# FLASH APPEAL

---

- Will cover all of 2025
- NOT an HNO/HNRP. This is a Resource Mobilisation Document, not a Plan
- We are waiting for guidance on exactly where to pitch it – is it needs, partners capacity, or operational realities
- The cluster is currently working on outlining the activities – this will be much the same as 2024
- Mostly emergency, allowing for some early recovery, etc

# WB UPDATES

---

1. The total registered shelter damage cases include:
  - Approximately **2,500** housing units (HUs) in Tulkarem and Nur Shams camps.
  - Approximately **2,300** HUs in Jenin camp.
  - Approximately **150** HUs in AlFawwar camp.
2. Damage assessment is ongoing. With the current capabilities, the assessment in Tulkarem is expected to finish by the end of October. For Jenin, it is projected to be completed by mid-November. Discussions are ongoing regarding how to involve cluster partners in the damage assessment process.
3. Shelter Cluster and UNRWA are exploring the possibility of mobilizing resources to cover the damage repair gaps. The existing resources are sufficient to repair only a few hundred housing units.
4. Anticipated funding shortage around **(\$5.0M)**.
5. The cluster partners with available resources can start coordinating with UNRWA and responding within the camps.
6. UNRWA, Shelter Cluster, and the Cash Working Group (CWG) discussed how to use Multi-Purpose Cash (MPC) as a unconditional payment for light damage repair.

