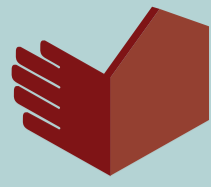

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# General Updates

Monthly Displacement Timeline

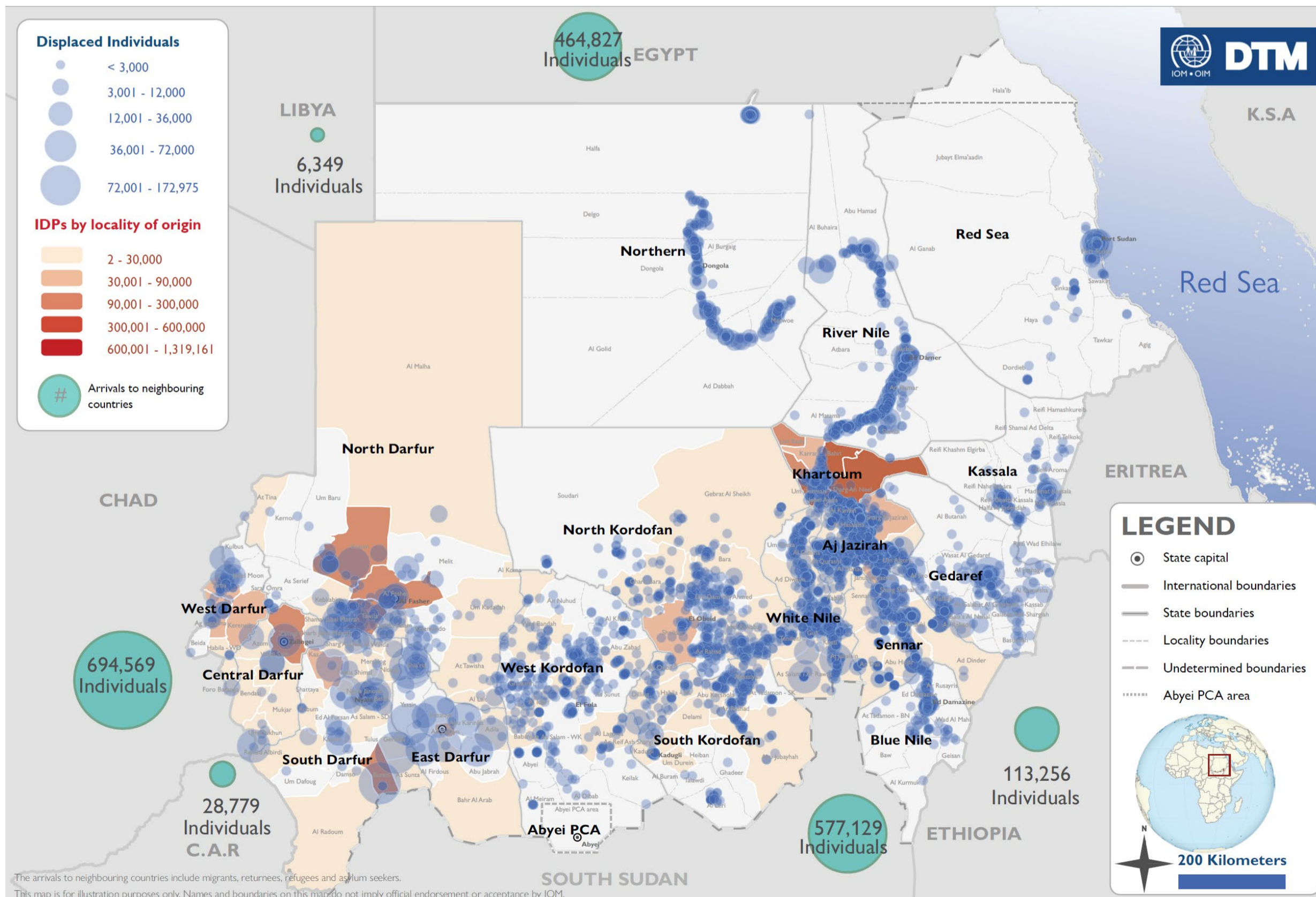

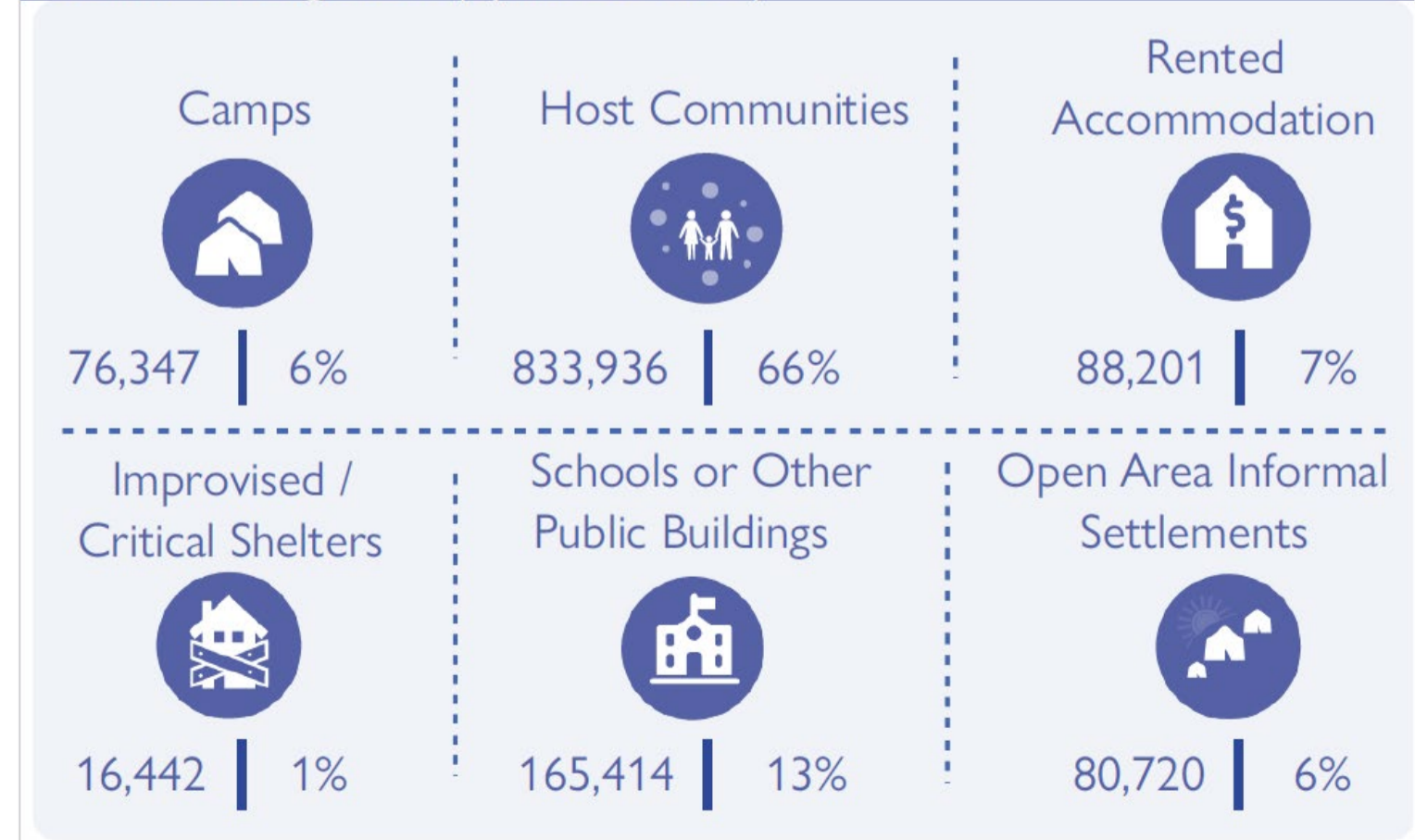

- **Ten and a half months** into the SAF-RSF conflict, **8.2 million people** have been forced to flee their homes, continuing the same upward trend.
- Out of those, the estimated number of IDPs across Sudan is **6.3 million**. The current