1	<b>Debrief on AlHudaydah hub mission</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Deputy Cluster Coordinator (DCC) briefed the participants on the Shelter Cluster Team (SCT) mission to Al Hudaydah hub which took place on 27 to 31 of March. The mission was supported by the Al Hudaydah Sub-National Cluster Coordinator and had field mission to IDP hosting sites in Al Hudaydah and Hajjah governorates. It was observed that there is a desperate needs for shelter including maintenance and upgrade, NFI and providing solutions for natural factors such strong winds and extreme heat. It was also observed in some sites good skills with IDP households upgrading by themselves emergency shelter to more durable solutions using indigenous materials e.g., clay and thatch. In addition, SCT met with the local authorities and SCMCHA to advocate for alternative sites or lands for the IDPs in sites under eviction.</li><li>- Cluster Coordinator (CC) outlined the recommendations that came up from the mission. 2	<b>HLP Working Group</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Depkia, the Housing, Land and Properties coordinator, was introduced to the participants as she has newly arrived to Yemen. She mentioned that HLP working group will be established which will be led by UNHCR with 2 International or National NGOs. It was explained that the objective of the TWiG is to facilitate a systematic approach to identifying and addressing HLP issues affecting the displaced population, returnees and host communities in Yemen. The membership is open to all Cluster's partners, which will be voluntary and self-nominated basis. 3	<b>Updates on the 2022 Humanitarian Programme Cycle (HPC)</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Clusters were asked by the Humanitarian Coordinator (HC) to use the Multi-Cluster Location Assessment (MCLA) data to update the HNO 2022 analysis. It was mentioned that the MCLA was used mainly as a gap filler or in areas where it had good coverage as it showed that the UNHCR INAT/PMT data is more representative. The revised HNO was shared with OCHA reflecting 7.4m people as a PiN. Moreover, it was highlighted that changes on the district severity and PiN will be reflected on HRP targeting and budget planned to be initiated this week.</li></ul>	<b>- SCT to discuss the CCPM action plan in the Shelter Cluster Partners Consultation</b>	<b>SCT</b>	
4	<b>Flood Preparedness Plan</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- DCC mentioned that the Inter-Cluster Coordination Mechanism (ICCM) agreed to develop flood preparedness plan that was started in January and the discussion initiated at hub level to develop different scenarios. The overall ask provided for the shelter/NFI response is 33.4 million USD including activities for NFIs, Emergency Shelters, Rental Support, Shelter maintenance/upgrades and flood mitigation solutions</li></ul>
