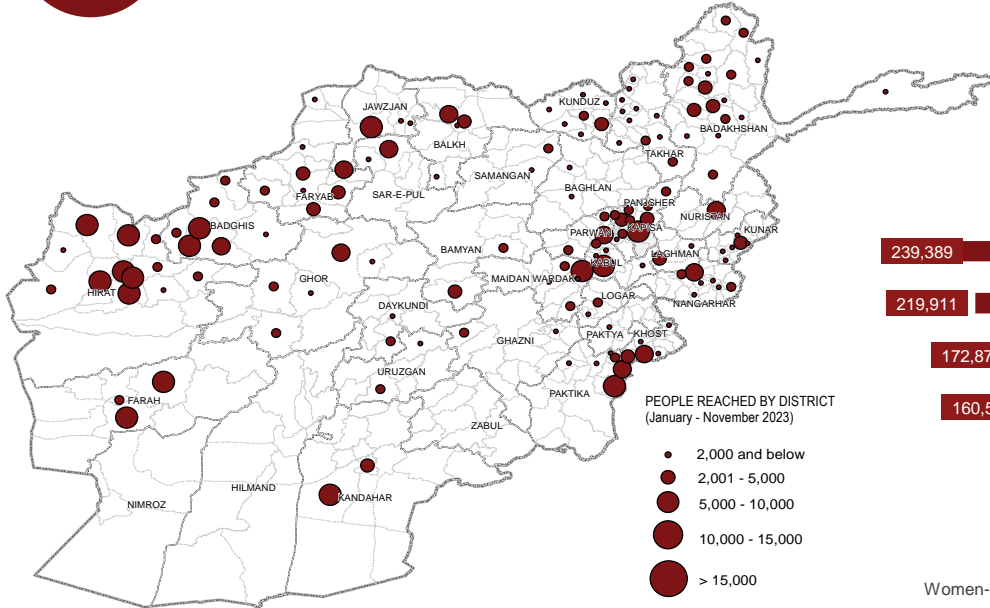




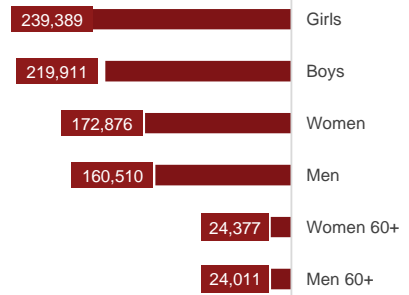

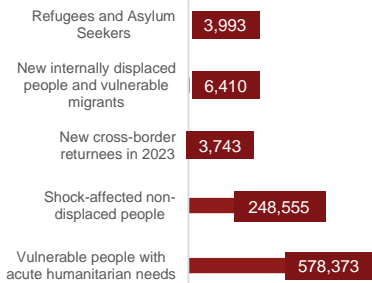
AGE & GENDER BREAKDOWN

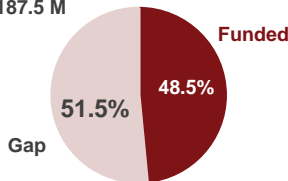
