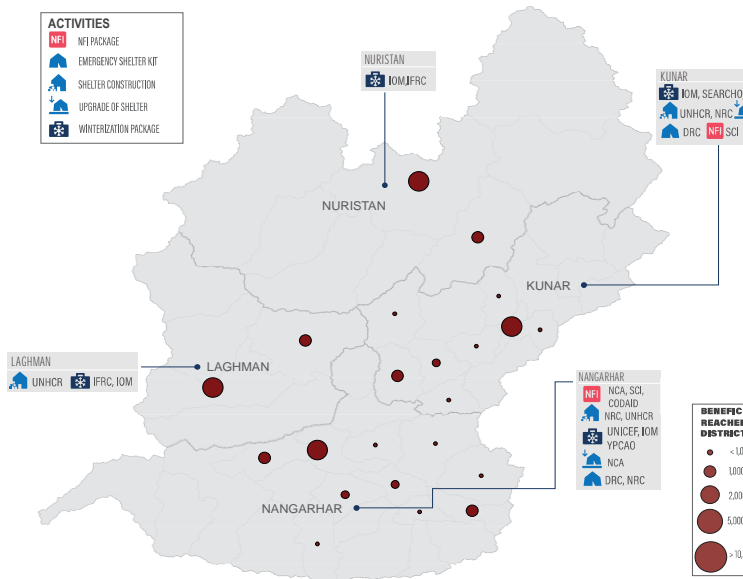




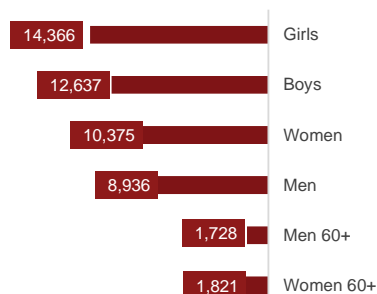

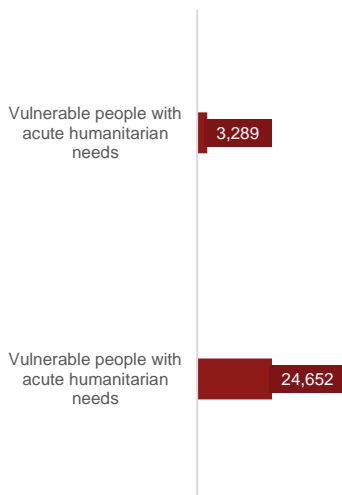
### AGE & GENDER BREAKDOWN