assessment has observed the IDP caseload in all of Sudan's 18 states. The highest proportions of IDPs have been observed in **South Darfur (12%), River Nile (11%), East Darfur (10%), White Nile (8%), North Darfur (7%), Central Darfur (7%), Sennar (7%), Northern (6%), Gedaref (6%), Aj Jazirah (5%), Red Sea (4%),** and **Kassala (3%),**
- While over **1.9 million** people have crossed into **neighbouring countries**.

## \$65 M of pooled fund allocations for addressing Food Insecurity across Darfur and Kordofan regions:

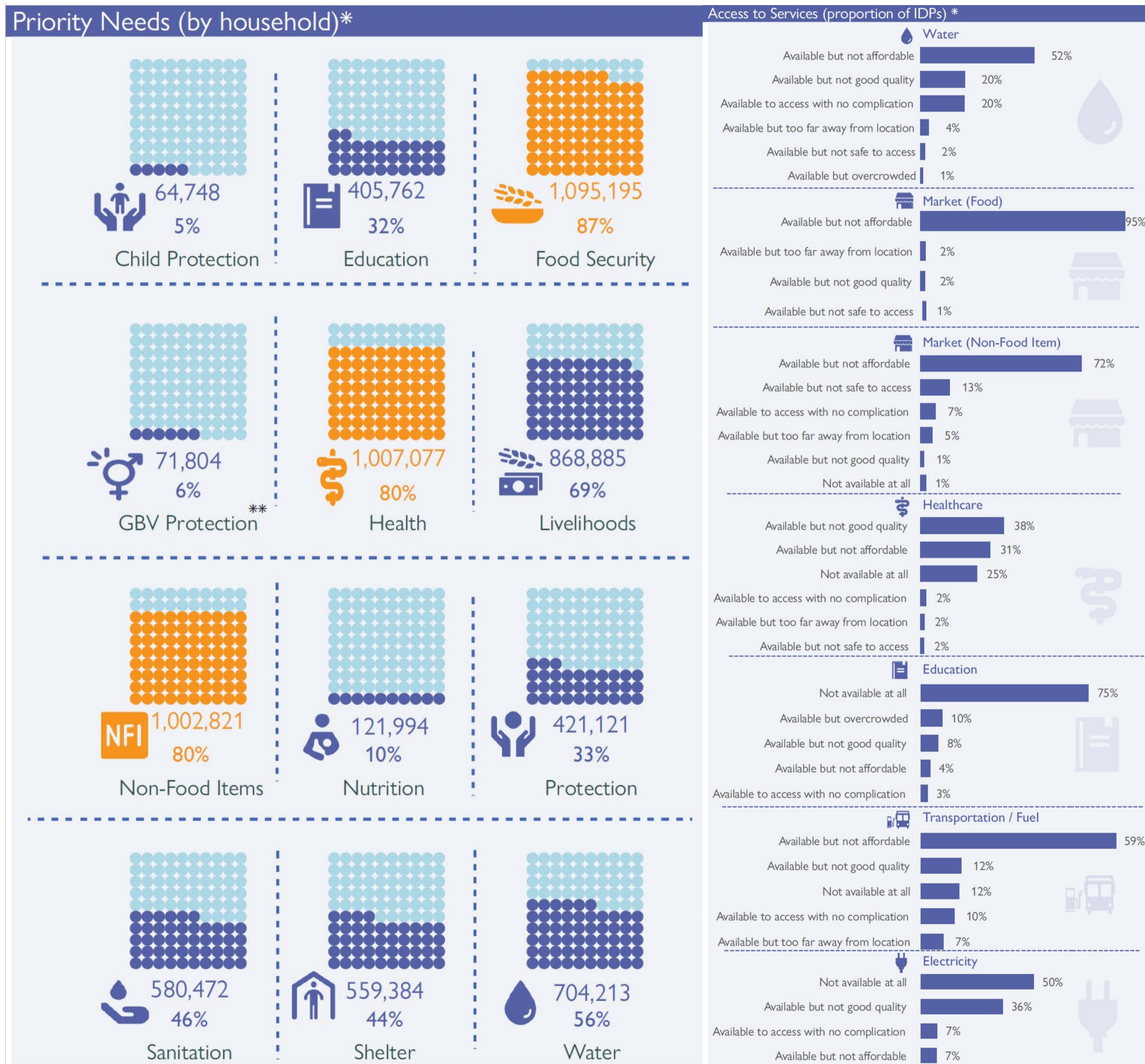
- **Rapid Response CERF:** \$15 million for WFP and UNICEF (food and nutrition supplies).
- **SHF Allocation:** \$30 million for NGOs (logistics, agricultural inputs, cattle vaccination).
- **Under-Funded Emergencies CERF:** \$20 million pending (broad food insecurity response, including Protection efforts, and all other sectors enabling the food response).

