

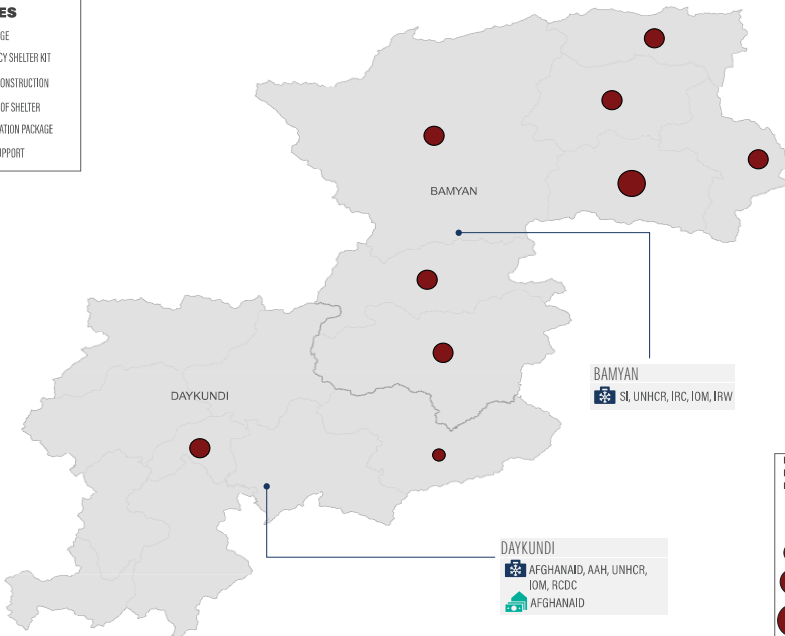

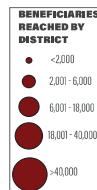
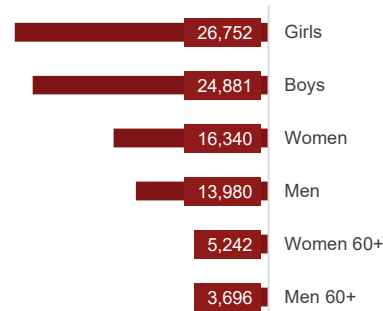

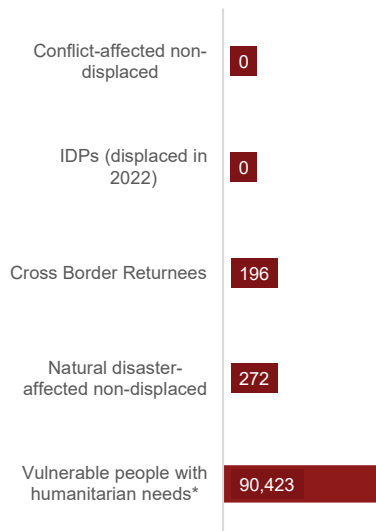


AGE AND GENDER BREAKDOWN

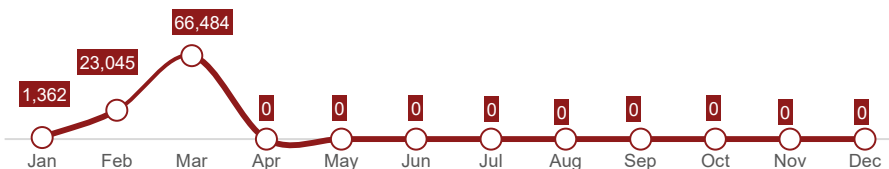
