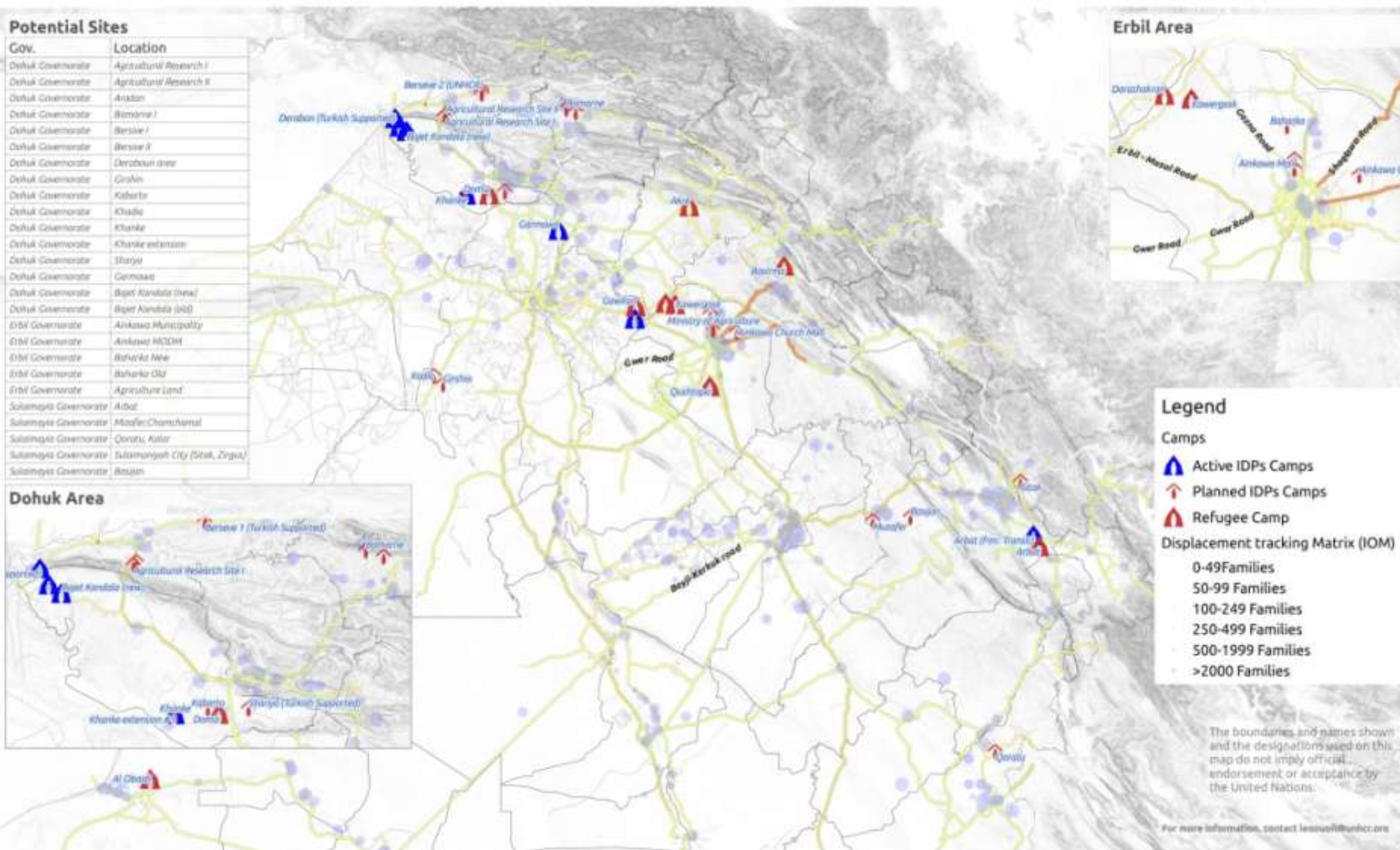

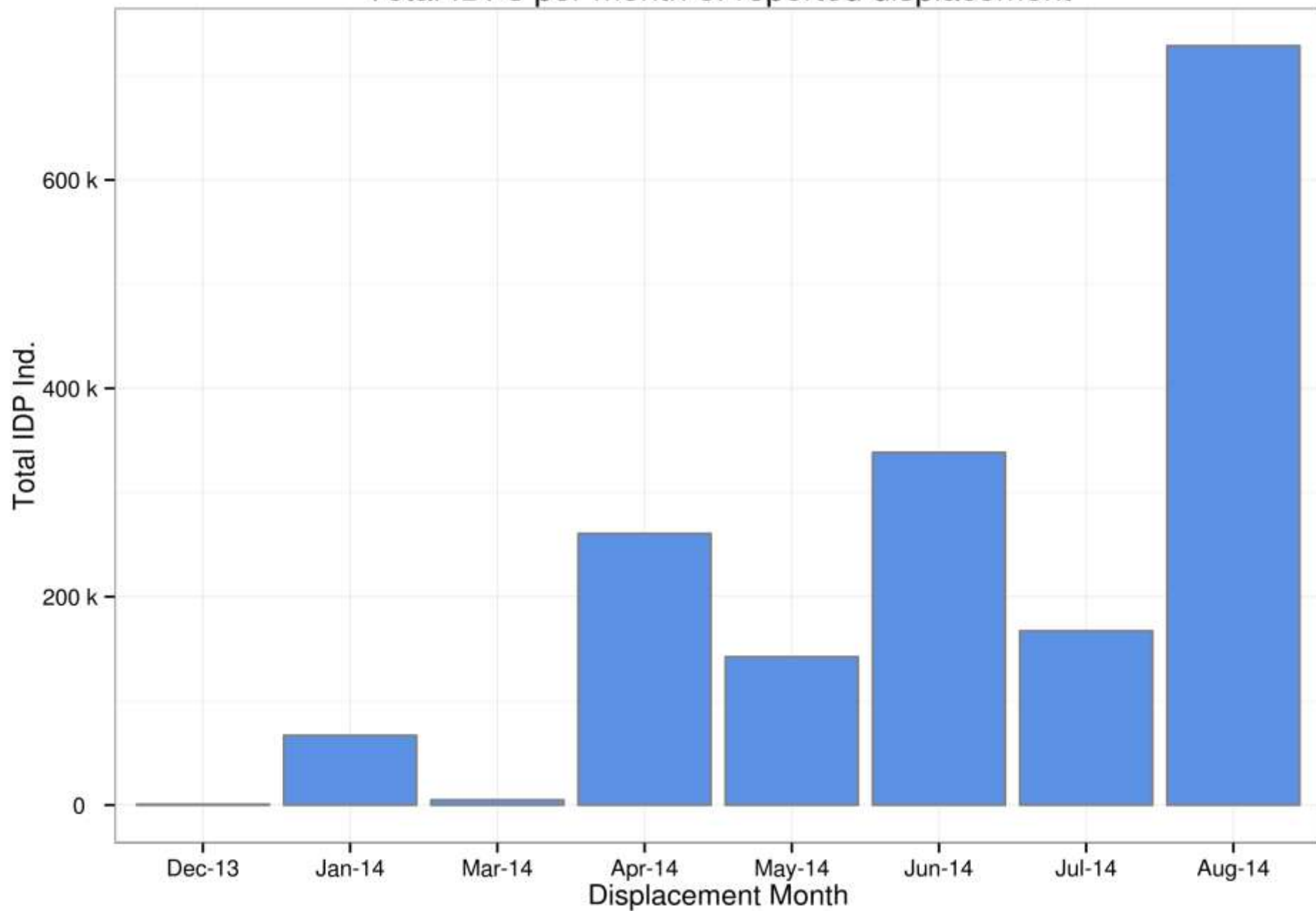

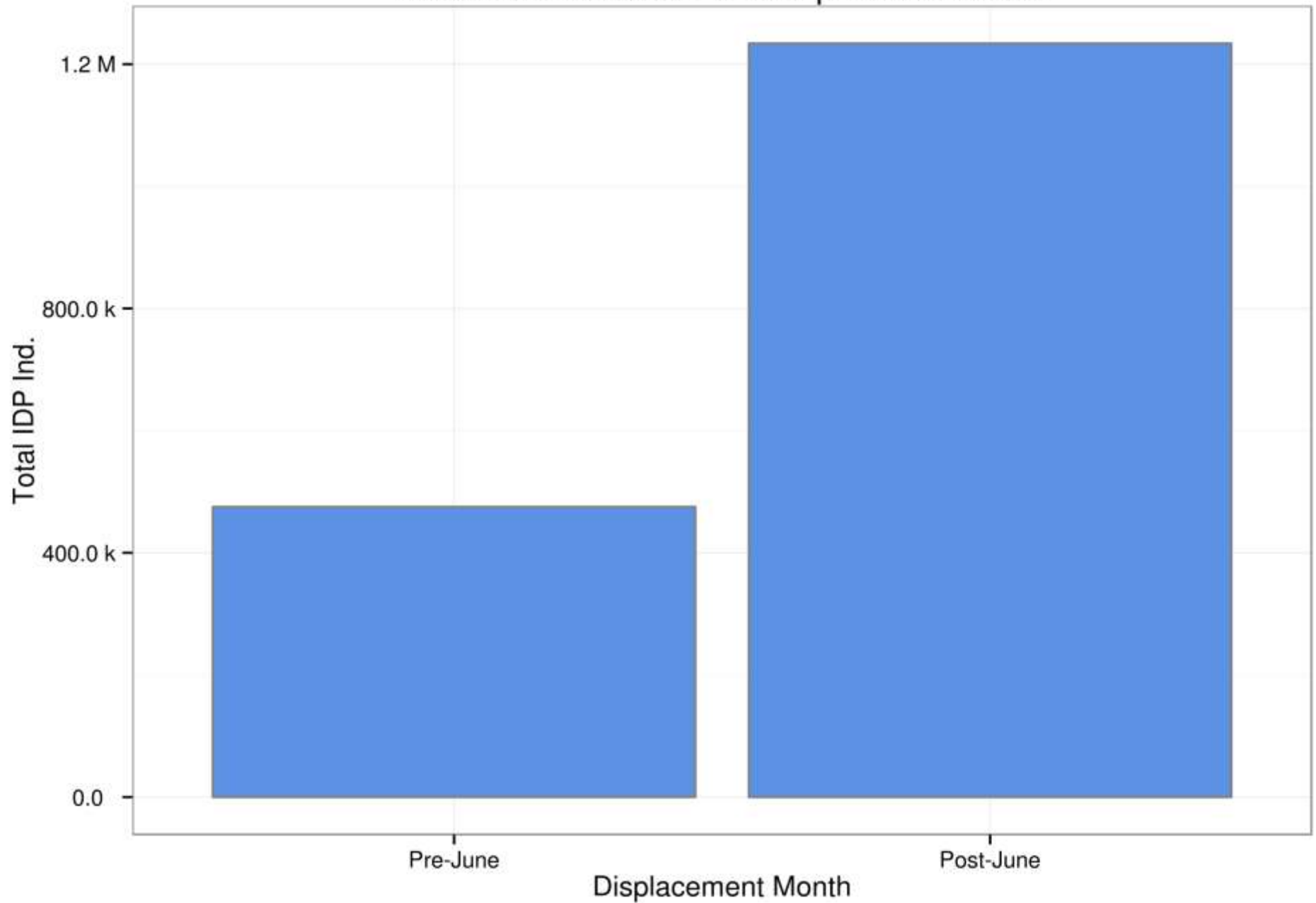

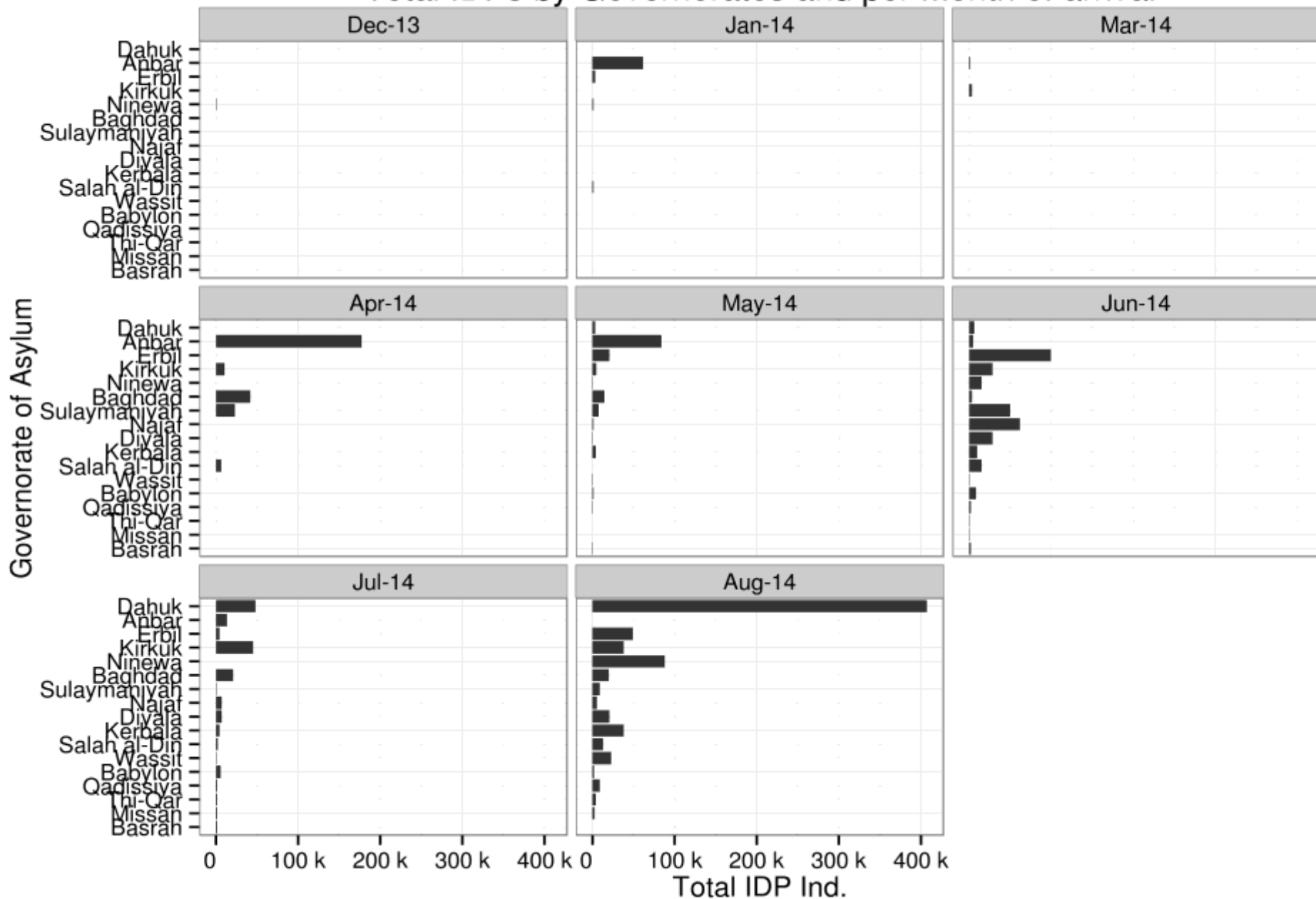
## Total IDPs per month of reported