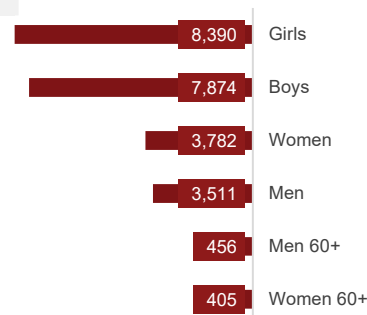

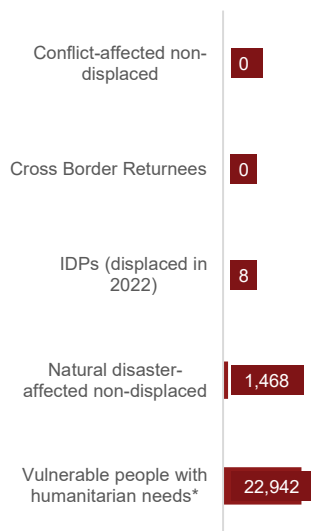


### AGE AND GENDER BREAKDOWN
