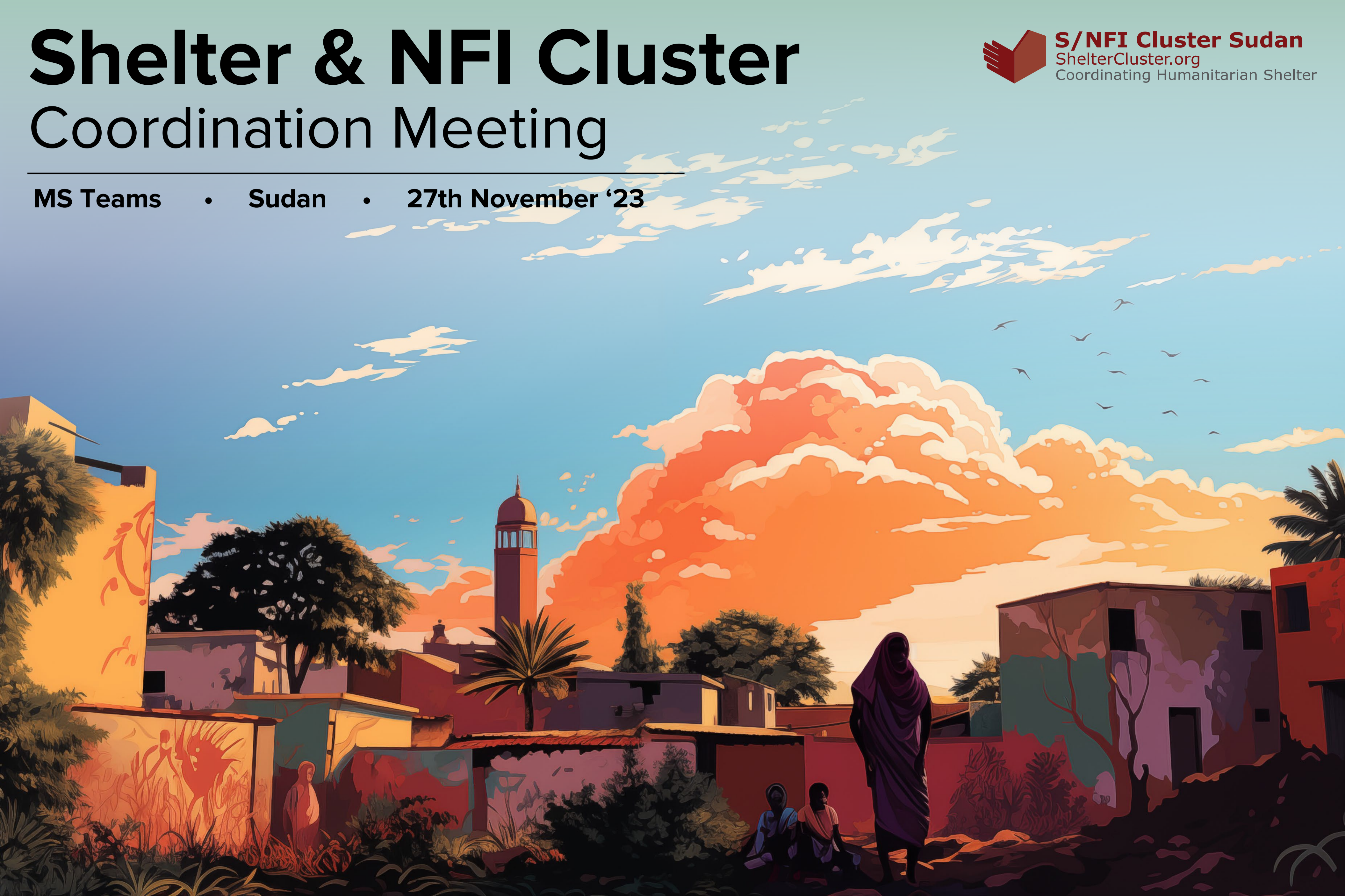

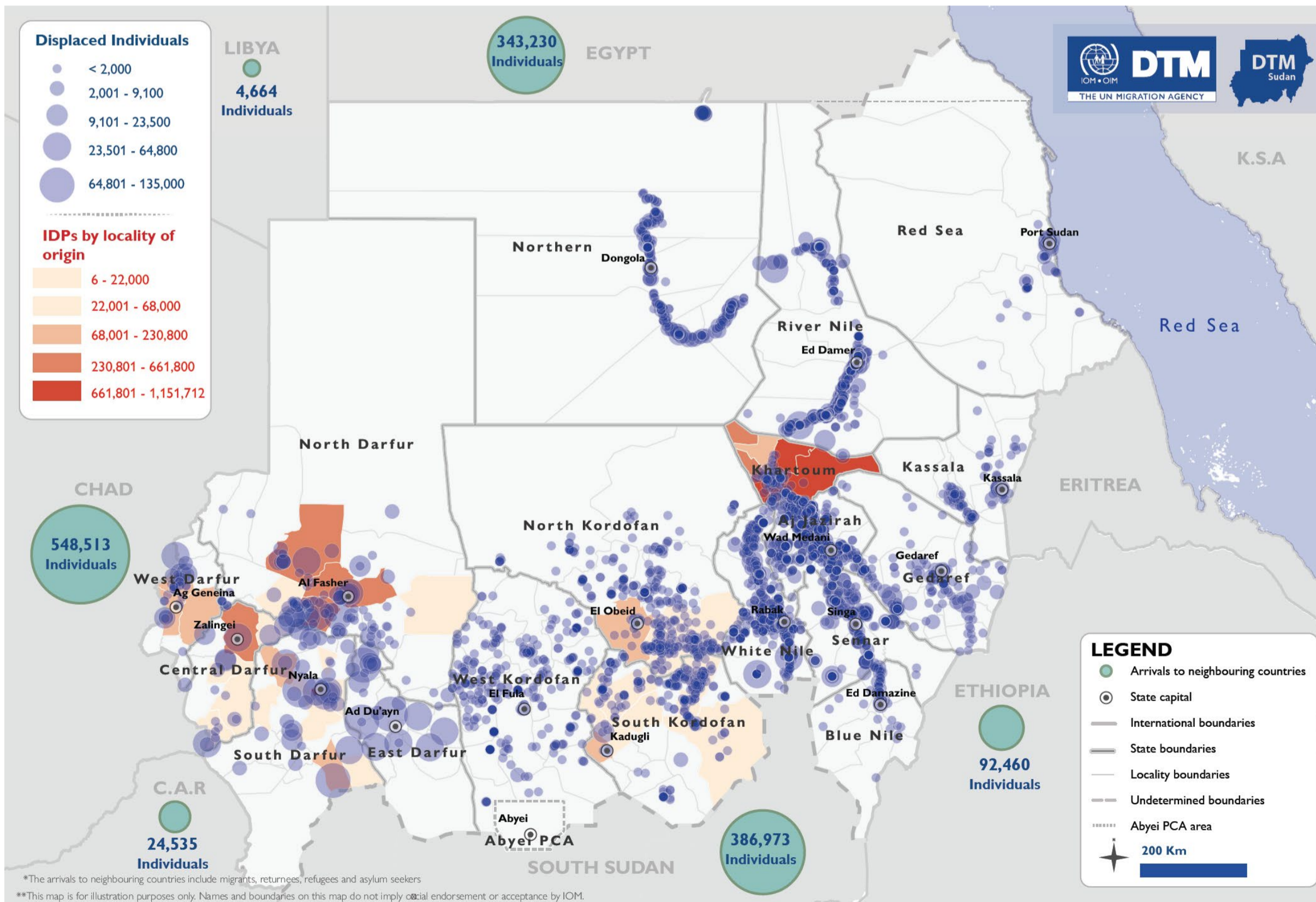

General Updates



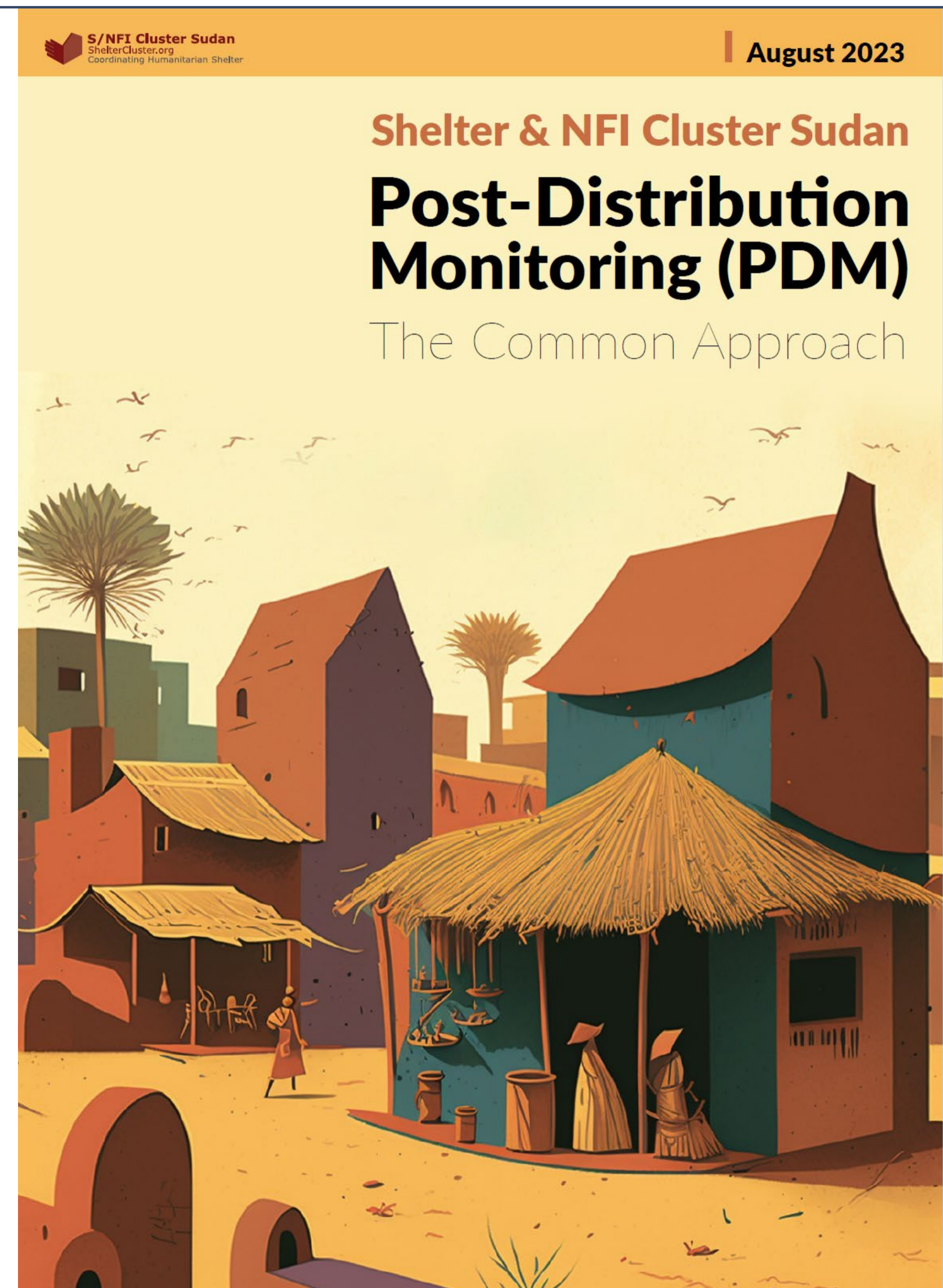
- **Seven and half months** into the SAF-RSF conflict, **6.5 million people** have been forced to flee their homes, continuing the same upward trend.
- Out of those, the estimated number of IDPs across Sudan is **5.1 million**. The current assessment has observed the IDP caseload in all of Sudan's 18 states. The highest proportions of IDPs have been observed in **South Darfur (12.28%)**, **River Nile (11.99%)**, **East Darfur (10.59%)**, **White Nile (8.32%)**, **North Darfur (8.31%)** and **Northern (7.09%)**.
- While over **1.4 million** people have crossed into **neighbouring countries**.

Common PDM Tool

- This document takes a **two-fold approach** to systematizing Post Distribution Monitoring (PDM) in the Shelter and NFI Cluster in Sudan.
- Firstly, it presents a **standardized framework** and emphasizes benefits of utilizing **shared digital tools** to consolidate PDM efforts at cluster level and unlock the potential for **collective learning**.
- Secondly, it offers **technical advice** and **practical guidance** for successfully **conducting PDM exercises** across the five key stages of the process.
- The **preliminary feedback** was integrated before April 15, followed by **a second round** in August to accommodate the post-conflict shifts in the operational environment. Your **ongoing input is invaluable**, and we will periodically refine the tool accordingly.
- We are excited to debut the **dashboard** today, enabling instantaneous analysis of **over 2,000 records** currently in our database.