displacement



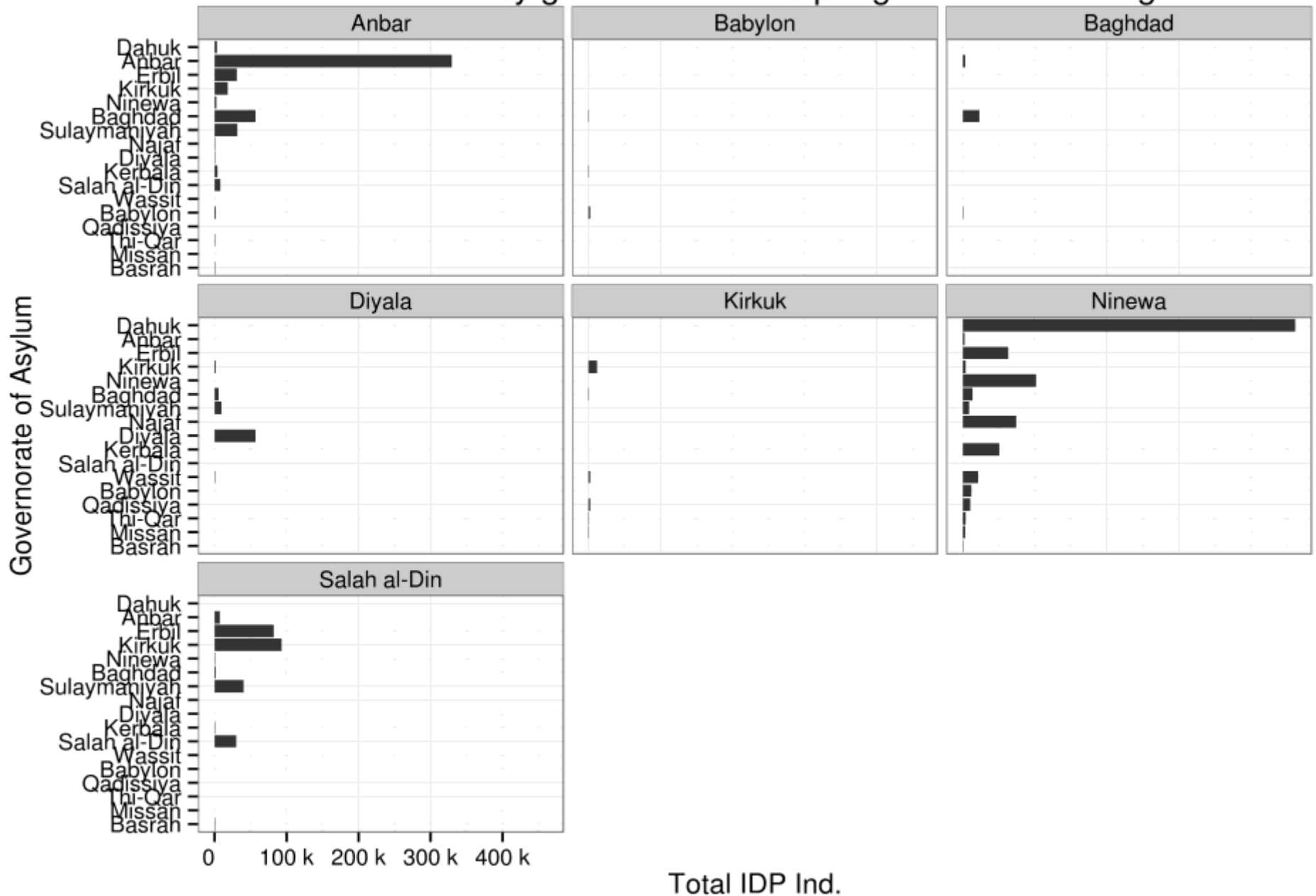
# Total IDPs Jan-June 2014 / post-June 2014



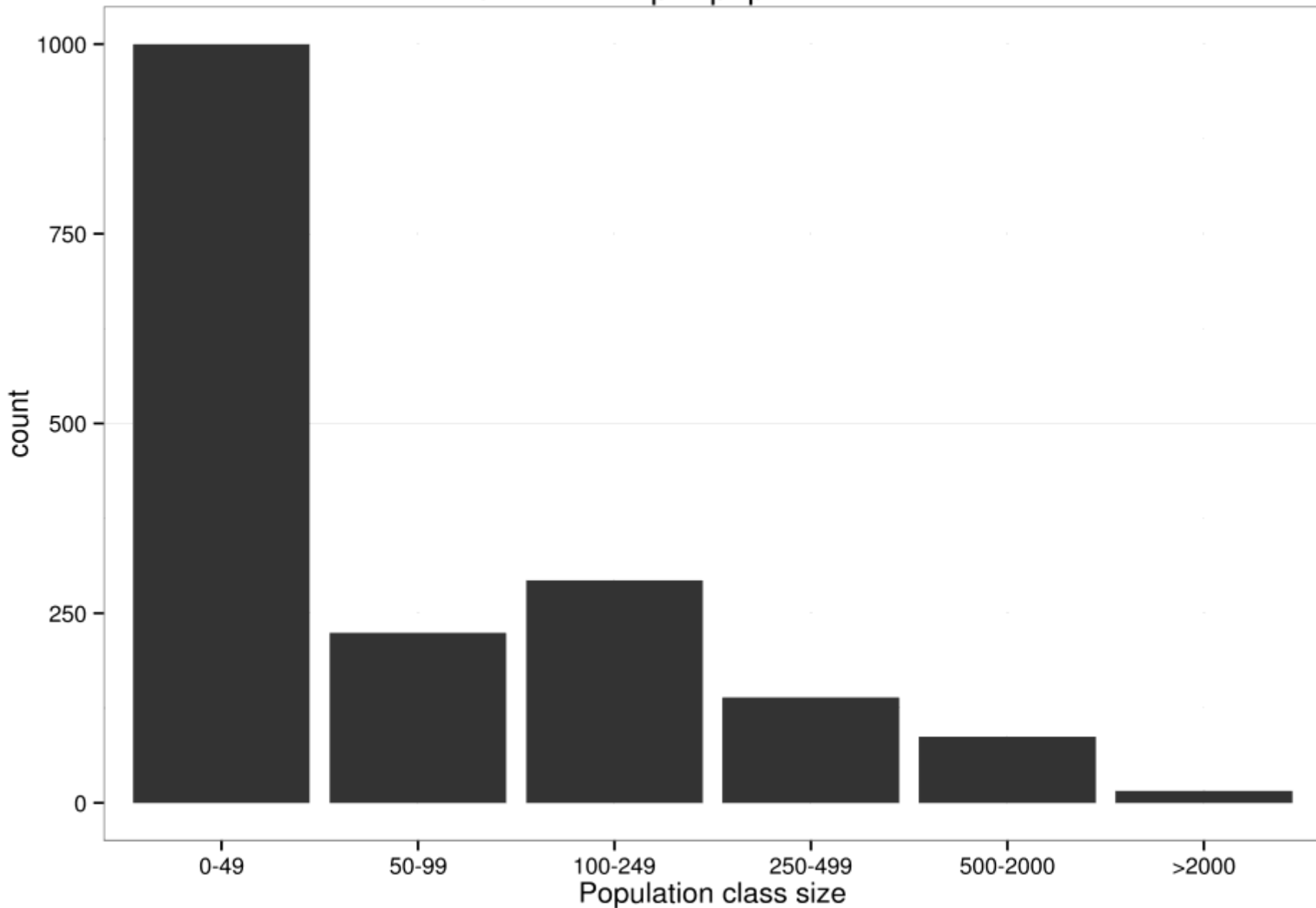
# Total IDPs by Governorates and per Month of arrival



