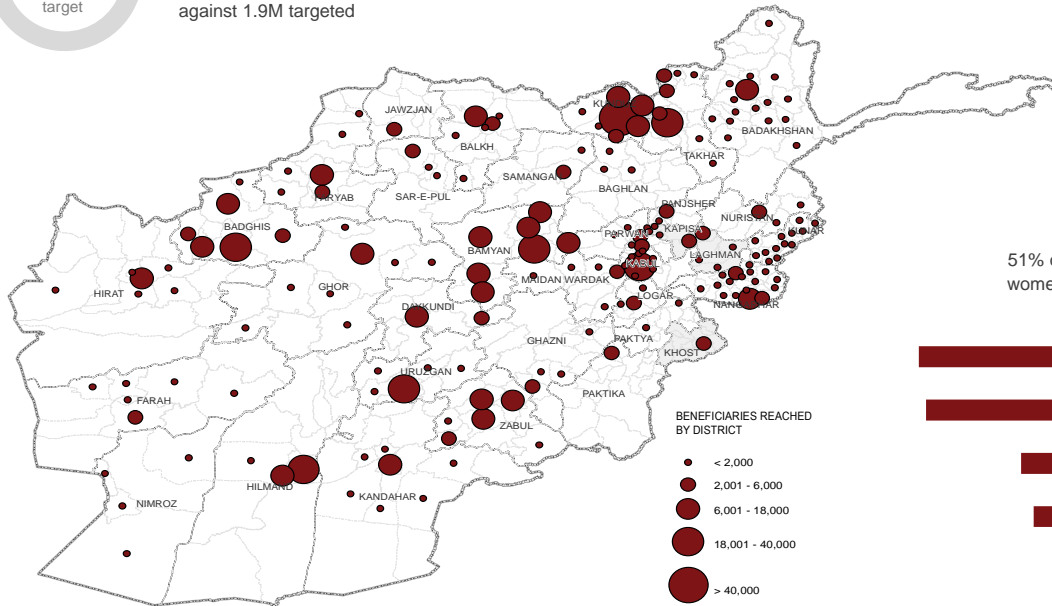




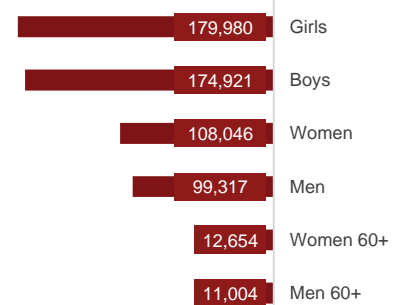

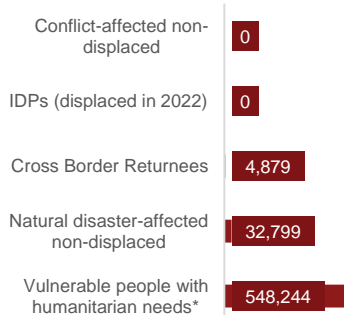


### AGE AND GENDER BREAKDOWN

51% of the population reached are women and girls, 61% are children

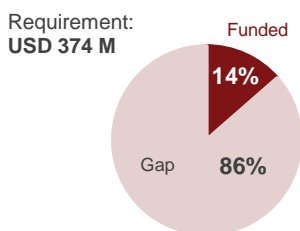


### BENEFICIARY TYPE