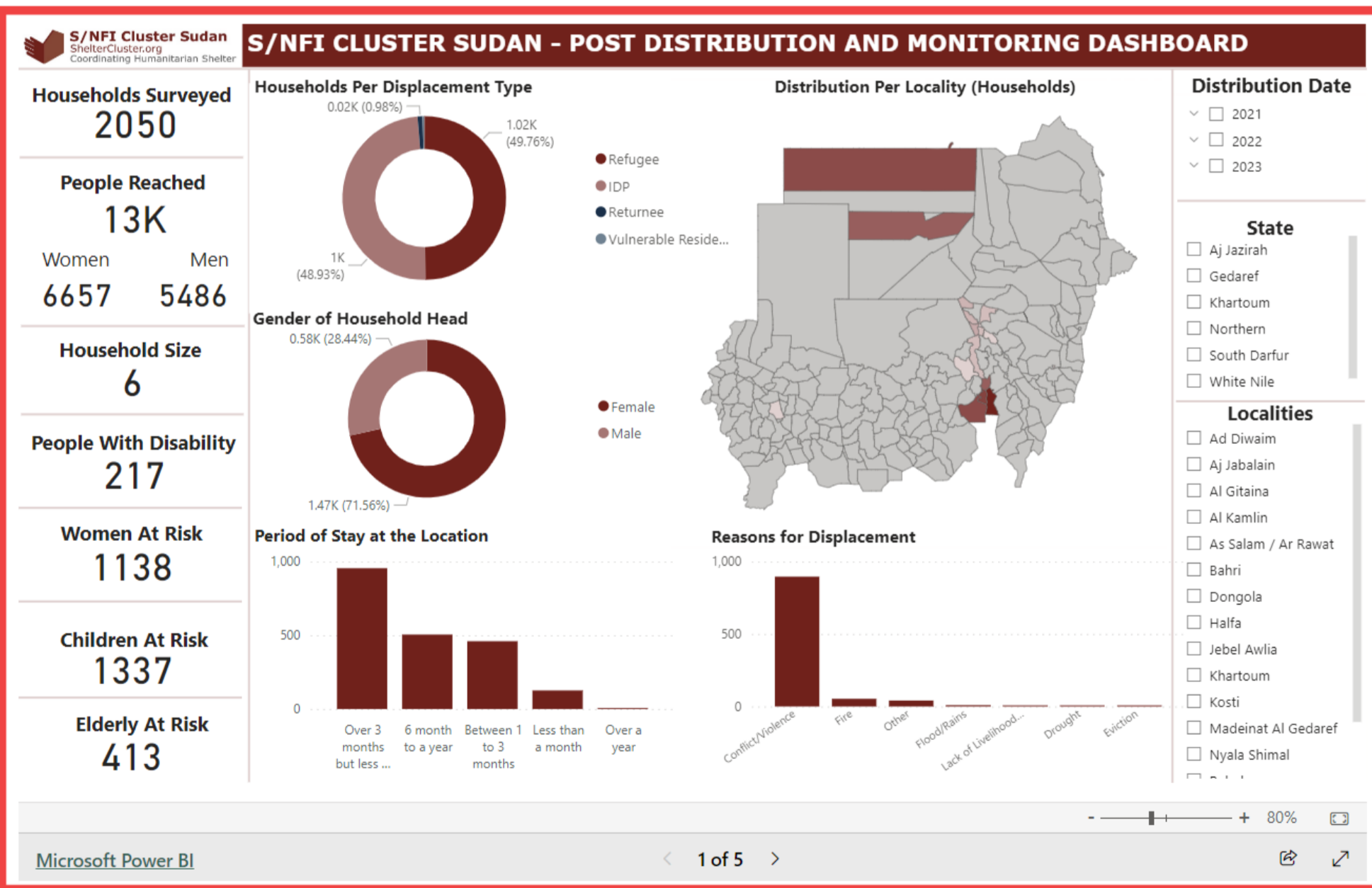

Service Mapping for Digital Information Service

Internews – 27 November 2023



Internews, Signpost, and NRC are teaming up to launch an **information service via social media and digital channels** with the aim of responding to the information needs of people affected by conflict and displacement in Sudan, and for IDPs and refugees on the move and along borders.