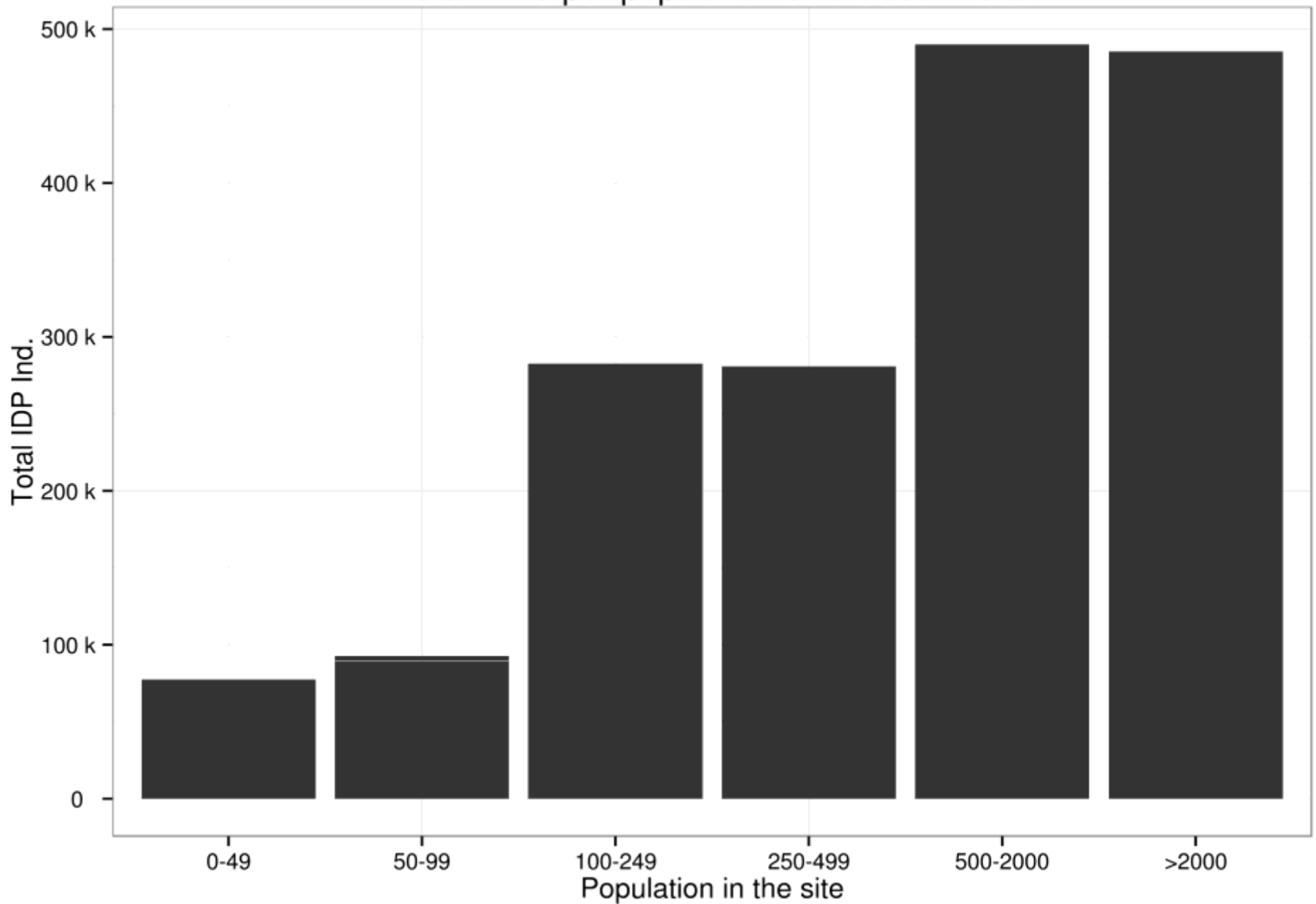
# Total IDPs by governorates and per governorate of origin



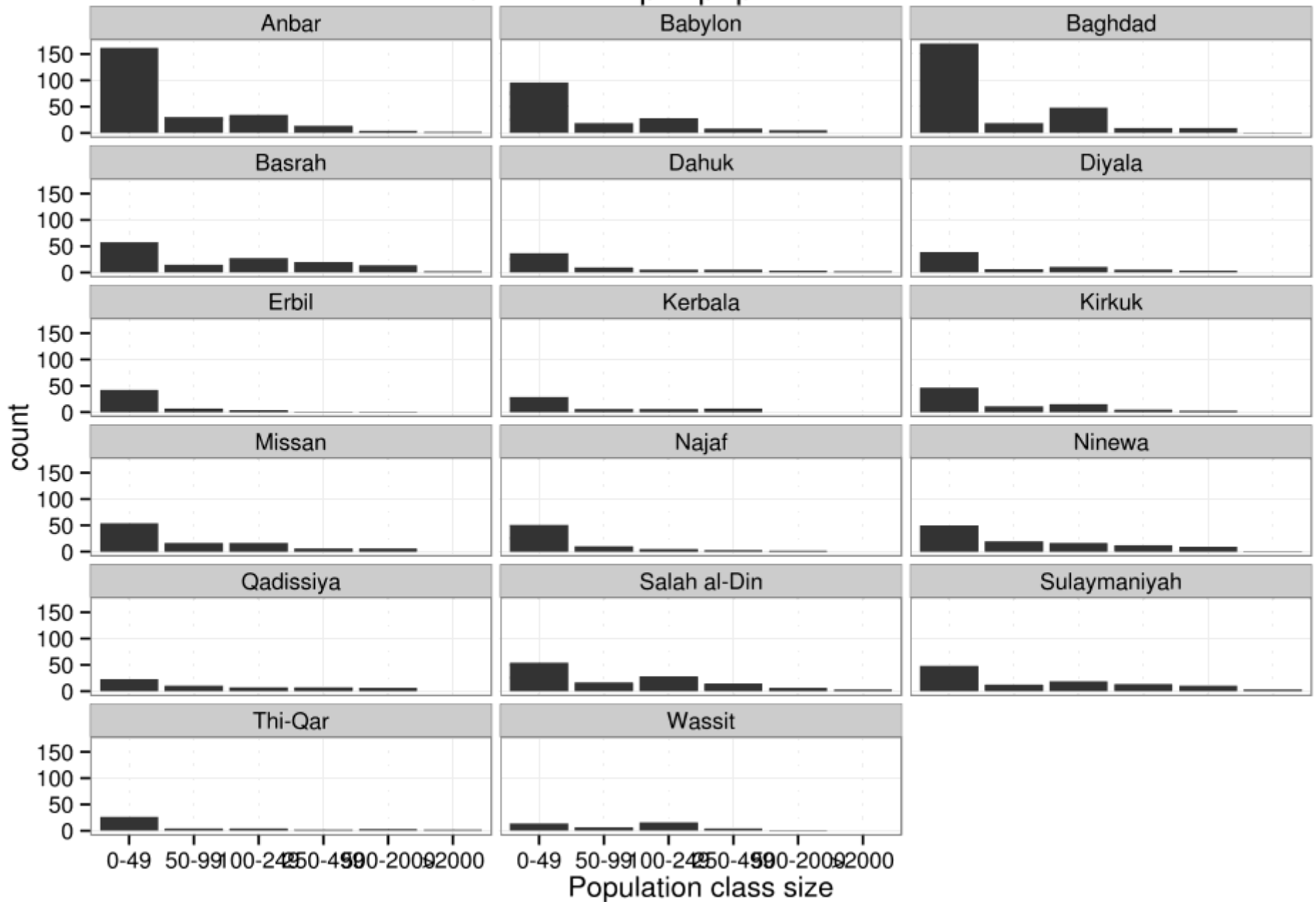
# Number of sites per population size class



