#### 1. Introduction

- The shelter cluster coordinator presented the team members and agenda. She also presented the key links that cluster partners can use to access information. These being the website, the mailing list, the TwiG sign up sheet. As well as the online database links to access information on collective centers, and winterization response planning.

#### 2. Winterization planning update

- The IMO presented the active partners in reporting as well as the organizations who have not been actively reporting. The IMO urged partners to enhance their reporting as well as their winter planning reporting, specifically for those partners who have received grants under UHF. As this information is vital for the cluster to highlight funding and response gaps for winter.
- The total individuals targeted with winter support is 2.2 M individuals. The main focus of partners plans is to provide winterization non-kits NFIs.
- The biggest gap in planned winter activities vs targets set fall under: rental support, light repairs of collective centers and provision of winter clothing.
- UNHCR will target 880,701 individuals with shelter and NFI during winter. IOM will target 955,217 individuals during winter with Shelter and NFI support.

### 3. Response update and planning update partners

- As the 31st of August, 106,344 individuals have been reached with shelter support and 962,257 with NFI support by partners. As well as 2,205 individuals have been reached with winterization activities. Under-reporting remain an issue in presenting achievements and gaps in response.
- The IMO also presented the operation presence map, currently 93 active partners are present across Ukraine. You can view the partners by activities per oblast. The cluster will look into producing map on Ramada level.
- Gaps per Oblasts have been presented, and an interactive dashboard will soon be published on the website. Gaps vs. Progress on activity has also been presented.
- The funding status has been presented; 51 per cent of the funding requested has been received (477 million USD).
- Stock and pipeline have been presented and the segregation between winter items and the regular NFI items. These being: thermal blankets, heating appliances, solid fuel, and winter clothing.

### 4. CCCM updates on UHF

- Key CCCM objectives under UHF allocation has been presented. Of which, two objectives are cross-cutting with shelter and NFI activities, these being: Improving living conditions in collective sites (CSs) through enhanced site coordination and management and strengthening self-organization of displaced population and improve access to information.
- Activities and indicators considered under each objective has also been presented.

### 5. UHF Updates from Shelter Cluster

- A new allocation has been announced under UHF of 50 M USD. To fall under two envelopes with a duration of 12 months. Linkage to CCCM and protection activities as well as working with volunteer groups is encouraged. The proposals should not be seen with only shelter and NFI focus.
- Two information sessions will be organized to guide partners on applying and budget development.

### 6. ICCG updates

- OCHA presented a country-wide winterization plan has been presented up to March 2023.
- HNO and HRP update; a discussion on data received and data needed for calculation of severity of need and number of people in need. The 19<sup>th</sup> of September is the deadline for the calculation.
- Shelter Cluster is looking into government data sources that are available to aid the calculation on the number of people in need; these include damages map, employment rates data, government budget and plans for responding to needs.
- The MSNA will be initiated in the 20<sup>th</sup> of September and its findings will be included in the revision of the figures later on in February.

### 7. Sub-national level cluster coordination highlights

- Coordination focal point for the central part of the country has contributed to the development of the winterization SOP and will be finalized. The subnational meeting for central region is planned on Friday at 15:00. He will also be meeting with deputy-governor of Vinnitsa oblast to present winterization plans.
- On the east: Kharkiv city has shared lists of needs for shelter and NFI intervention. Need to upgrade interventions in newly liberated areas in Kherson. Subnational level meeting for the east will be held on Thursday at 15:00.

## 8. TWiG updates

- The final draft of winterization SOP will be shared for final comments before the TWiG meeting for input of partners.
- Light and Medium repairs guidance note will be published, however, in case of individual cases that need further guidance, the TWiG facilitator Andrea would be available for further discussion.
