The cash for rent activity has more technicalities on how to do the and more support is offered by the cash working group. There are four response activities identified and there is the need to reconnect with HLP technical Working Group and to work together on the legal aspects of this of this types of activity.

The cluster is following up a meeting with the Ministry of Regional Development. For reintegration, the meeting was held on Thursday, so today we will share with you the details that we have.

IOM Ukraine Internal Displacement Report

IOM Ukraine shared the internal displacement report which can be shared. Any partners that might have questions can contact the IOM team in in Ukraine.

2. Work in progress

The project “Prykhystok” developed by the Ukrainian Government to support households hosting IDPs.

The social project for resettlement of internally displaced persons in the homes of people in safer regions.

The Costs per person– 15\$ /month

An approximate number of displaced persons – 500 000

Budget – 7,5 million \$ /month

Mechanism – owners of apartments and private houses in certain regions accommodate IDP`s

Financial support for the population – Reimbursement of costs: 0,5\$/day for each person

3. Next steps on coordination with authorities about refurbishment of buildings for collective centers

The sheltercluster advocates to continue other kinds of activities and the support of our rental and the refurbishment of new buildings for collective centers.

The rental assistance packages that are being currently discussed should include the protection considerations around opening up off of homes. The protection cluster should be included as it's more of a protection considerations than necessarily shelter that that will need to take priority over.

During refurbishment there needs to coordinate with the wash cluster to make sure that the standards and activities are conducted properly.