With few official channels of information available, people affected by the current conflict have been turning to social media for **peer support and to access critical information needs**. The limited online AAP channels have impacted trust and contributed to an increase in the spread of online misinformation.

About Signpost

Signpost is a community-centered information service aiming to empower users in crisis situations. It delivers life-saving and critical information via digital platforms and social media – equipping affected people with time-sensitive and actionable information "to make critical decisions on the issues that matter most to them."

Actionable & demand-driven information

Every local Signpost program is context-specific and designed to meet users where they are on the digital channels they already use in the languages they speak. Vital Information in times of crisis must be hyper-localized to reflect the lived realities and needs of clients. Projects offer two main forms of information products.

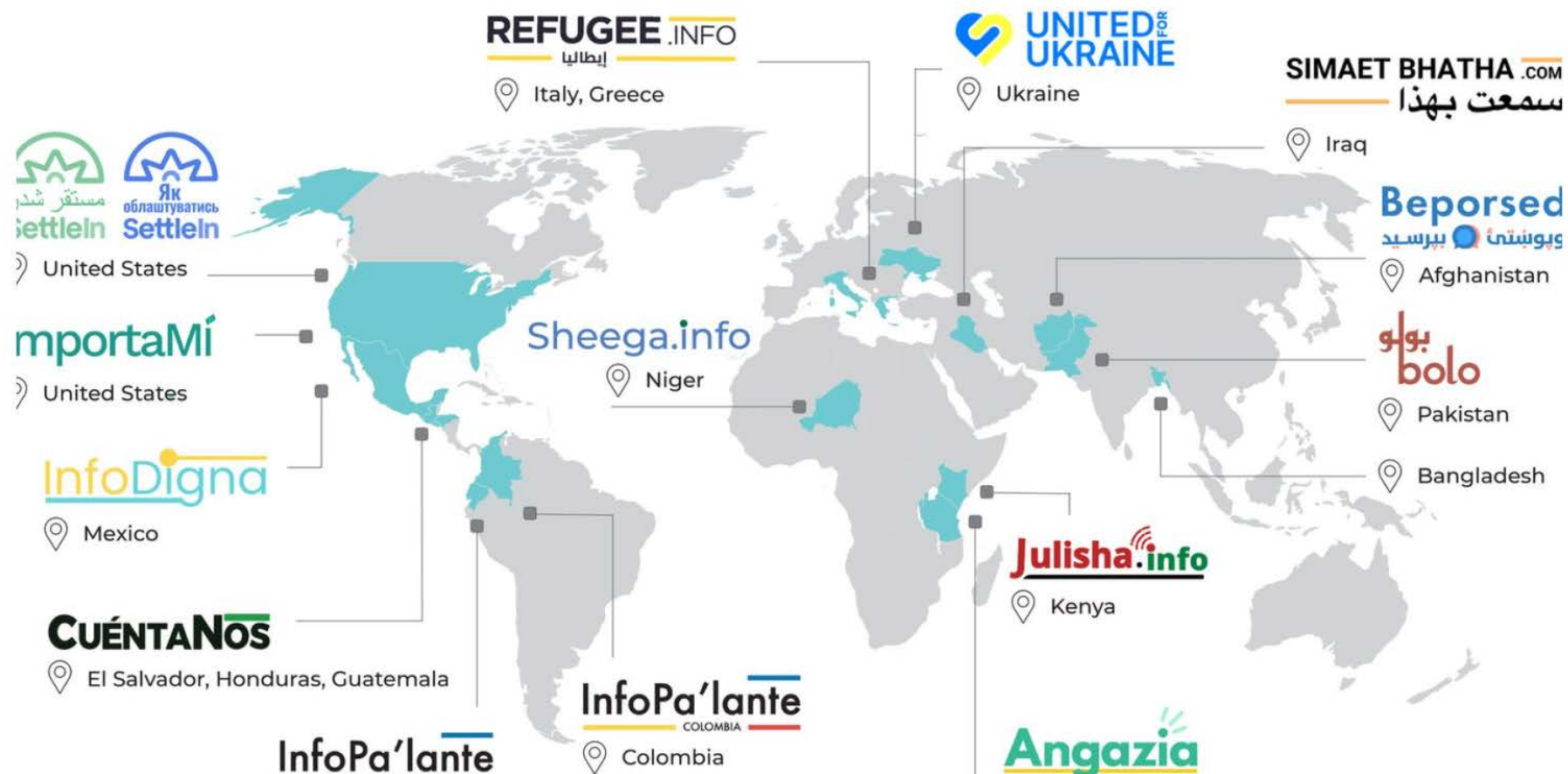


Regularly updated **articles, infographics, videos**, and other forms of **informational media** which speak to the the concerns of clients. Clients can send messages to a Community Liaison for direct support. *"Can I apply for refugee status in [country]?"*

