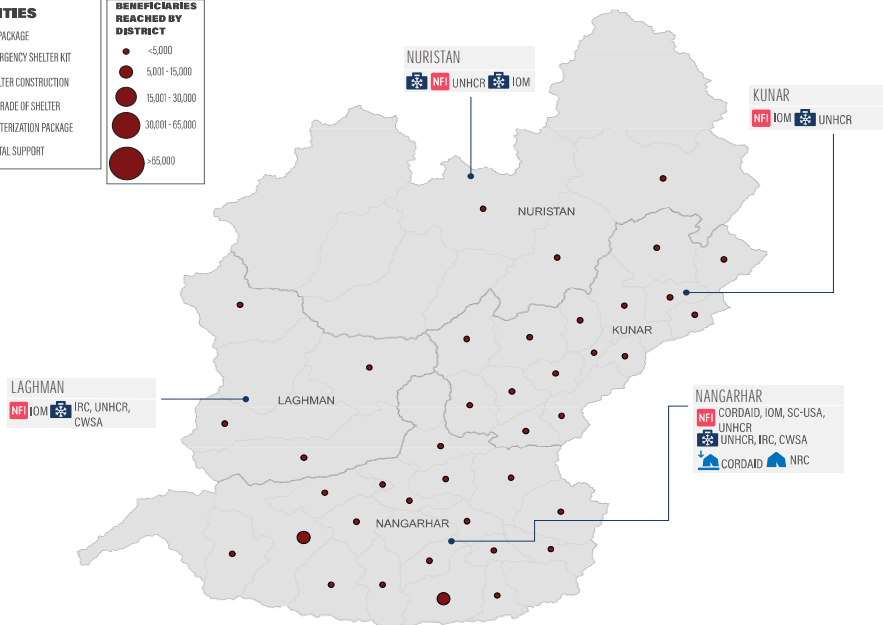
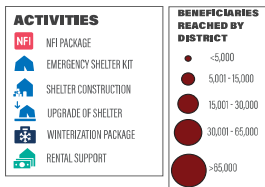




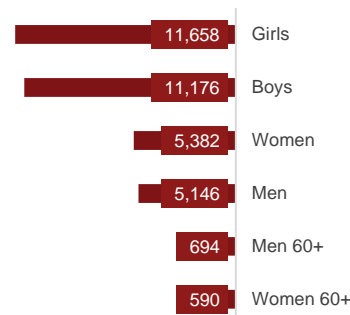

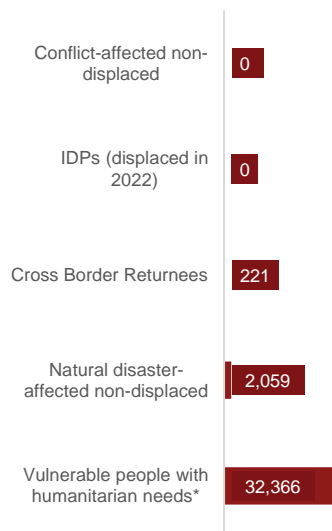


AGE AND GENDER BREAKDOWN

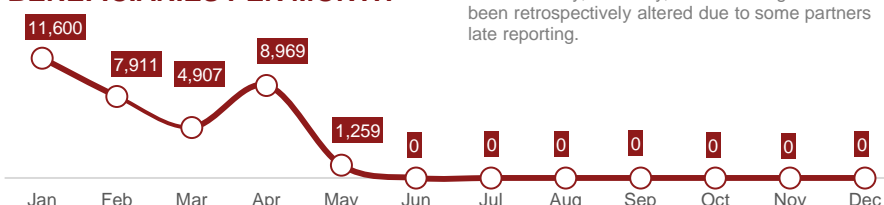
