COORDINATION

- **Influx from Lebanon Emergency:** 562,000 Estimated Individuals Who arrived in Syria from Lebanon since 24 Sep 2024.
- **Response:** NFI sector partners provided crucial assistance to newly arrived populations and vulnerable host communities. Key achievements include the distribution of 39,986 core items to new arrivals and 10,803 winter kits.
- **Recent Developments in Syria:** following the recent developments in Syria after 8 December, which led to a substantial increase in the number of returnees, This arrival, coupled with the imminent arrival of the harsh winter season, has created a critical need for essential NFIs.
- **WoS Coordination Workshop:** Early December, the SNFI sector conducted a three-day coordination workshop in Amman, bringing together coordinators and IMOs from the three hubs under the 'WoS' forum, along with the Syria Shelter Cluster focal point from the GSC. The workshop aimed to strengthen the harmonization of responses across the three hubs and finalize the activities log-frame for the 2025 HRP including sector objectives, activities, and indicators.
- **2025 HRP/ HNO:** . The NFI sector in Syria faces critical challenges. 6.6 million people need NFI assistance, with a target of 0.52 million. The financial requirement for the non-cost extension of the HRP is US\$76.9 million. Warehouse lootings severely disrupted NFI distribution, causing shortages. Urgent needs include relief items, winterization support (heating), and cooking solutions. NFI gaps remain, including heating. Priority activities: Core and Winter NFI distribution. The sector aims to provide life-saving support, improve resilience, and enhance protection. This includes mitigating harsh winter conditions and supporting domestic activity. 4Ws, PDM, field visits, and FGDs will ensure accountable programming.

RESPONSE

- **NFI Distribution:** In 2024, the NFI sector distributed NFI assistance, including core relief items (CRIs) and winter items, to 276,989 individuals. This represents only 9% of the annual target of 2.2 million individuals.
- **Core NFIs:** Core reach amounted to 42,191 individuals, representing 4% of the 1.1 million target.
- **Winter NFIs:** Winter reach from September to December 2024 reached 115,247 individuals, representing 10% of the 1.1 million target.

GAPS / CHALLENGES

- Significant funding shortages and delayed approval processes hindered NFI distribution throughout the year, impacting the sector's ability to reach those in need.
- The challenging economic conditions continue to significantly impact sector partners, particularly in terms of planning and procurement. Additionally, access and safety remain concerns in certain areas of the country, alongside limitations in partner capacity and funding.

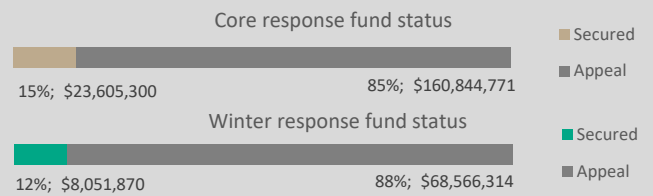
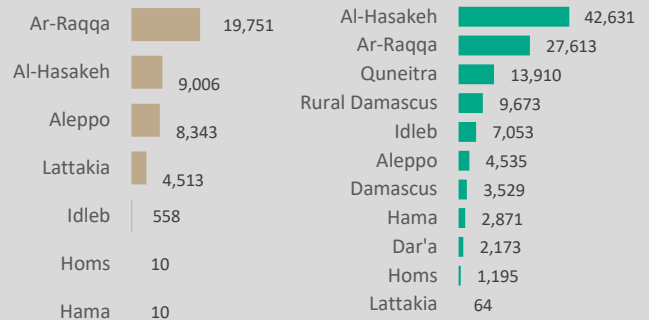

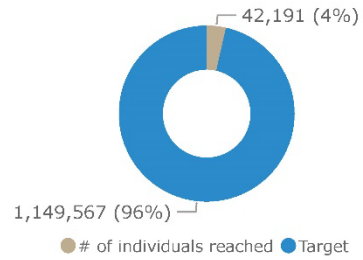

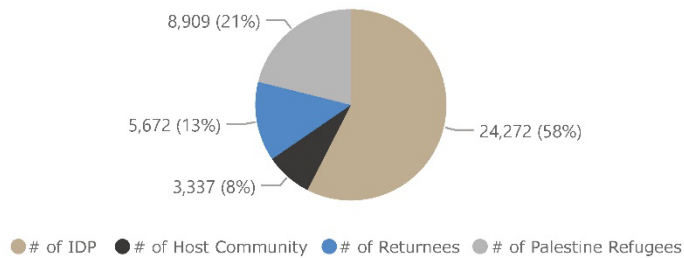
Individuals unique reach with Core NFIs



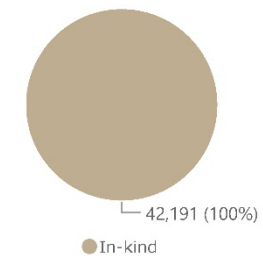
CORE NFIs, Individuals 'Reached' v 'Assisted.'