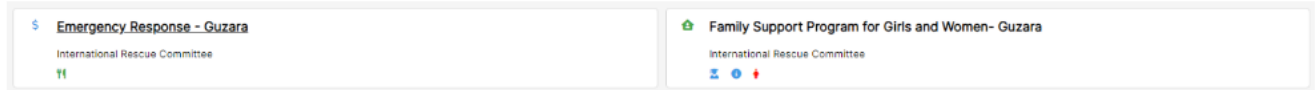


A **map of critical services** local to the user, complete with opening hours and contact information of providers. Services mapped range from health clinics to temporary shelter accommodation.

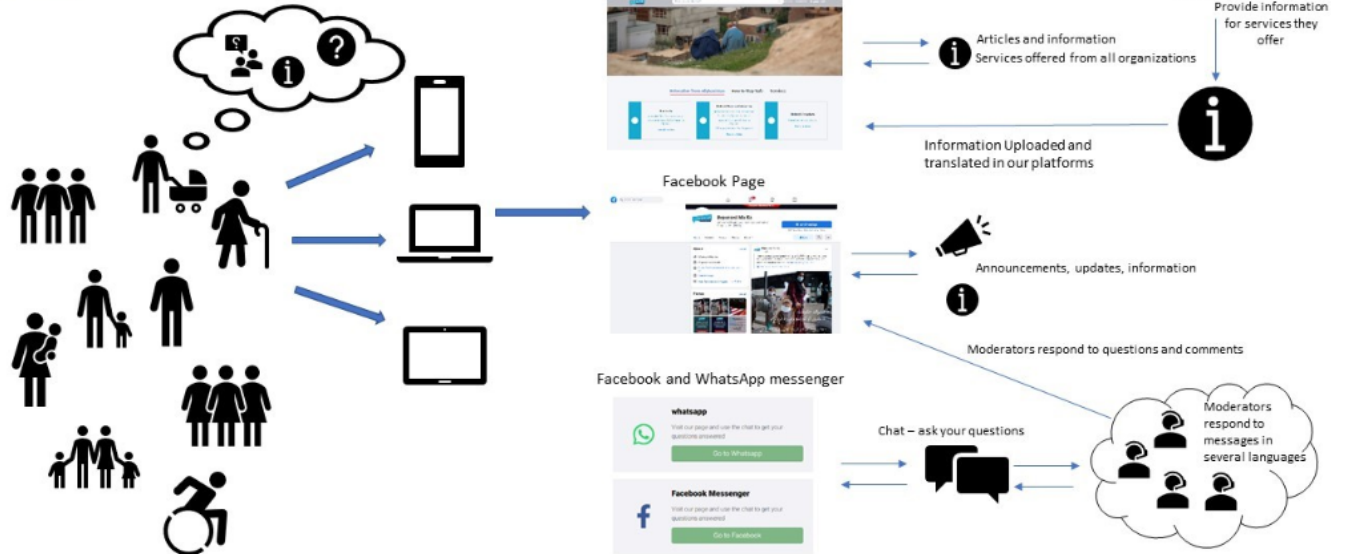

Roundtable on Achievements & Operational Plans

Objective: Ensure that our collective response efforts are well communicated to partners, donors, media and general audiences!

- **Achievements** – type of interventions, HH reached, locations, timeframe, etc.
 - **Challenges** – looting of supplies, access challenges, etc.
 - **Procurement** – quantities of stocks arriving to the country, type of stocks, timeframe, where will the stocks be prepositioned – particularly given the incoming flood season.
 - **Assessments** – e.g., needs assessments outlining specifics with respect to Shelter and NFI needs as well as market assessments on NFIs, shelter materials, or Cash for Rent.
 - **Context and impact** of interventions – e.g., any successes with respect to cash for rent, how is sustainability achieved, what about tenure security?
 - **Interventions in the host community** – with 65% of the population staying in host community – what has been achieved so far? Cash for shelter for the families hosting IDPs can be an option, or preselecting landlords to improve their housing in order for them to subsidize rent for IDPs – this can include negotiating longer-term tenure security.