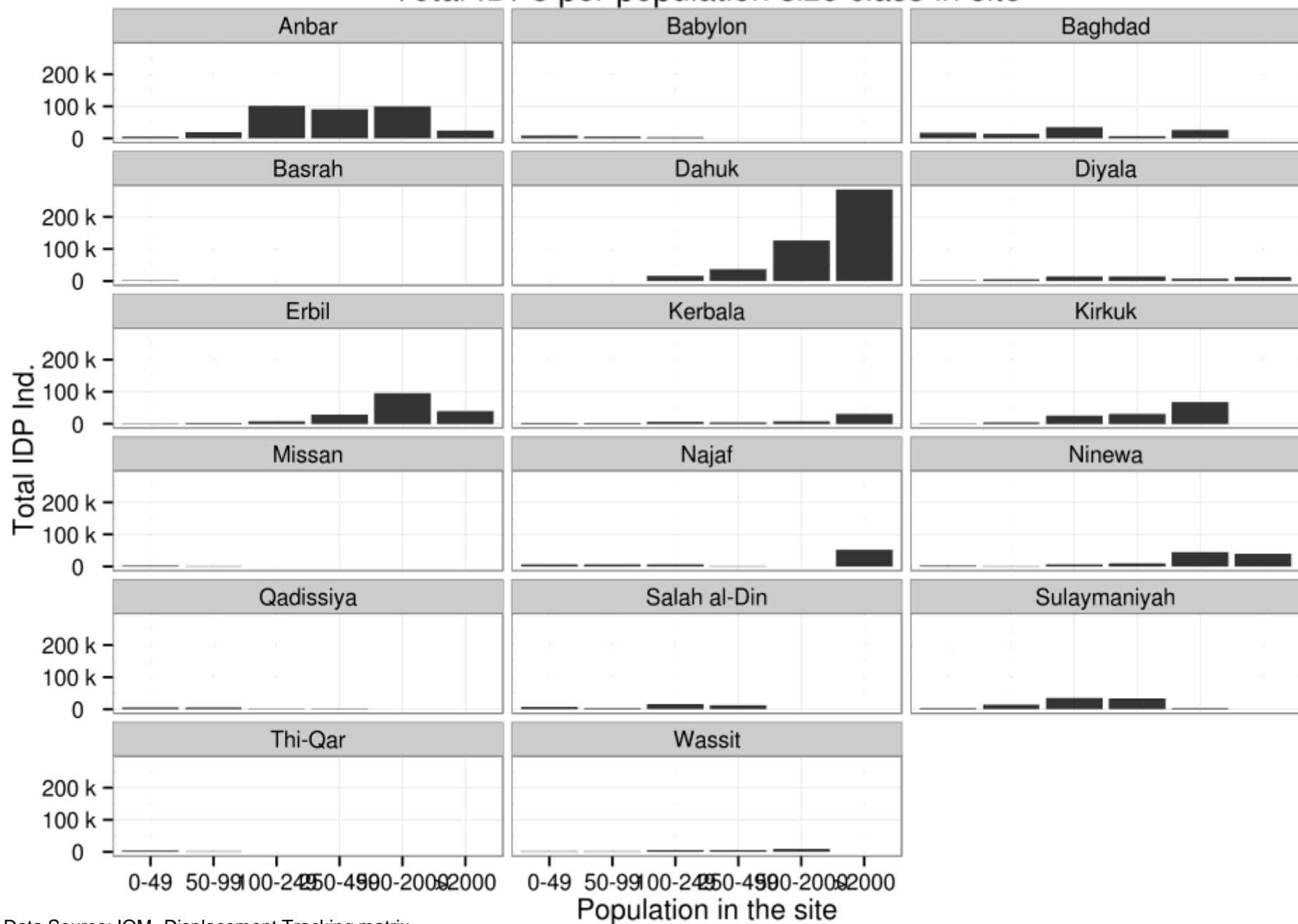
# Total IDPs per population size class in site

