## HIGHLIGHTS

- South-West region emergency: According to the Multisector Initial Rapid Assessment (MIRA) close to 3,500 IDPs lives in three villages within the Ballin court area: Ugang, Ballin and Bon Varegeh. The priority needs are Shelter and Non-Food Items (NFI). Displaced individuals are living in overcrowded host shelters, makeshift homes, or open-air spaces, lacking proper sleeping and cooking materials.

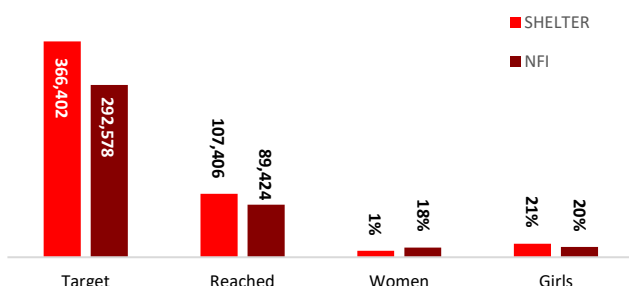
## RESPONSE

- Up to 131,474 people received NFI assistance and accessed adequate shelter through emergency – transitional – durable interventions.
- In the Far North region 11,430 households have been assisted with shelter items/kits and household items while a total of 6,690 households gained access to transitional/emergency shelters and 1,485 got their house rehabilitated or reconstructed.
- In the North-West, South-West regions 9,568 households have been assisted with shelter items/kits and household items while 645 households gained access to shelter through rental support.

## GAPS / CHALLENGES

- Operational capacity drastically decreasing in the North-West, South-West regions
- Lack of a contingency stock
- Partners capacity in applying for funds and absorb them
- Lack of flexible, timely, multi-year, local and traceable funding
- Lack of dedicated resources for Cluster Coordination in the North-West, South-West regions since more than 6 months
- Coordination between Humanitarian and Development sectors

## KEY DATES

On 17 October 2018, the Shelter Cluster was activated for the South-West and North-West regions of Cameroon to support the response to the Anglophone crisis. In the Far North region the Shelter WG exists since 2015 to respond to displacement generated by tensions at the border with Nigeria, seasonal flooding, inter-community tensions.
