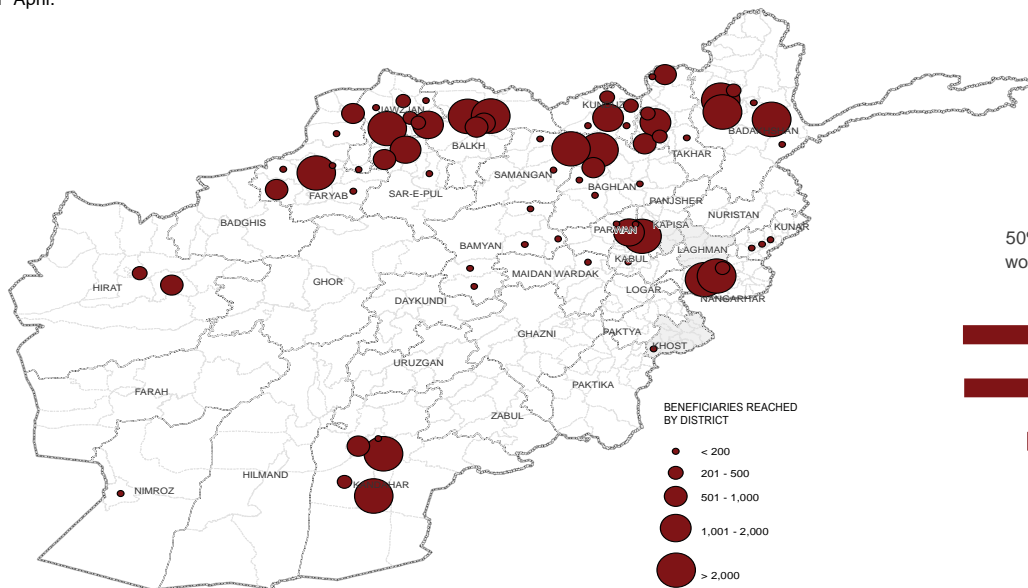


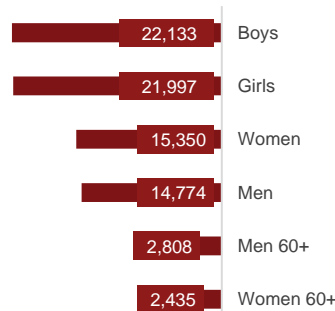

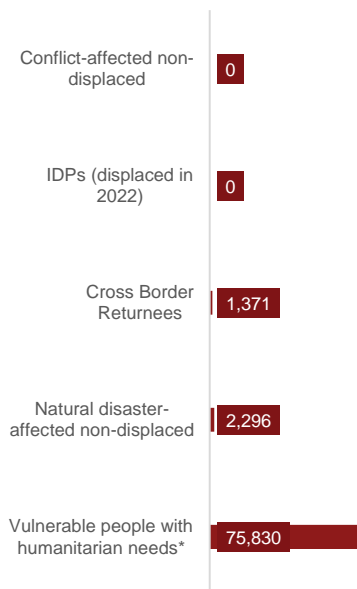


### AGE AND GENDER BREAKDOWN

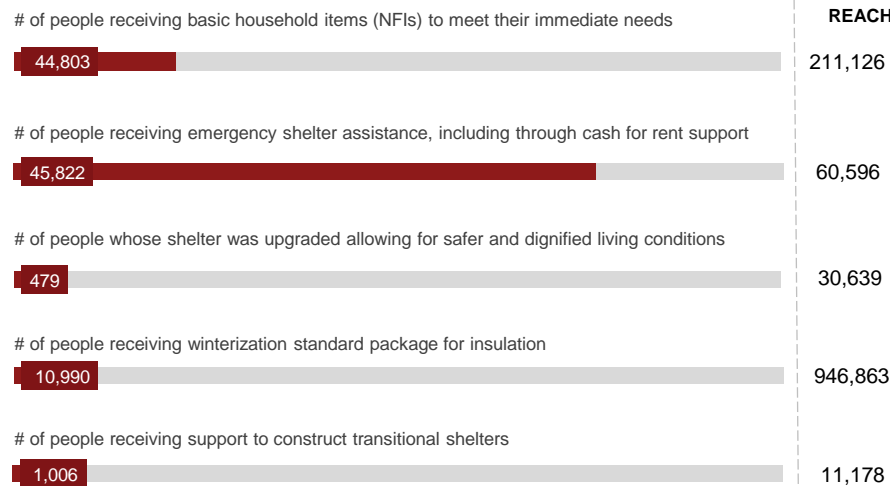
50% of the population reached are women and girls, 56% are children

23,603 people received additional NFI or shelter assistance.

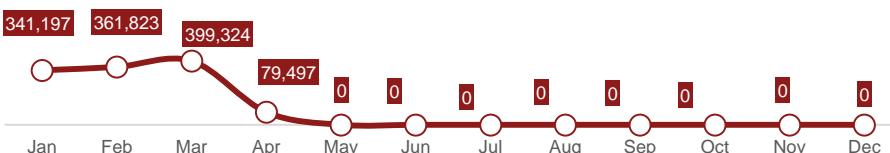