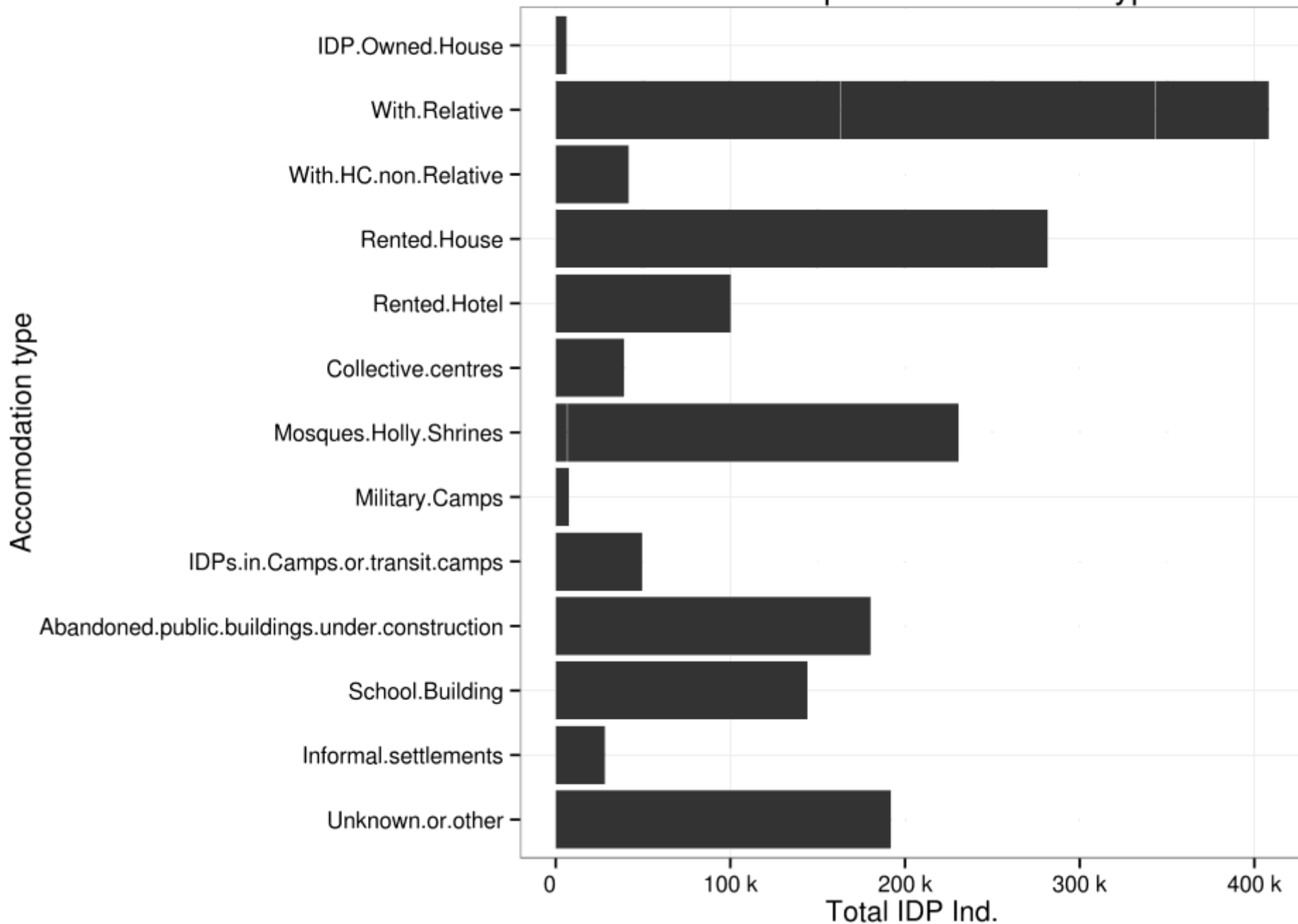

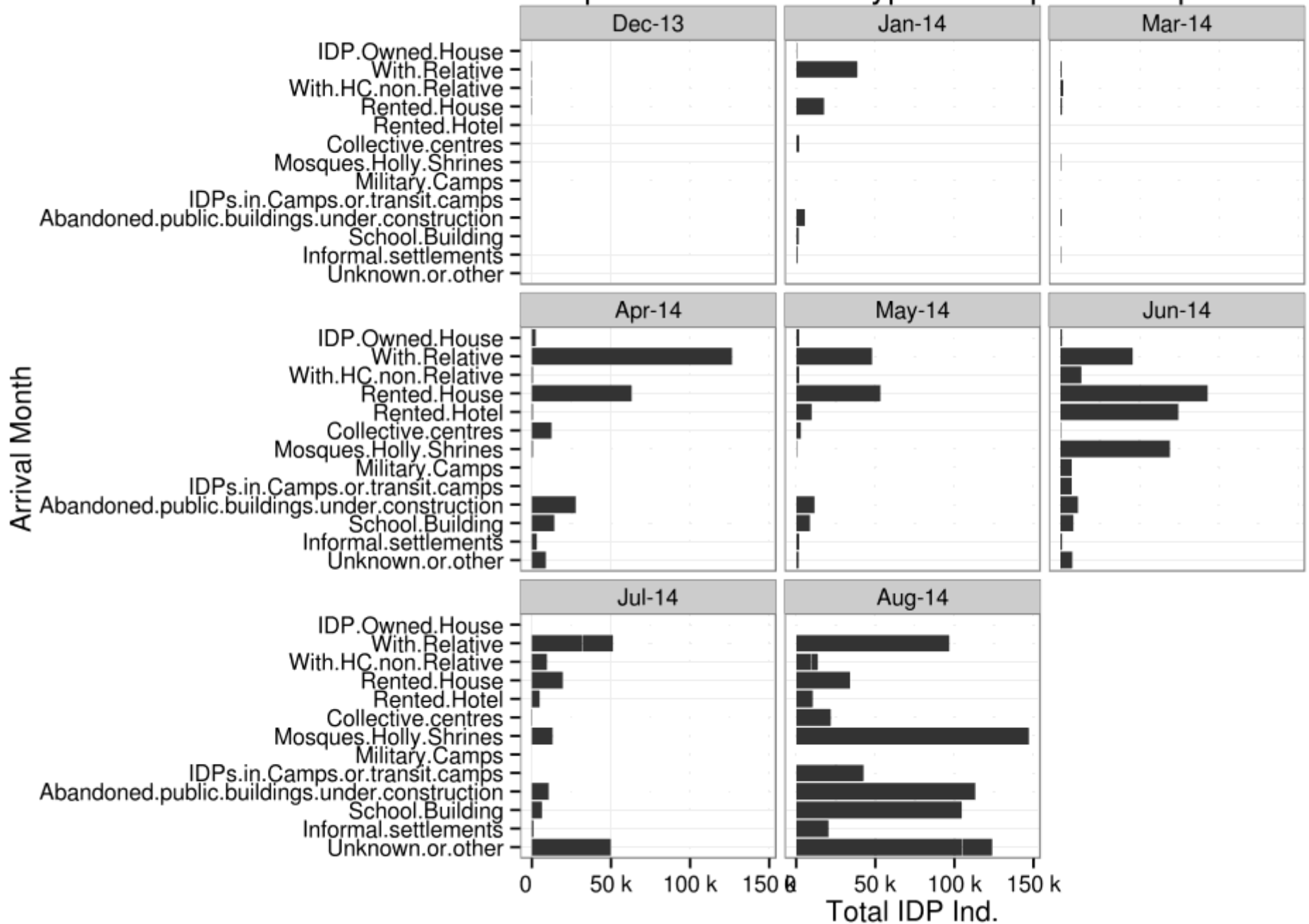

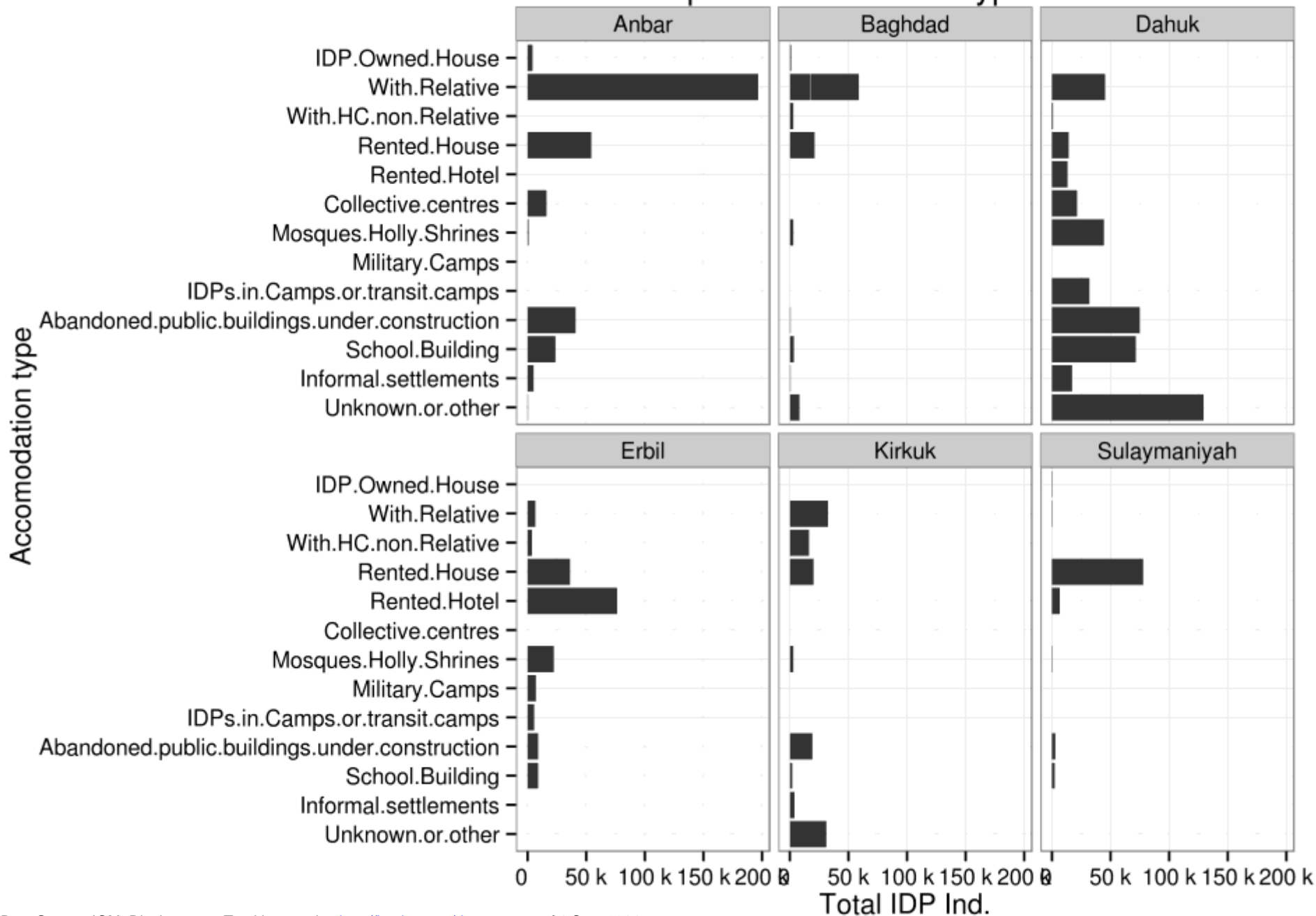

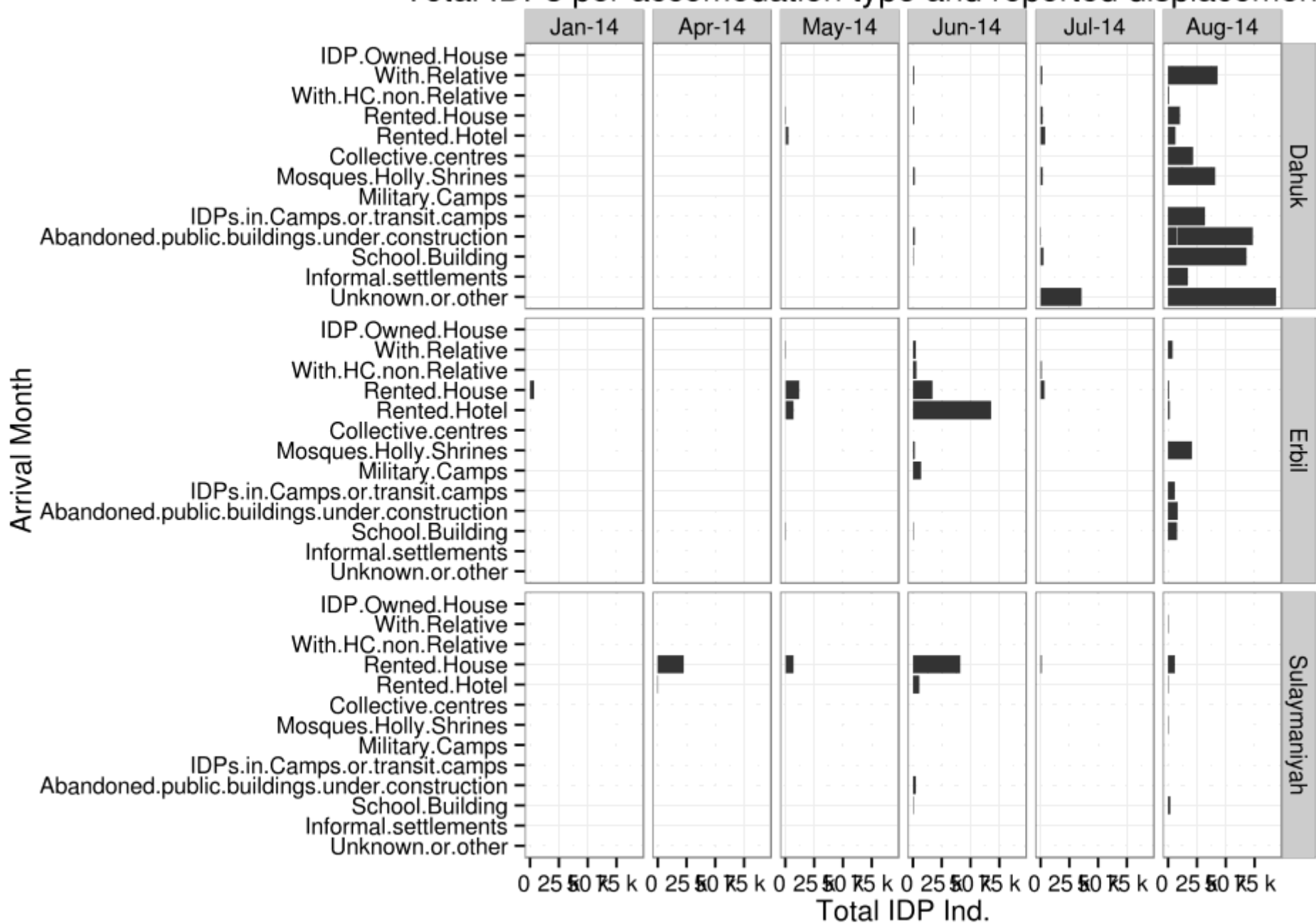
# Total IDPs per accomodation type and reported displacement