## Critical Role of Shelter/NFI in Food Security:

**High Demand for NFIs:** Only 7% less than food, underscoring their importance.

**Key Components for Food Security:** Kitchen sets, Jerry Cans, and Plastic Sheets, at minimum.

**Shelter Support:** Essential for safe food storage and consumption.



## **Khartoum:**

- Following SAF's victory in breaking the siege around Engineering Corps in Omdurman, clashes and artillery shelling continue in the three cities of Khatoum, Omdurman and Bahri.

## **East Sudan:**

- SAF on counter-offensive in Sennar Sugar Factory and in Aj Jazirah state.
- Looting of villages in Aj Jazirah and violence, including kidnapping, extortion, and brutal tactics against civilians.

## **Kordofan Region:**

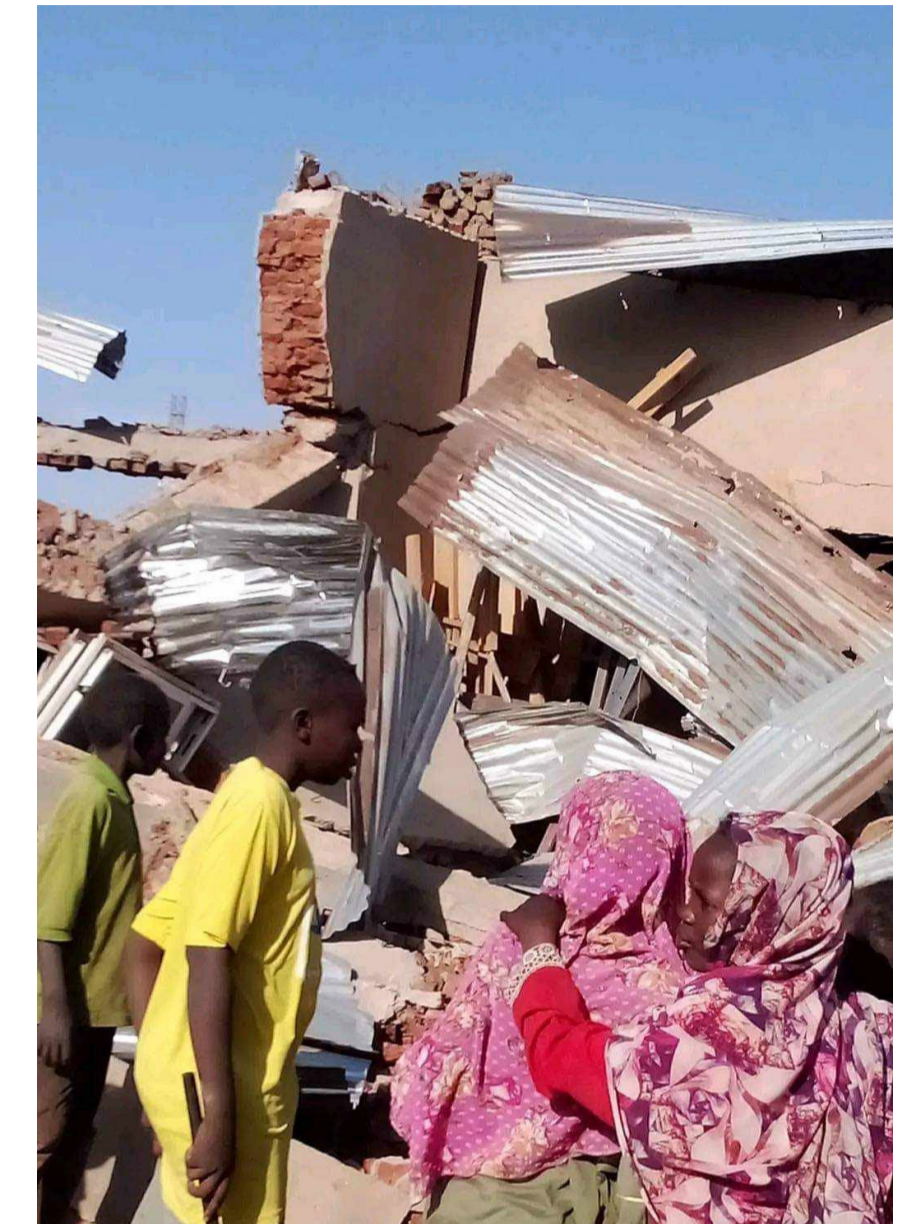
- Clashes between SAF and RSF in El Obeid, Babanusa and At Tadamon.
- Looting and violence by RSF in Um Rawaba and El Rahad.