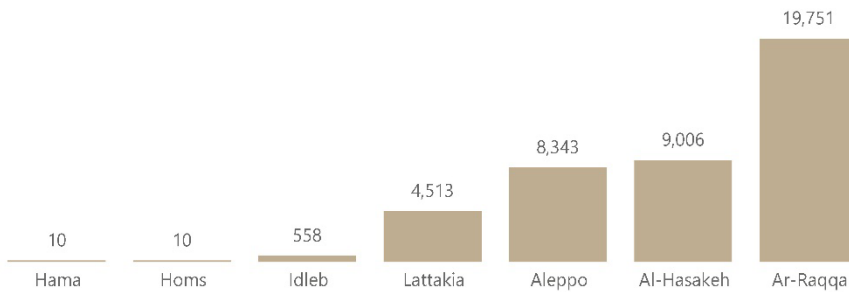
of Individuals Reached by cohort



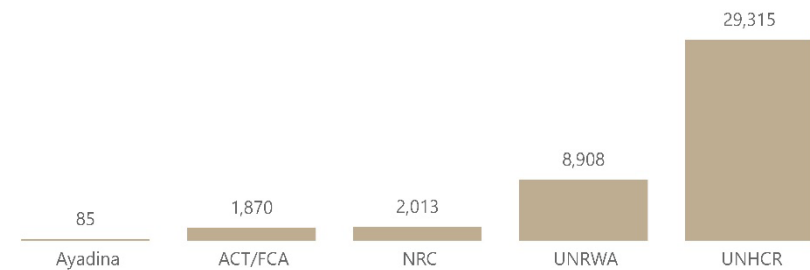
of individuals reached by Modality type



of Individuals Reached per governorates

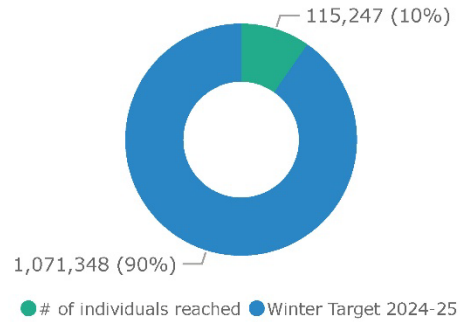

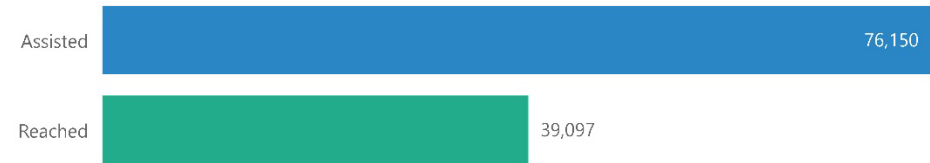

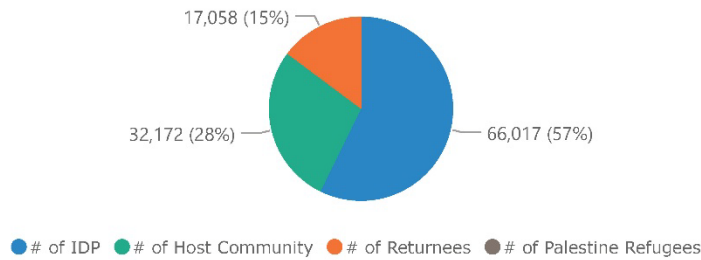
Individuals unique reach with winter NFIs



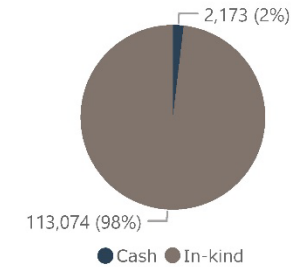
Winter NFIs, Individuals 'Reached' v 'Assisted.'