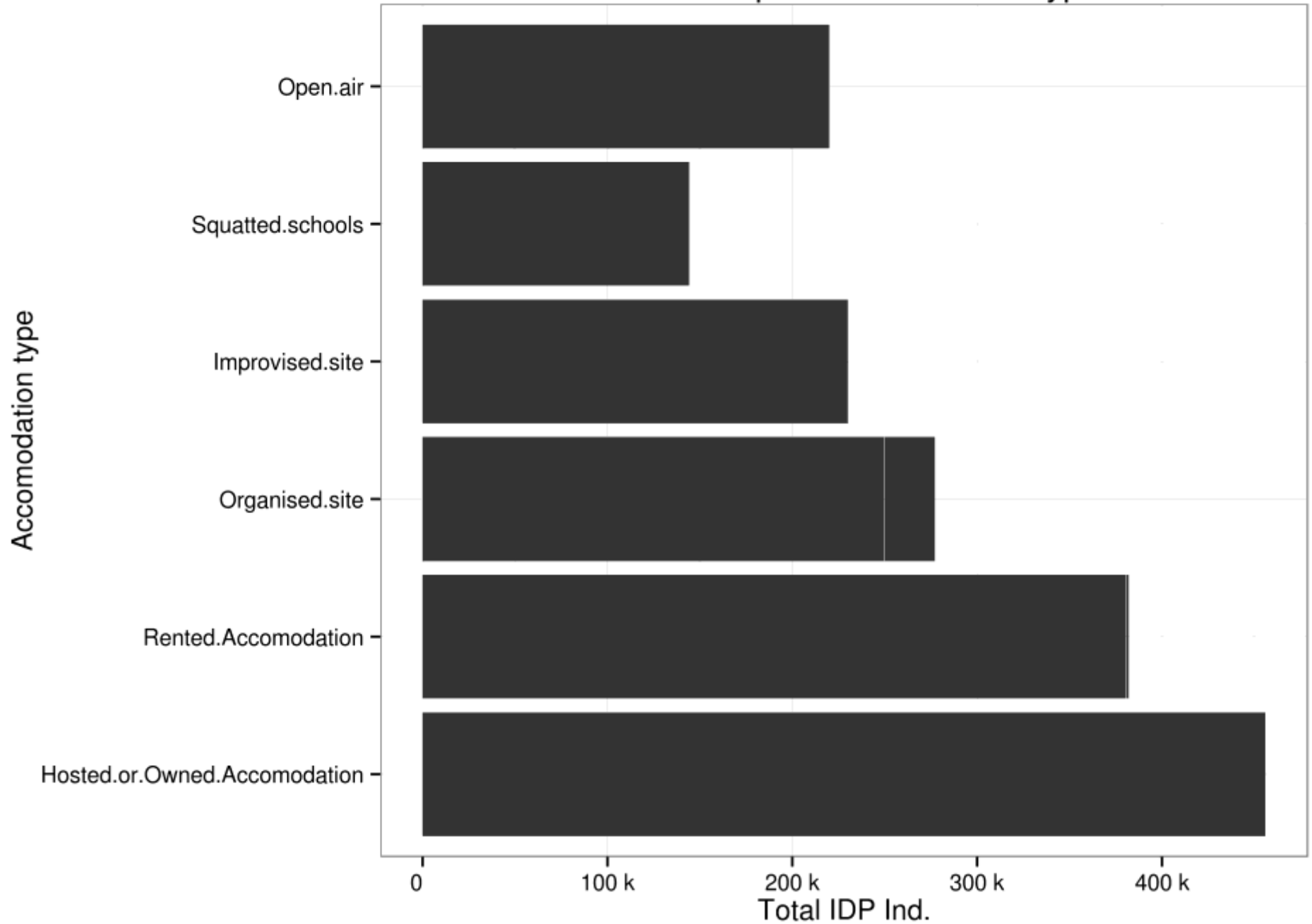

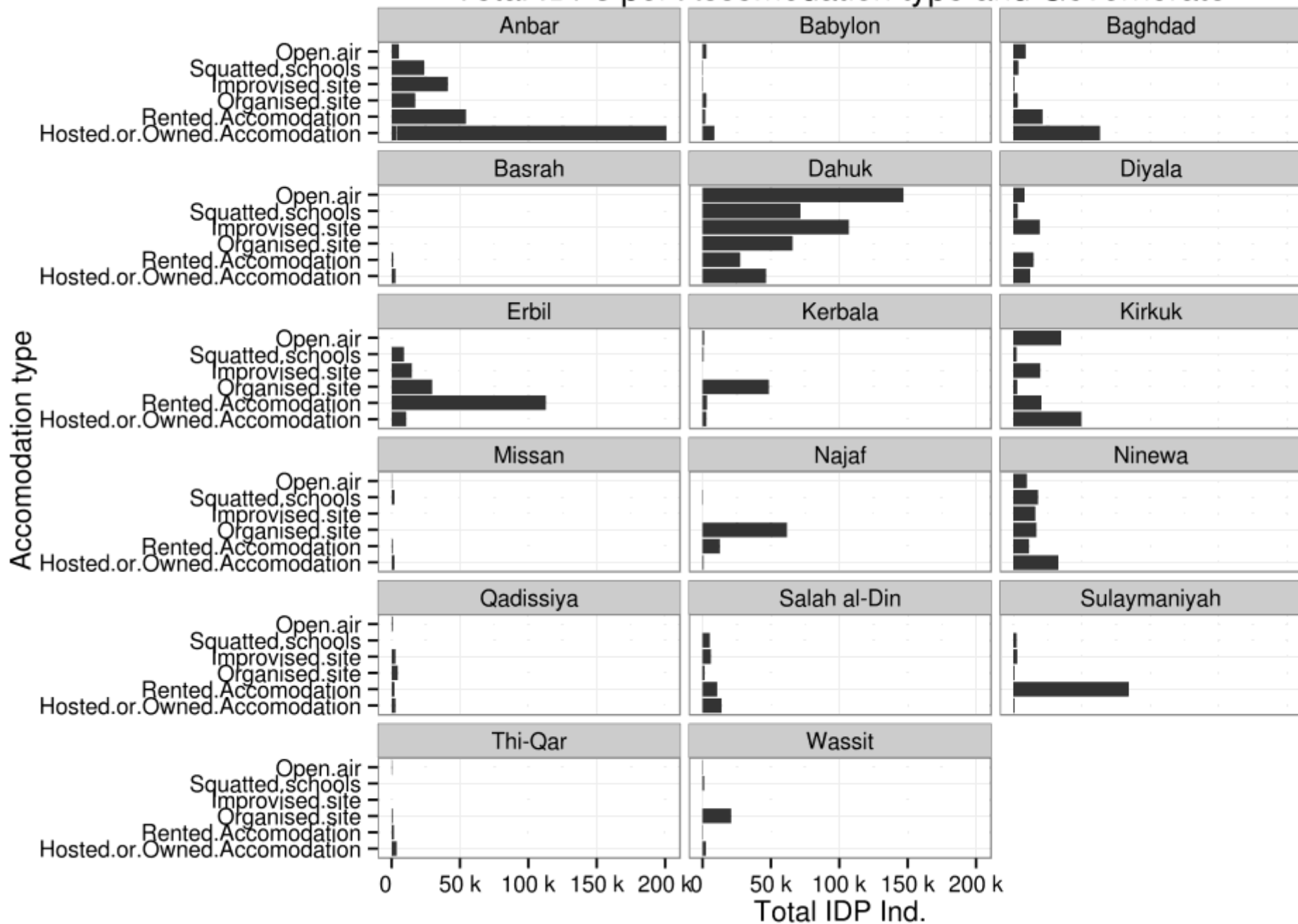

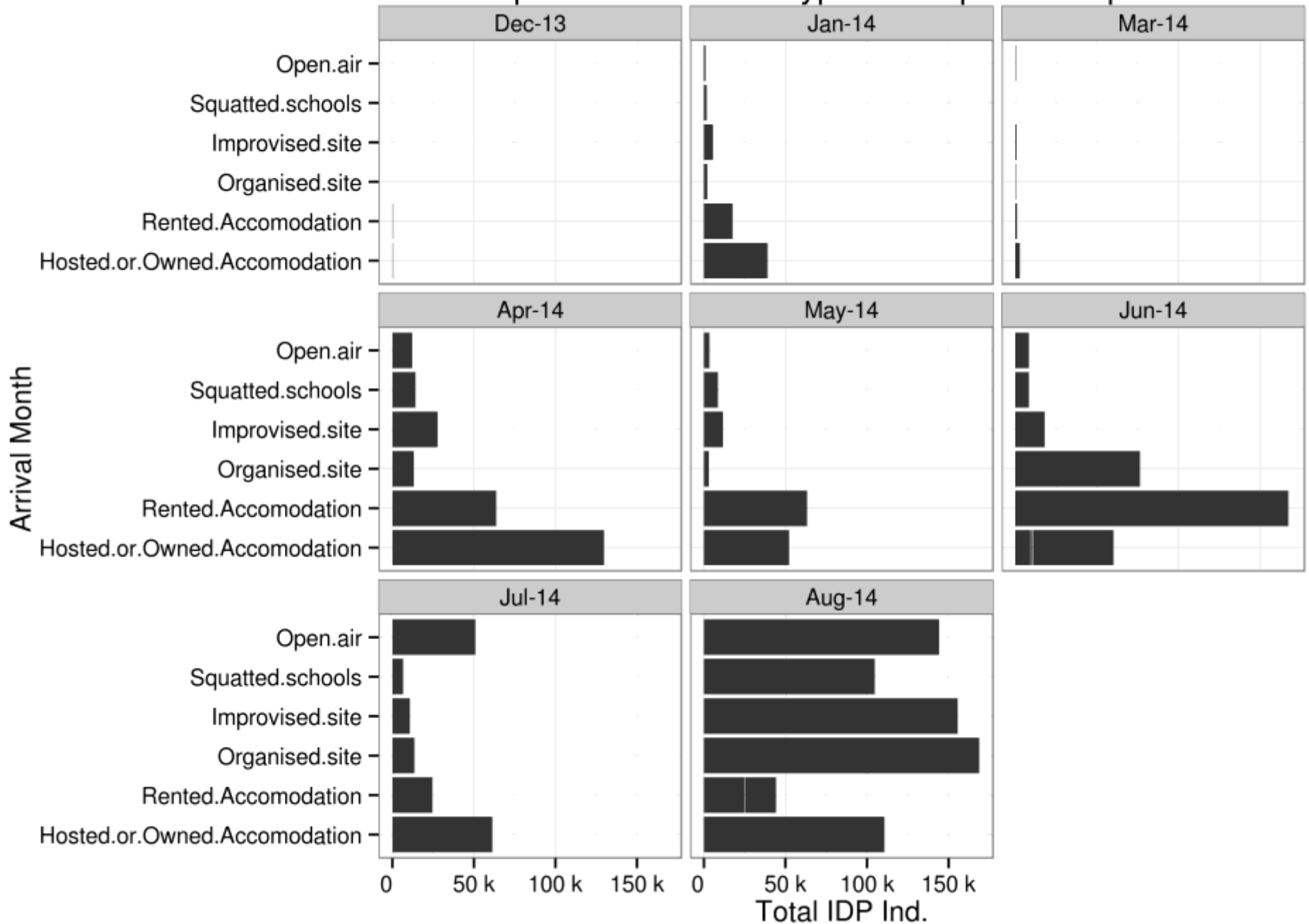

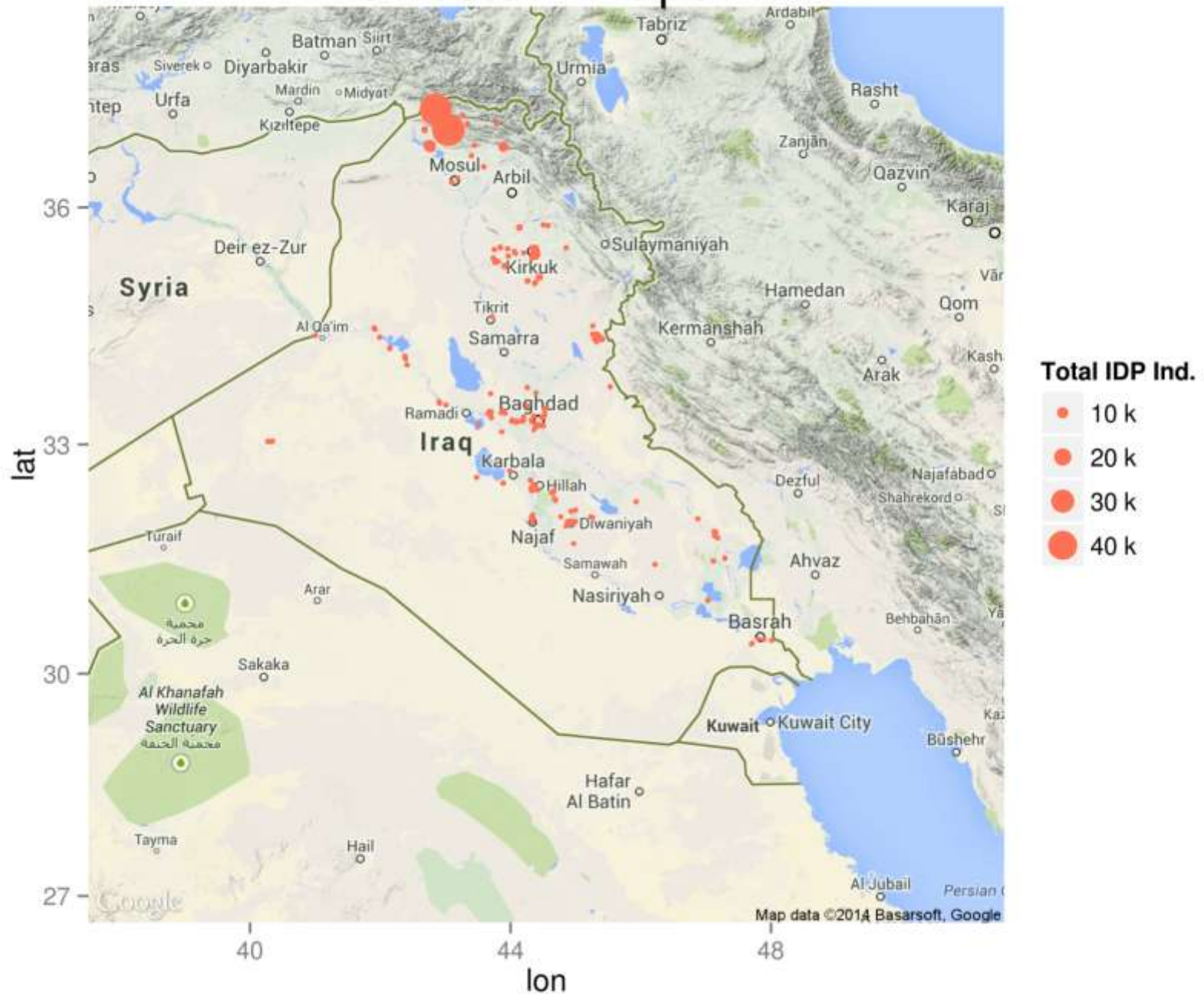
