- **Planned /Completed activities:**
 - **AbuSalim Municipality – Supporting Returnee’s families (38HH)**
 - Distribution of **Shelter materials** activities completed.
 - **Migrants – population at Alkirmia area (Alsfah site) - (147 Individuals)**
 - **Core NFIs assistance:** Distribution activities is ongoing.
 - **Migrants –population at Soug Aljoma area- (68 Individuals)**
 - **Core NFIs assistance:** Distribution activities is ongoing.
 - **GFFO project: Target** to reach is **285 affected individuals** for access to safe and appropriate shelter
 - Location identification has been completed for **shelter material support** (Qasir Ben Kasir area)
 - Beneficiaries' identification and assessment phase are on going.



2. PARTNER UPDATE

NRC- Shelter updates

- **Projects in partnership with UNHCR:**

1. **HHs level rehab:**

- a. Benghazi: target is 50 housing units- implementation work is completed and all housing units have been handed over to beneficiaries
- b. Tripoli: target is 50 housing units- Technical package including BoQs and SoWs is completed, will be shared soon with UNHCR for their final review before the start of the implementation.

2. **Rehab and upgrade of community infrastructures:**

- a. Benghazi: target is 1 project: technical package is completed and approval was received from UNHCR to proceed with launching the tender, tender announcement was done and the closing date for submitting the bids is 18th of August.
- b. Tripoli: target is 1 project, confirmed and agreed about the **(Hey Alzour water pump station rehab in Abouslaim municipality)**, and the technical package is completed and will launch the tender next week.

- **Other shelter projects:**

1. **Other 78 HHs rehab housing units project in Tripoli:** V.assessment is completed.
2. **Other 128 HHs rehab housing units project in Benghazi project:** Technical package for 50Hhs sub-standard housing units rehabilitation in Benina is ready, the implementation phase will start next week.
3. **Shelter rehab for HHs level in Tawergha with a total of 246 housing units:** vulnerability assessments completed, and start working on the preparation of technical package for the 1st batch of 50 housing units, implementation for the 1st batch should start next week.



NFI Update

During the reporting period, a total of **43 HHs (545 individuals)** asylum seekers and refugees received NFIs and HK assistance, among them **209** individuals at Ganfouda DC, while the rest were in the urban refugee context in the CDC and Evaluation to Italy.

2. PARTNER UPDATE



1. Distribution activities of FI and Hygiene kits in Zawiya: on July 26th, 27th and 28th, the eighth ordinary monthly distribution of Hygiene and FI kits took place in 4 different districts of the Municipality of Zawiya (**Juddaim, Arewie, Khartoum/Bu Ghalasha and Terfas**) for the benefit of **262 beneficiaries** among **migrants, refugees and asylum seekers in urban settings**. The distribution have been organised and carried out by CEFA. **90 Hygiene and 90 FI Kits** (individual/family kits) have been distributed to the beneficiaries.

2. Distribution activities of FI and Hygiene kits in Tripoli: on July 26th, 27th and 28th, the second monthly distribution of Hygiene and FI kits took place in 4 different districts of Tripoli (**Alswani, Ghout Al Shaal, Hay Alandalus and Tripoli Centre**) for the benefit of **migrants, refugees and asylum seekers in urban settings**. The distribution have been organised and carried out by CEFA in collaboration with CEFA's local partner, IOCS. **148 Hygiene and 162 FI Kits** (individual/family kits) have been distributed for the benefit of **259 beneficiaries**.



2. PARTNER UPDATE

IOM SNFI Assistance : July 2022 DAU/MRRM Outreach UPDATE



- The total number of individuals reached with NFIs assistance during July 2022 is 2926 individuals , all of them are migrants. (218 boys, 45 girls, 2032 men, 631 women)
- In this month DAU covered 2926 migrants in 9 mantikas which are Toukra, Zuwarah, Bani Waleed, Gartoun, Sebha, Benghazi, Aljabal Alakhdar, Alfara, and Tripoli.
- In detention center DAU covered 1528 migrants with 4525 kits of NFIs
- In Urban settings DAU covered 1398 migrants with 2025 kits of NFIs.
- The Assistance provided where 6550 NFIs including mattresses, summer blankets, kitchen sets, diapers, jerry cans, solar lamps, and Clothing Kits



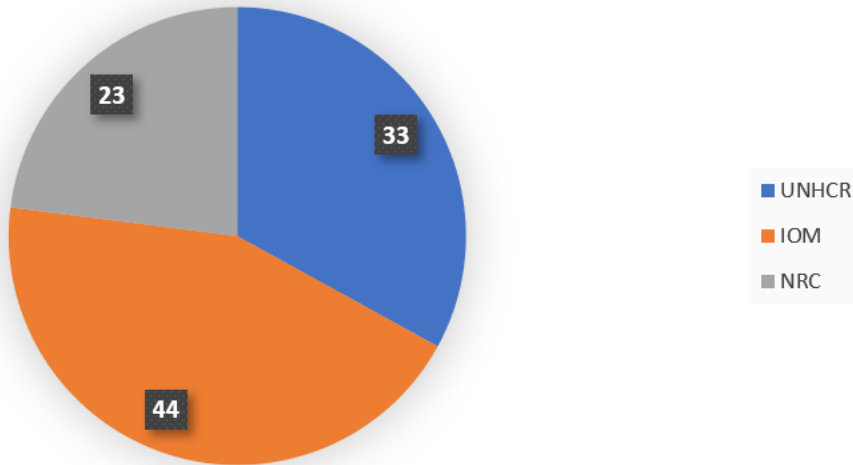

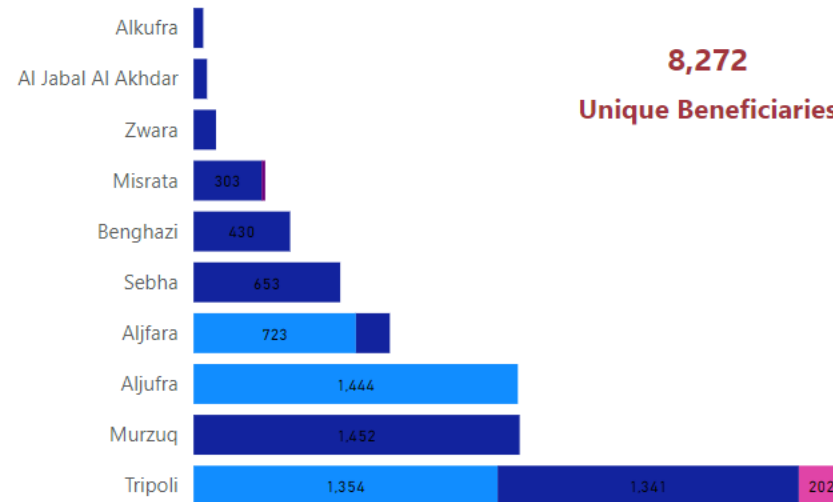

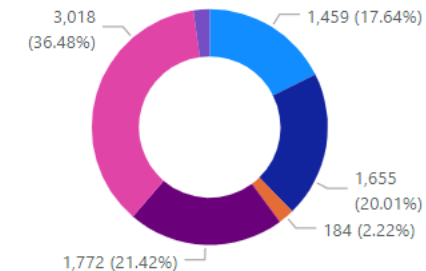
