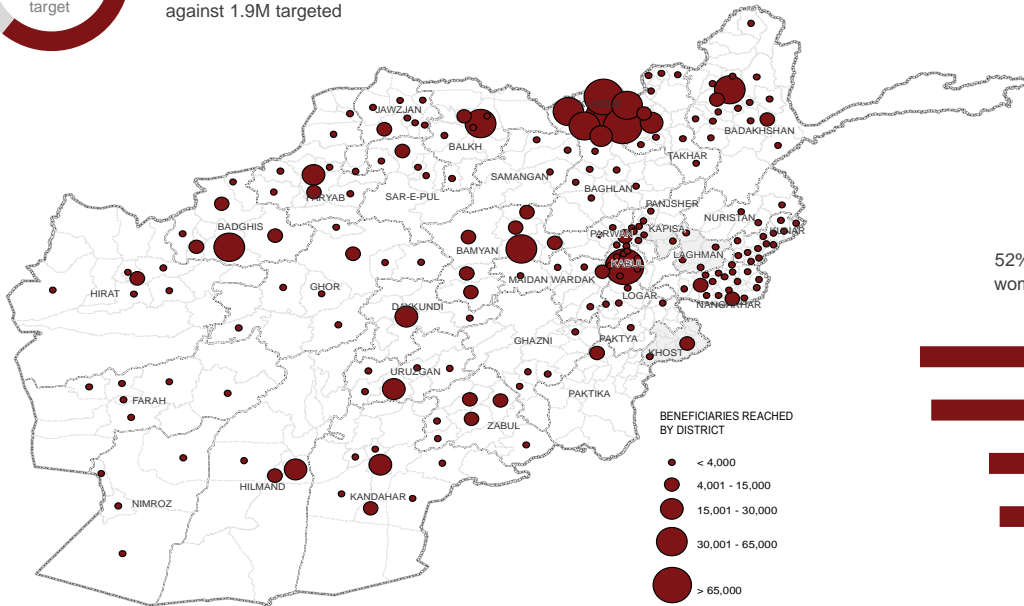




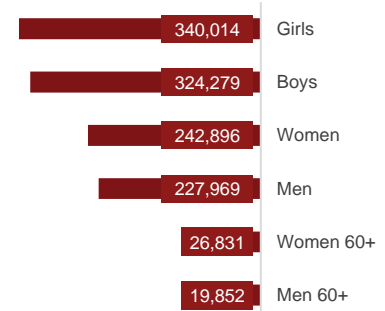

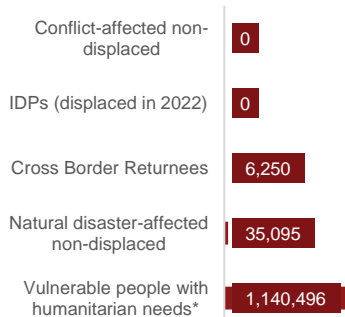


### AGE AND GENDER BREAKDOWN

### BENEFICIARY TYPE

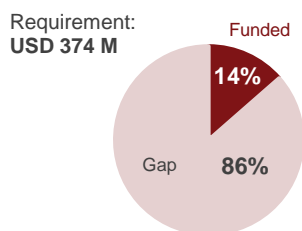