# Total IDPs per Accomodation type and Governorate



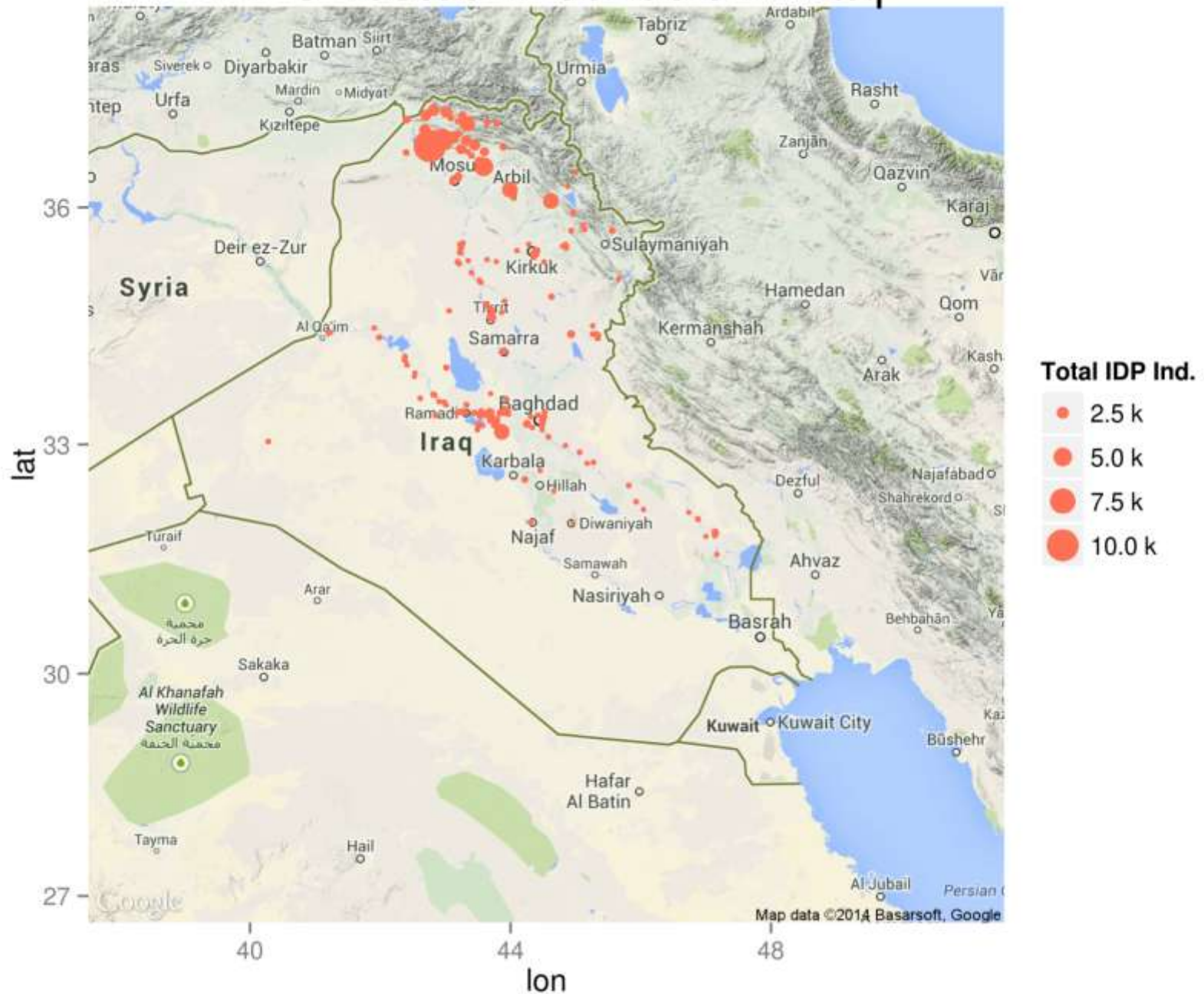
# Total IDPs per accomodation type and reported displacement date



