HIGHLIGHTS

- More than 120,000 people have been directly affected by the floods in the districts of Fotokol, Makari, Gouffrey, Waza, Blangoua, Lagone and Birnie, Kousseri, Zina (Lagone and Charie), Kai-Kai, Maga, Vele, Kalifou, Yagoua, Guere, Gobo, Car-Hai, Wina (Mayo Danay). Thousands of houses have been destroyed and people are now living in makeshift shelters at informal sites.
- According to the analysis of new severity indicators a total of **1,7 million of individuals are in need of adequate shelter in Cameroon** as of September 2022 (MSNA, IOM, August 2022)

RESPONSE

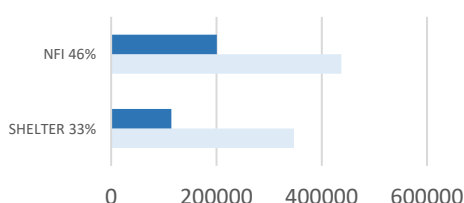
- As of 31 September in the **North-West, South-West regions**, 8315 households have received household items, 4688 households have received shelter items and 73 households were supported with rent.
- As of 31 September, in the **Far North region** 67,000 households have been reached with household items, 48,000 households with shelter items and a total of 42,000 households were supported with shelter units' construction or house rehabilitation.

GAPS / CHALLENGES

- Funds reduction which does not necessarily impact the # of household assisted rather the quality of assistance
- Due to the raising level of water several locations in the Far North region are expected to not be accessible for the upcoming months
- Lack of contingency stock
- Increase of construction material prices due to seasonal logistical difficulties (limited access due to flooding)