## **Darfur Region:**

- Volatility and clashes in North Darfur around El Fasher and Kutum.
- Fire incidents across Darfur causing extensive damage and loss.

## **General:**

- SAF airstrikes in Jazirah, White Nile, North Kordofan, East Darfur and North Darfur causing Civilian casualties and destruction of residential areas.
- Arrests of individuals suspected of RSF affiliation in the East, alongside RSF's abductions and killings of those suspected of SAF affiliation.
- Noticeable upsurge in criminal activity and a propensity for armed engagement among civilians.

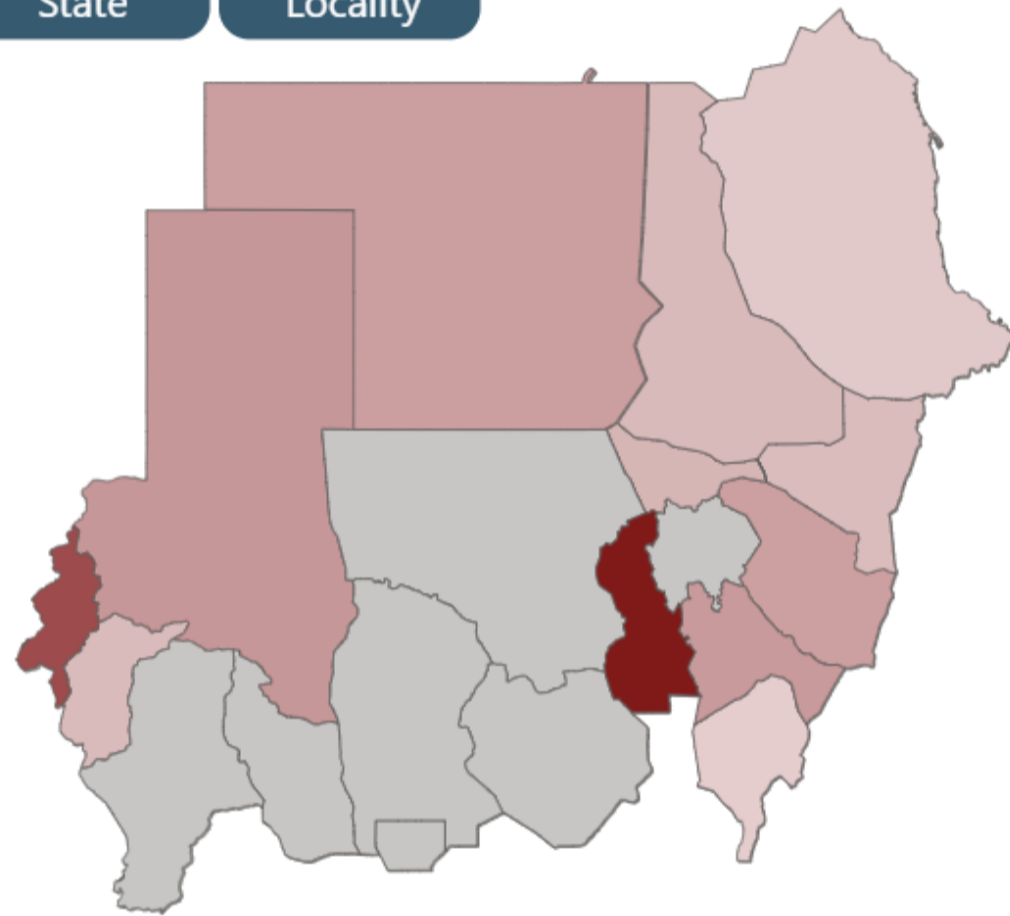

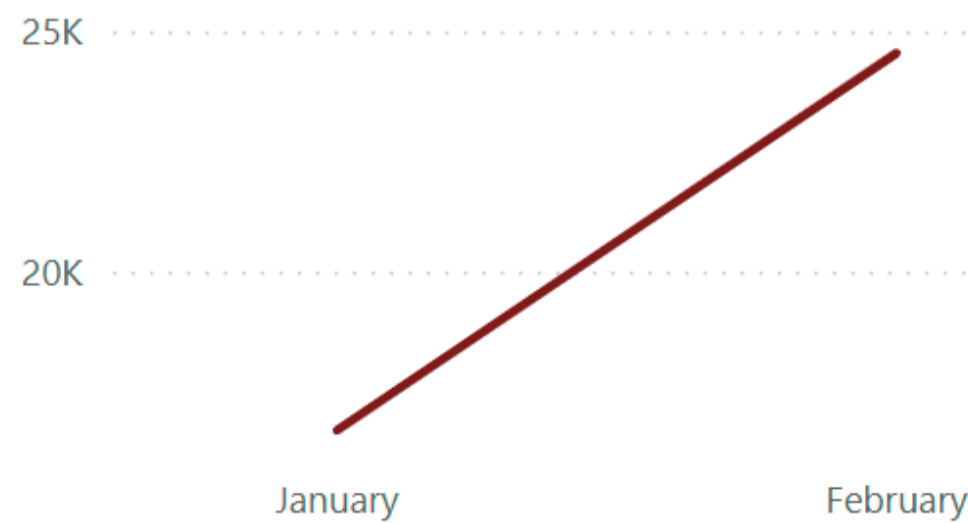

**Objective:** Ensure that our collective response efforts are well communicated to partners, donors, media and general audiences!

- **Achievements** – type of interventions, HH reached, locations, timeframe, etc.
  - **Challenges** – looting of supplies, access challenges, etc.
  - **Procurement** – quantities of stocks arriving to the country, type of stocks, timeframe, where will the stocks be prepositioned – particularly given the incoming flood season.
  - **Assessments** – e.g., needs assessments outlining specifics with respect to Shelter and NFI needs as well as market assessments on NFIs, shelter materials, or Cash for Rent.
  - **Context and impact** of interventions – e.g., any successes with respect to cash for rent, how is sustainability achieved, what about tenure security?
  - **Interventions in the host community** – with 67% of the population staying in host community – what has been achieved so far? Cash for shelter for the families hosting IDPs can be an option, or preselecting landlords to improve their housing in order for them to subsidize rent for IDPs – this can include negotiating longer-term tenure security.