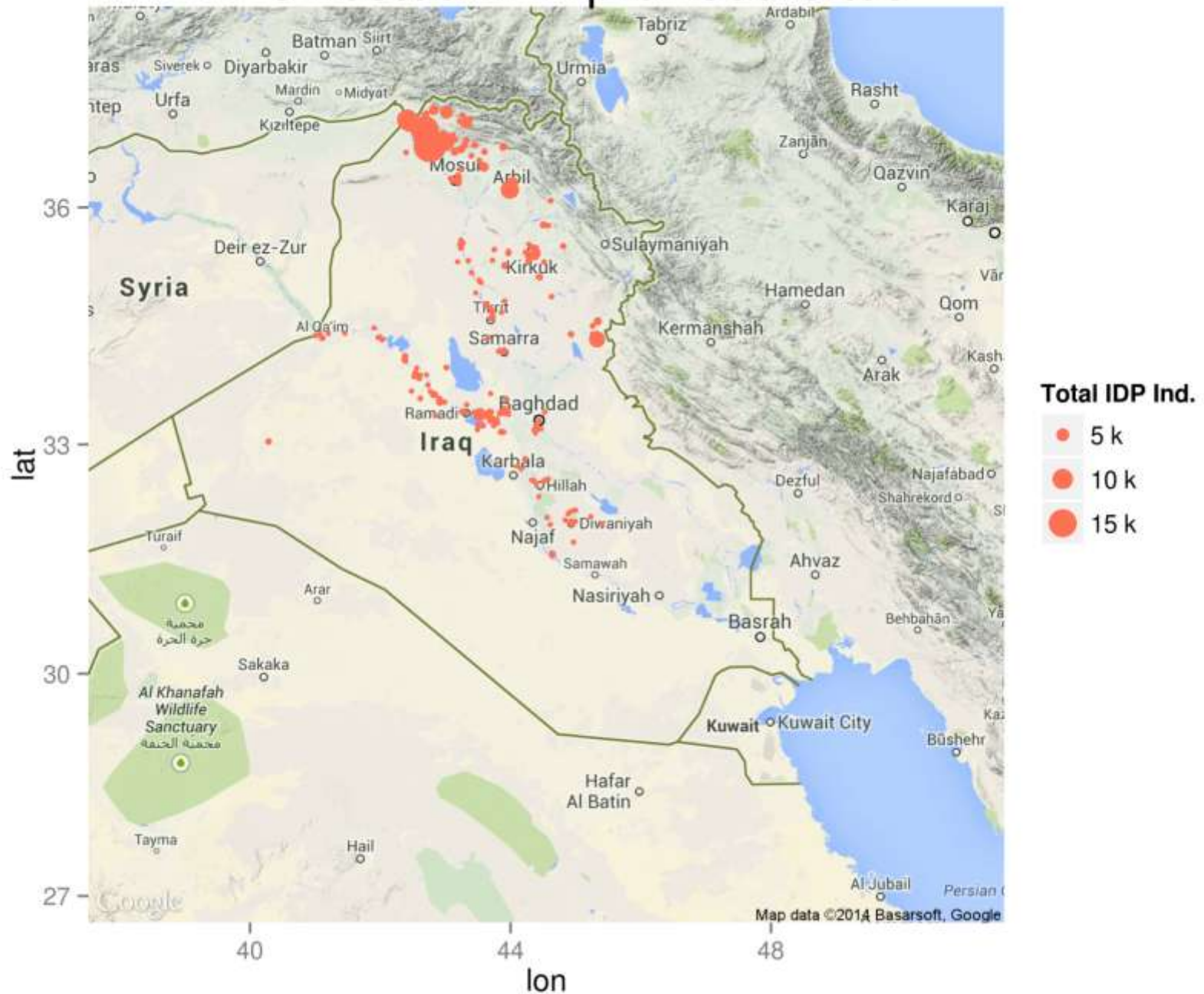

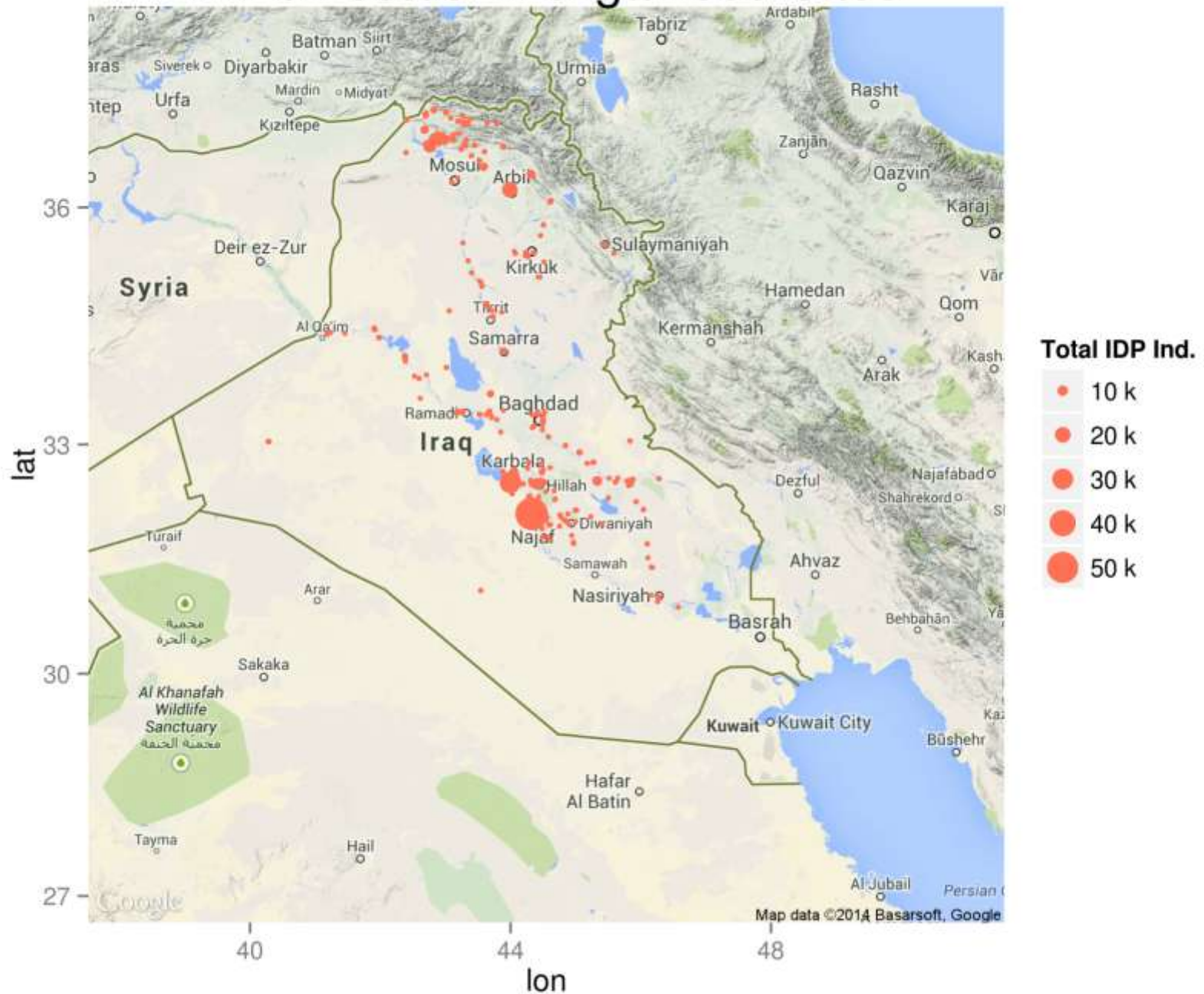

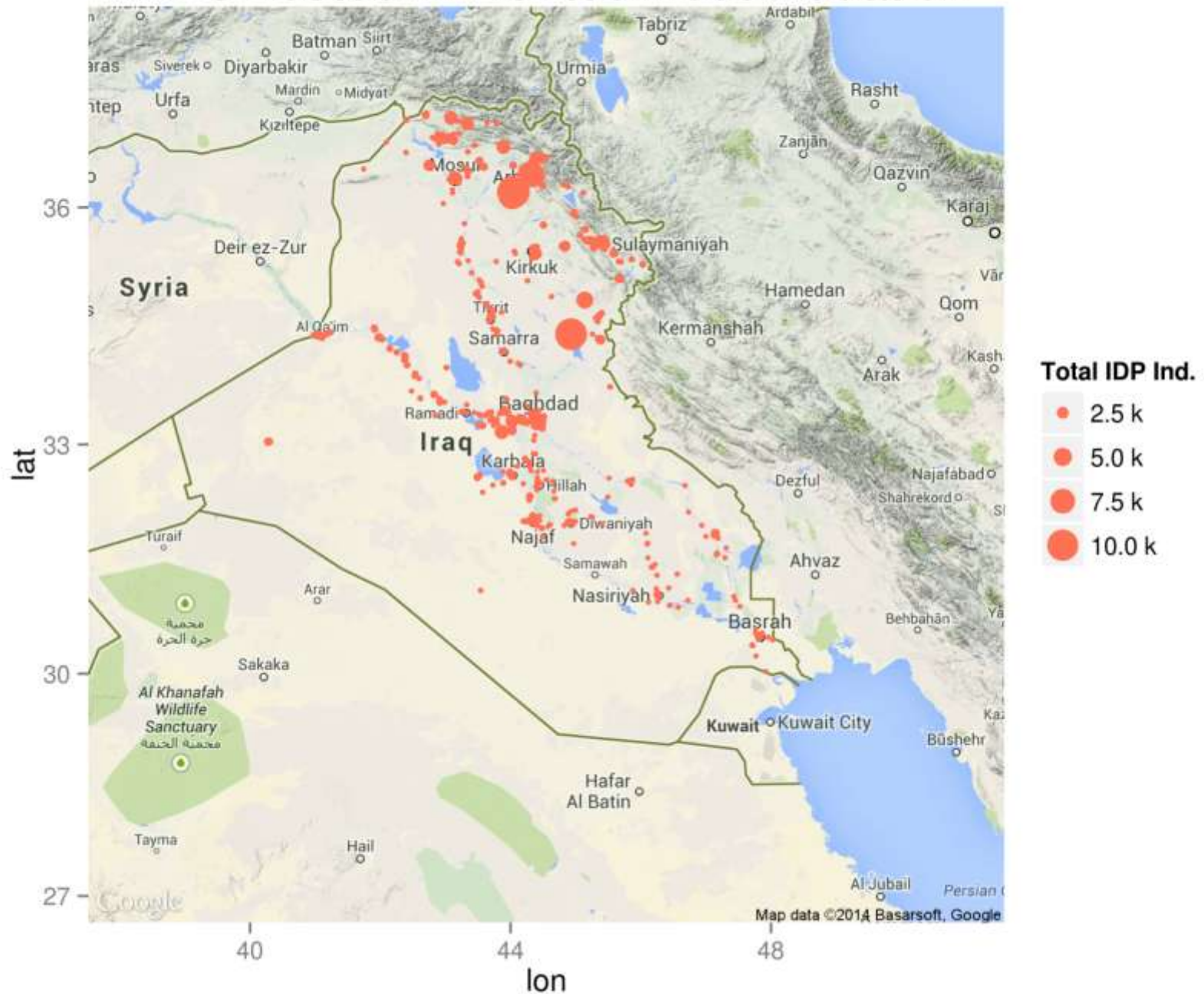

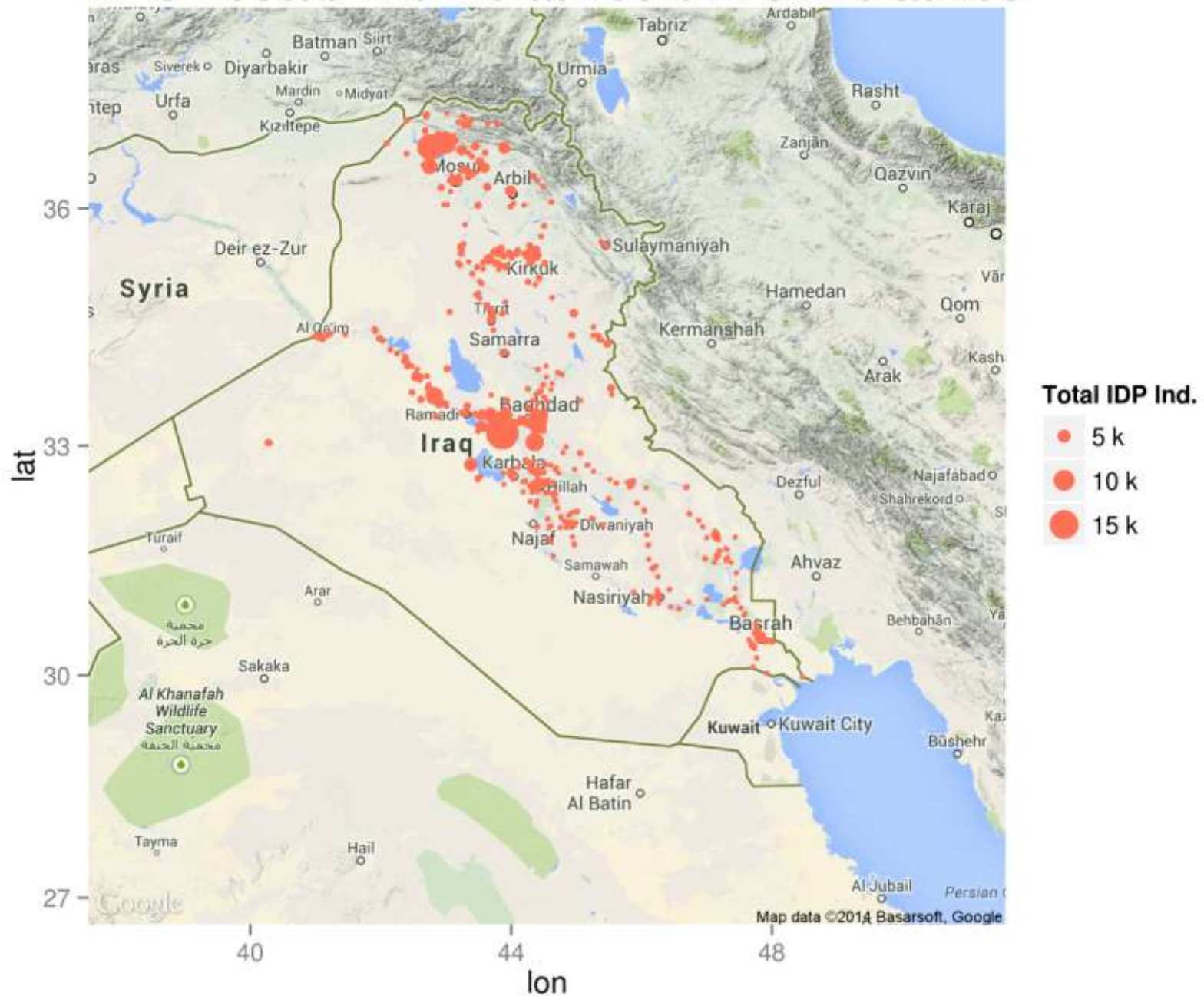