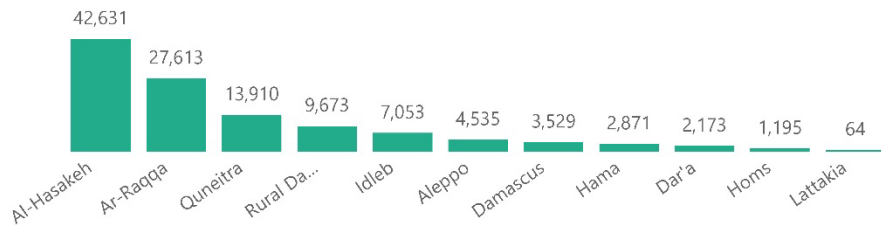
of Individuals Reached by cohort



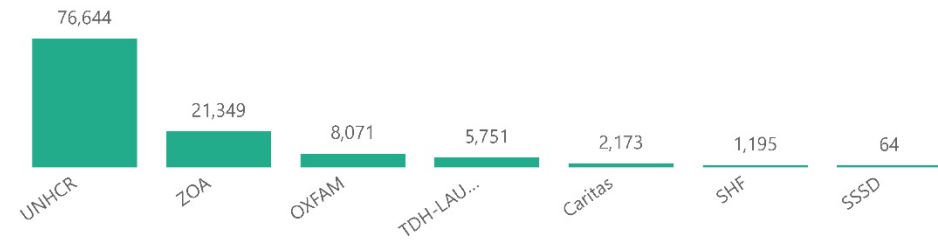
of individuals reached by Modality type



of Individuals Reached per governorates

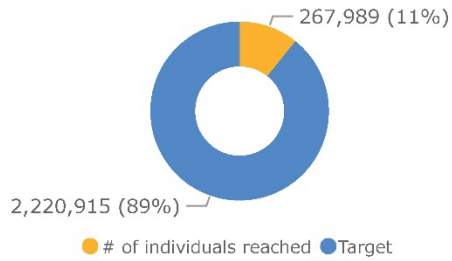

Individuals unique reach with NFIs



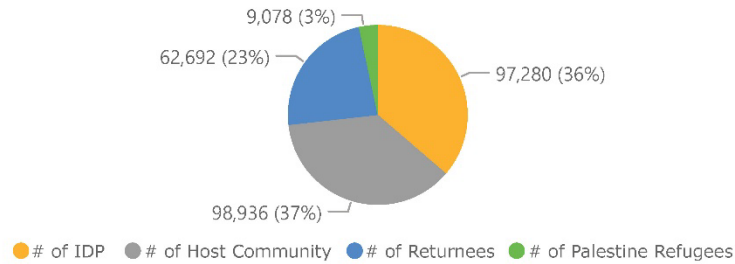

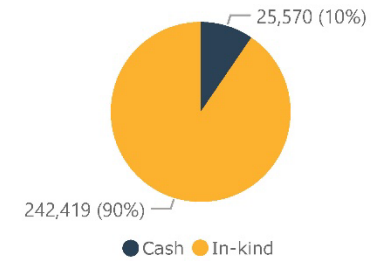

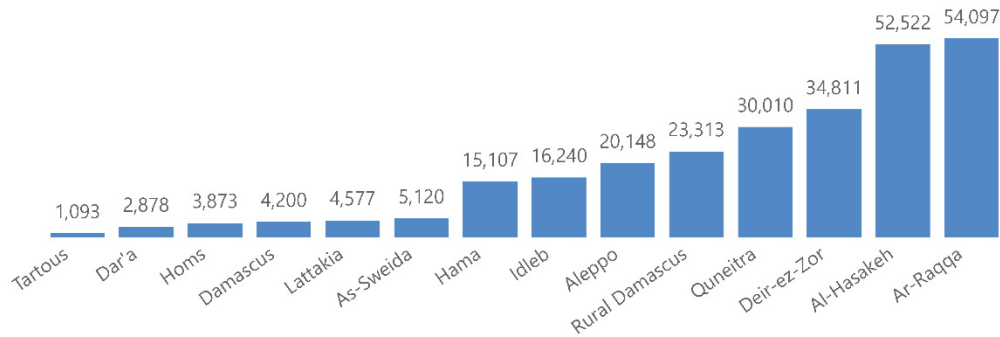
of Individuals Reached by cohort