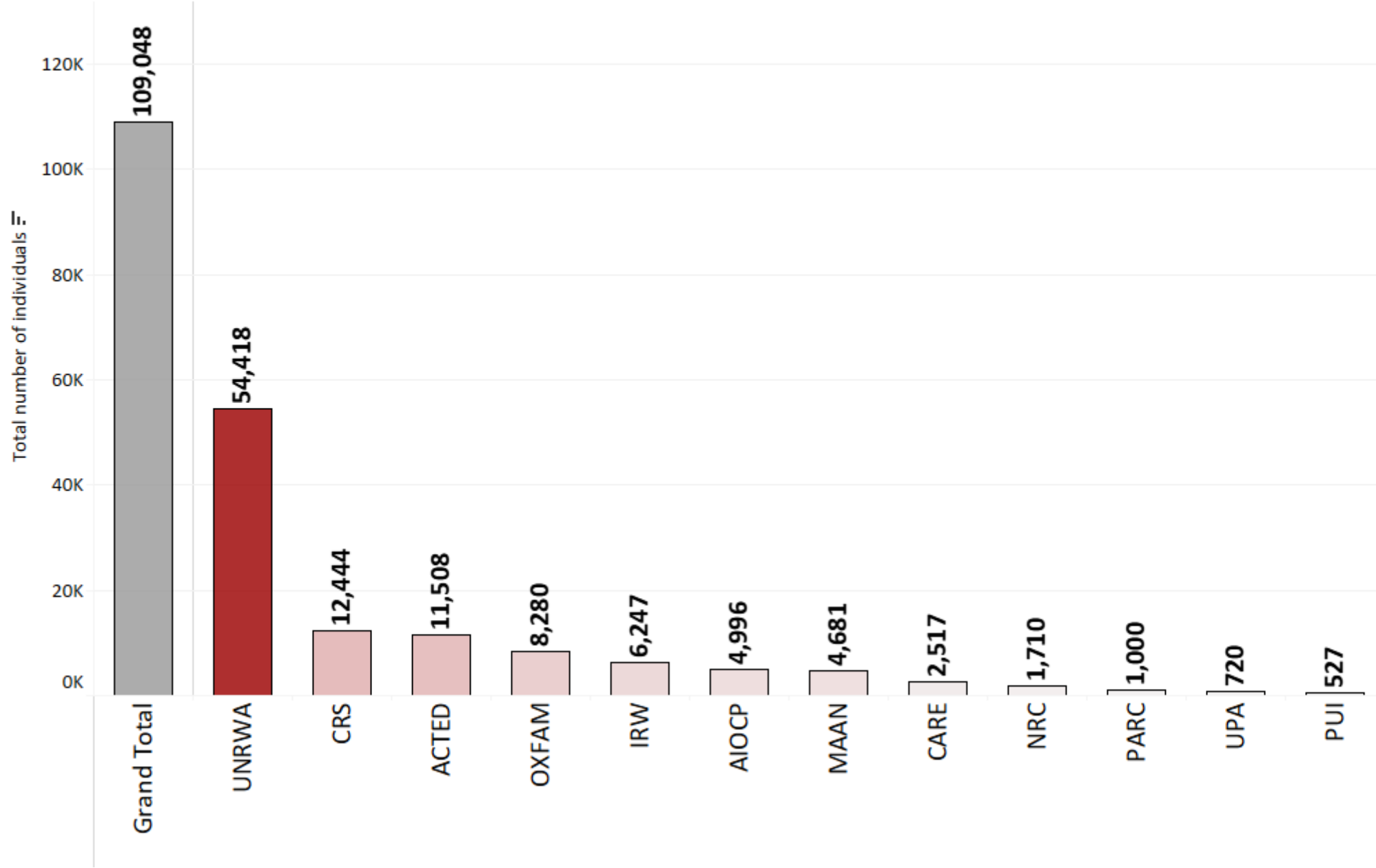

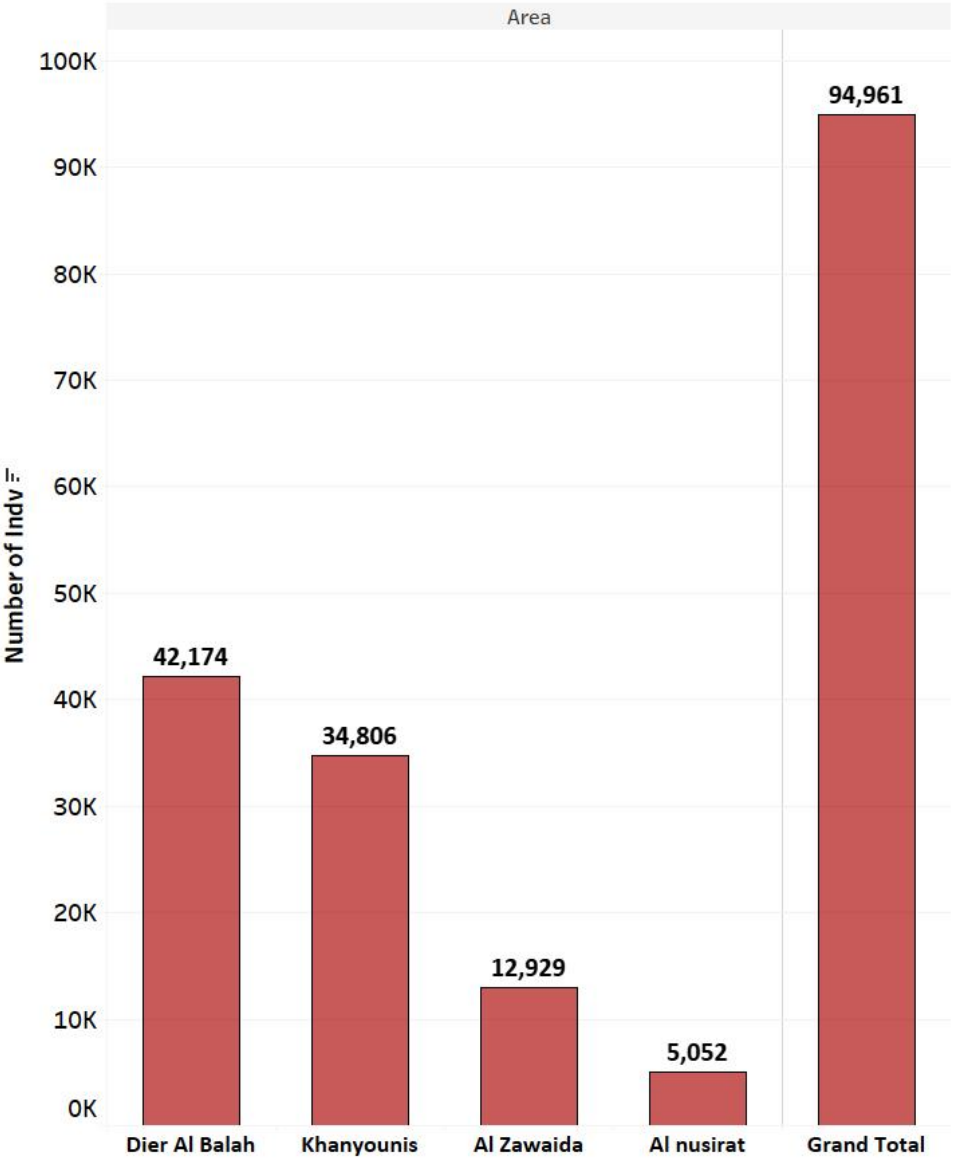