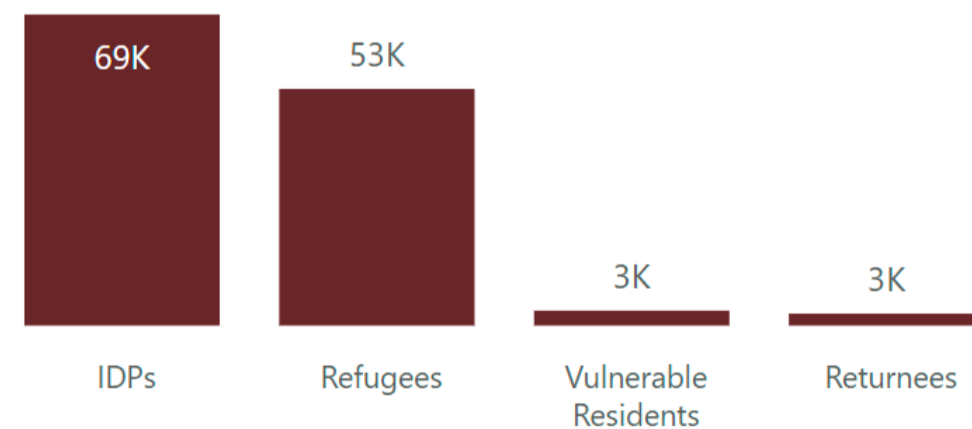

Household Reached by Response Type



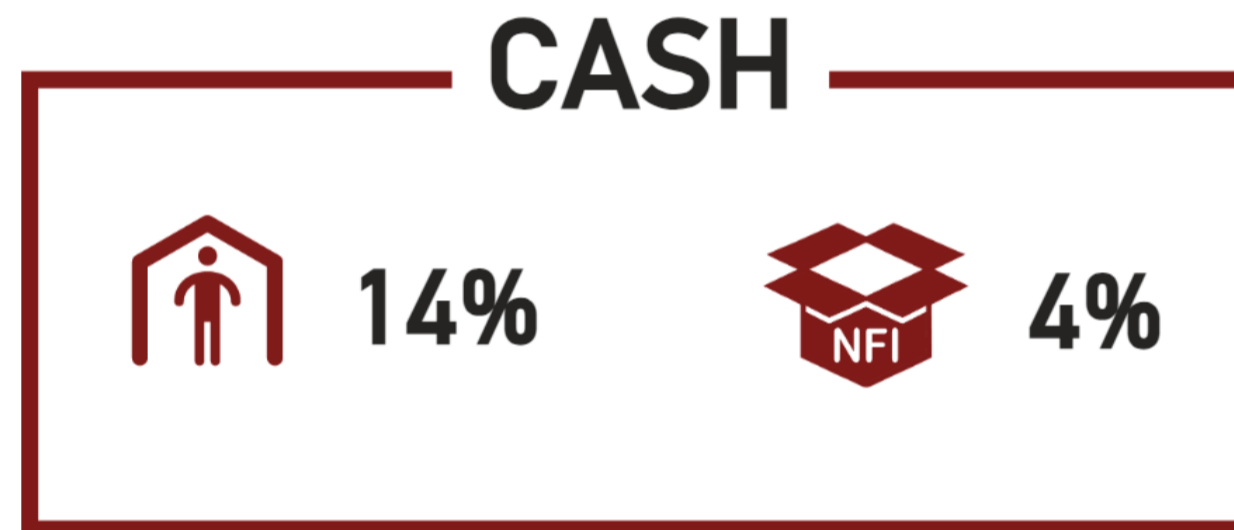
Sum of Households Reached by Population Type



