



Condition shelter: Essential (Yellow), Urgent (Orange) and Critical (Red), based on the observations of the enumerators on 10 criteria. These criteria include: (1) shelter condition score, (2) age of shelter, (3) number of shelters per household, (4) "availability" of separated sleeping spaces, (5) material of the floor, (6) material of the walls, (7) material of the roof, (8) presence of a door, (9) number of layers, (10) holes in the roof coverage.
