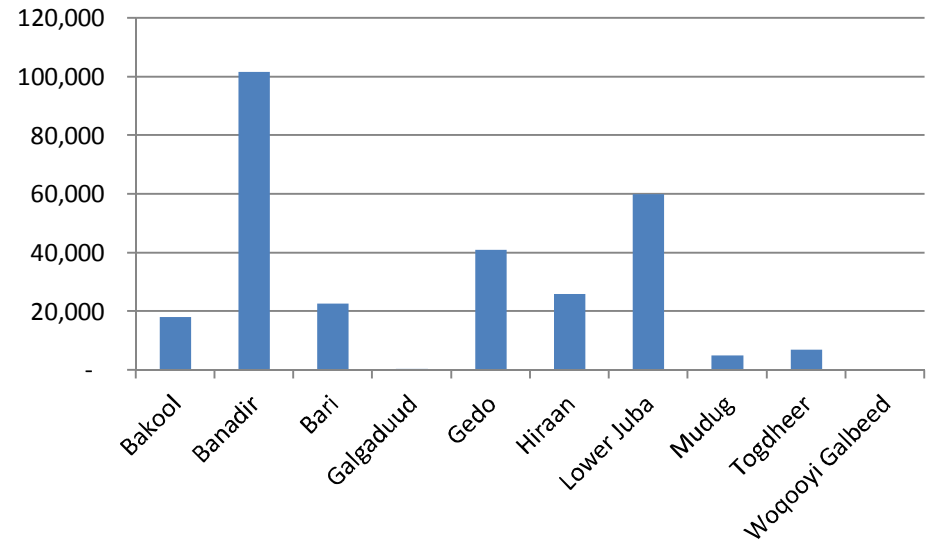
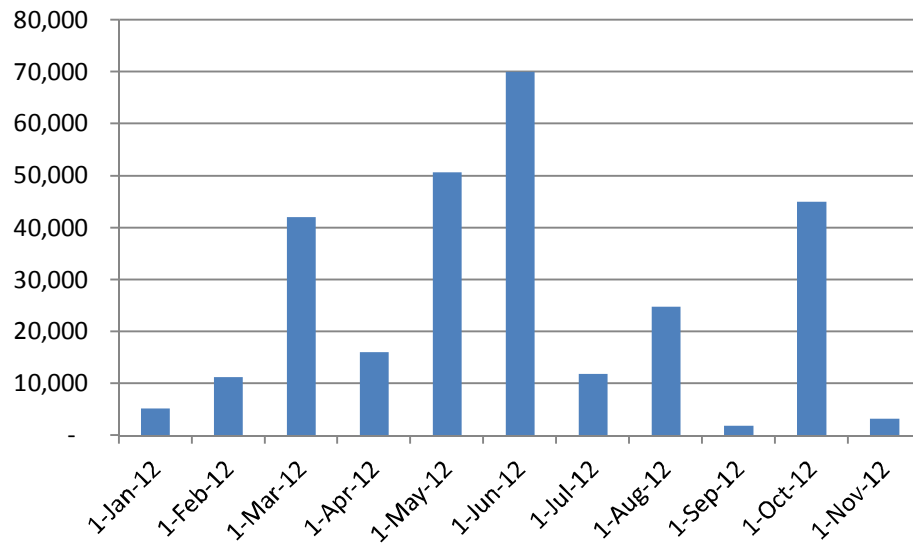


For 2013, the NFI strategy needs to be clarified:

- i. The purpose of NFIs is for life-saving interventions,
- ii. Loss of all household items is life-threatening,
- iii. Loss of household items can be caused by fire, flood, storm, displacement due to drought / famine or conflict,
- iv. No more regular distributions to the protracted displaced, replace with livelihood interventions,
- v. Ensure all zones are covered by pre-positioned stock so that response can be fast = life-saving,
- vi. Distributions can be triggered by referrals, more integration of activities
- vii. Distributions can be triggered by return.

NFIs

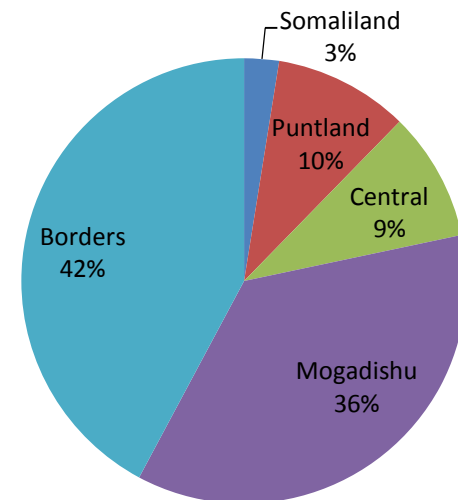


2012 Total = 281,862 (2nd half of Nov and Dec to add) – total for Cluster = 645,912 –
UNHCR = 44%

2013 Target for NFIs = 750,000 (whole cluster)

UNHCR = 300,000 – 40%

Total CAP 2013 estimates = 795,000