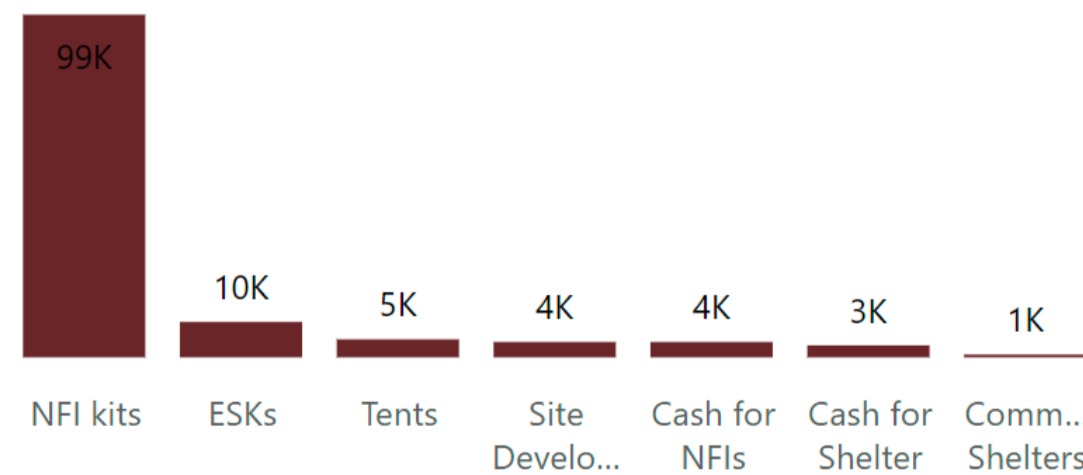

Out of which **62%** with partial assistance

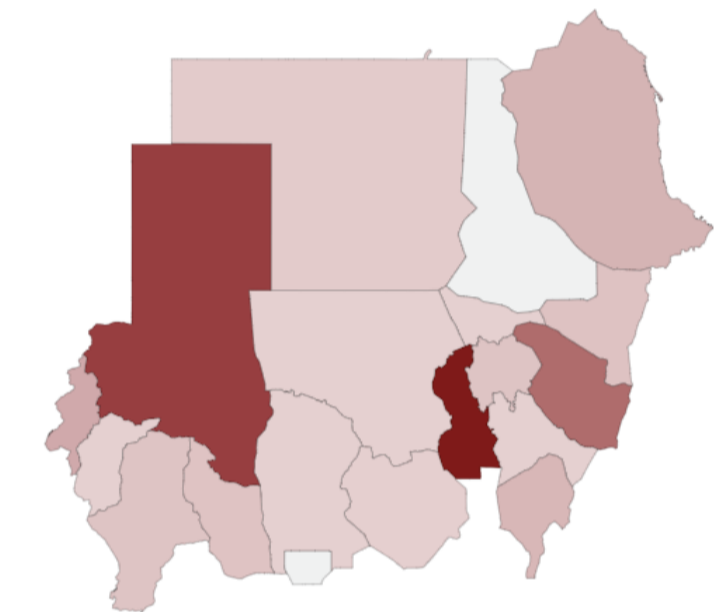


Sum of Households Reached by Indicator



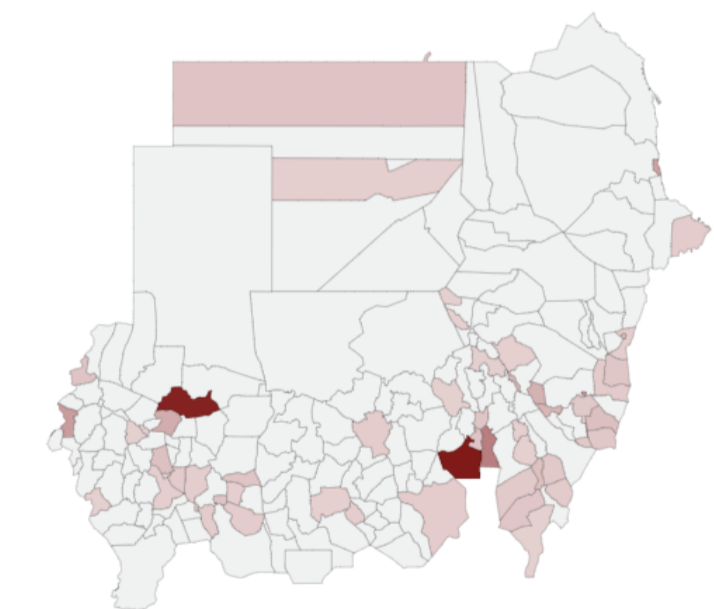

Household Reached by State

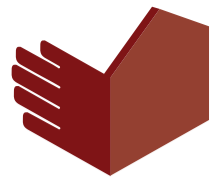


Locality:
