HIGHLIGHTS

- As part of the global humanitarian reset initiative, the ISCG undertook a re-prioritization of the humanitarian response. Shelter/NFI targets reduced by 3%—now set at 650,500 individuals—in alignment with ERC guidance. The budget, recalculated using the activity cost methodology, now totals \$16 million, reflecting a 27.3% reduction. Priority areas identified include Donga-Mantung, Menchum, Mezam, Momo, Ngo-Ketunjia, Fako, Kupe-Muanenguba, Lebialem, Manyu, Meme, Ndian, Logone et Chari, Mayo Danay, Mayo Sava, and Mayo Tsanaga.

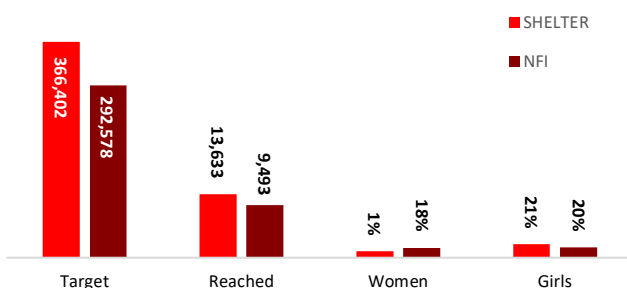
RESPONSE

- A total of 23,495 people received NFI assistance and accessed adequate shelter through emergency – transitional – durable interventions.
- In the Far North region 1031 households have been assisted with shelter items/kits and household items while a total of 1789 households gained access to transitional/emergency shelters.
- In the North-West, South-West regions 1000 households have been assisted with shelter items/kits and household items while 126 households gained access to shelter through rental support and 100 households got their shelters repaired.

GAPS / CHALLENGES

- After U.S. funds suspension two INGOs and two LNGOs have been impacted with the result that approximately 16,000 individuals won't receive households' items and rental support
- Coordination between Humanitarian and Development sectors

On 17 October 2018, the Shelter Cluster was activated for the South-West and North-West regions of Cameroon to support the response to the Anglophone crisis. In the Far North region the Shelter WG exists since 2015 to respond to displacement generated by tensions at the border with Nigeria, seasonal flooding, inter-community tensions.
