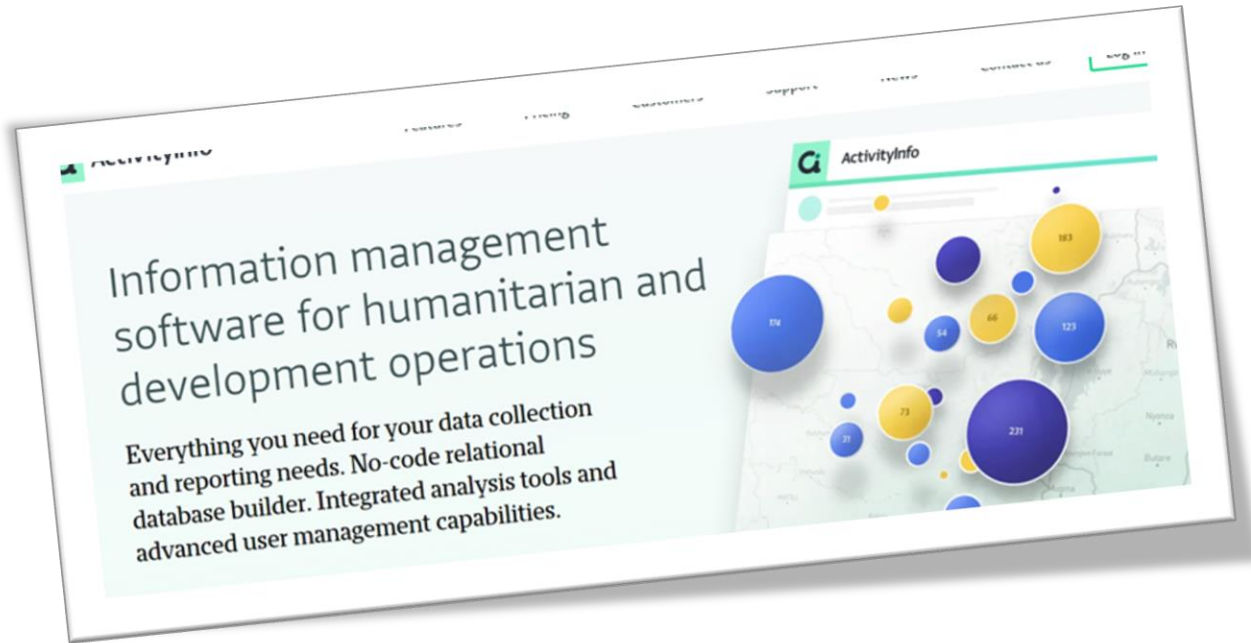

Introduction to Activity Info



- Activity Info is an online platform designed to support organizations and partners in managing, tracking, and reporting their humanitarian activities. It provides a user-friendly interface to collect, store, and analyze data related to various sectors, including shelter, WASH, protection, and Temporary Settlement Support (TSS).

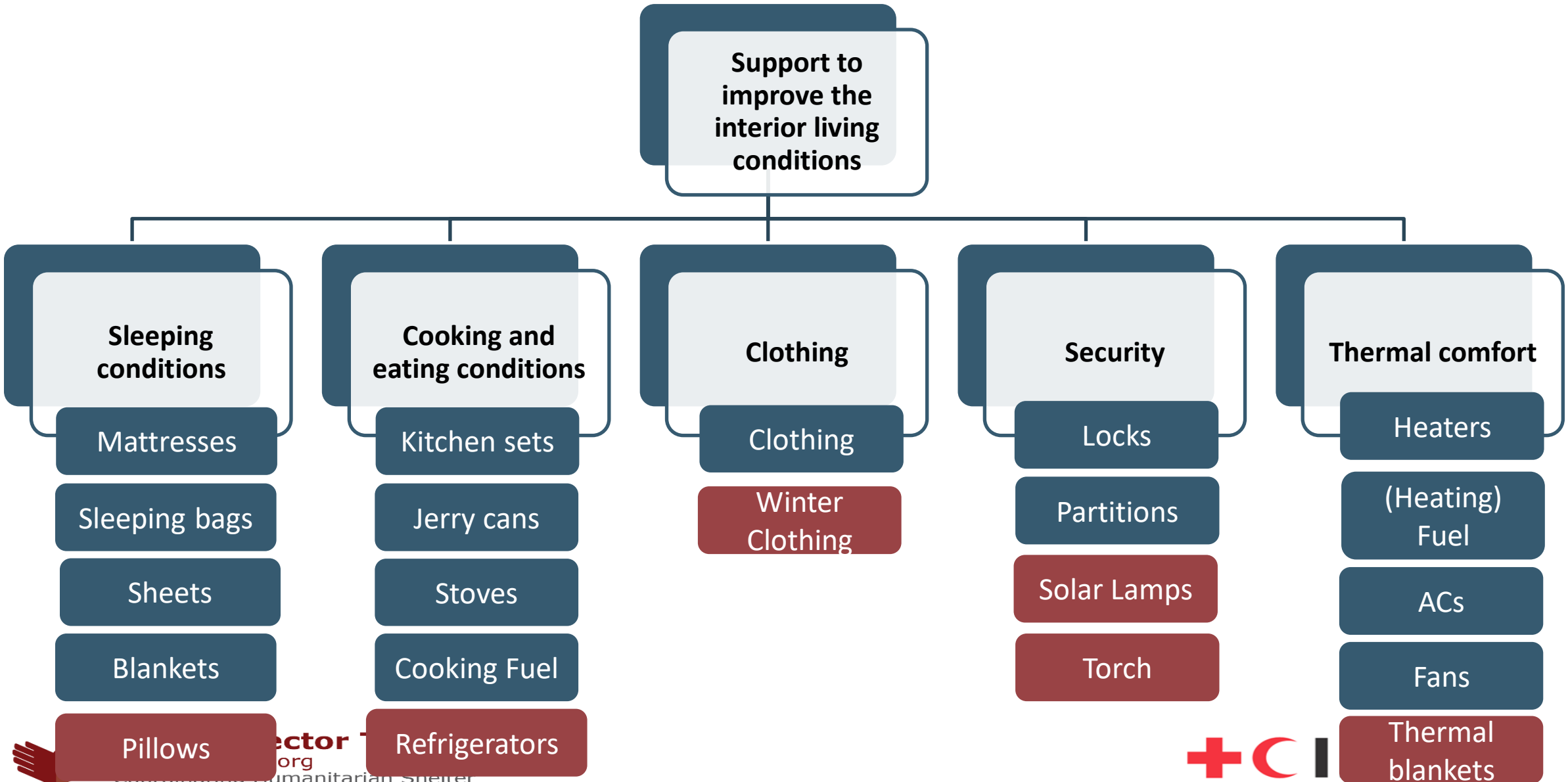

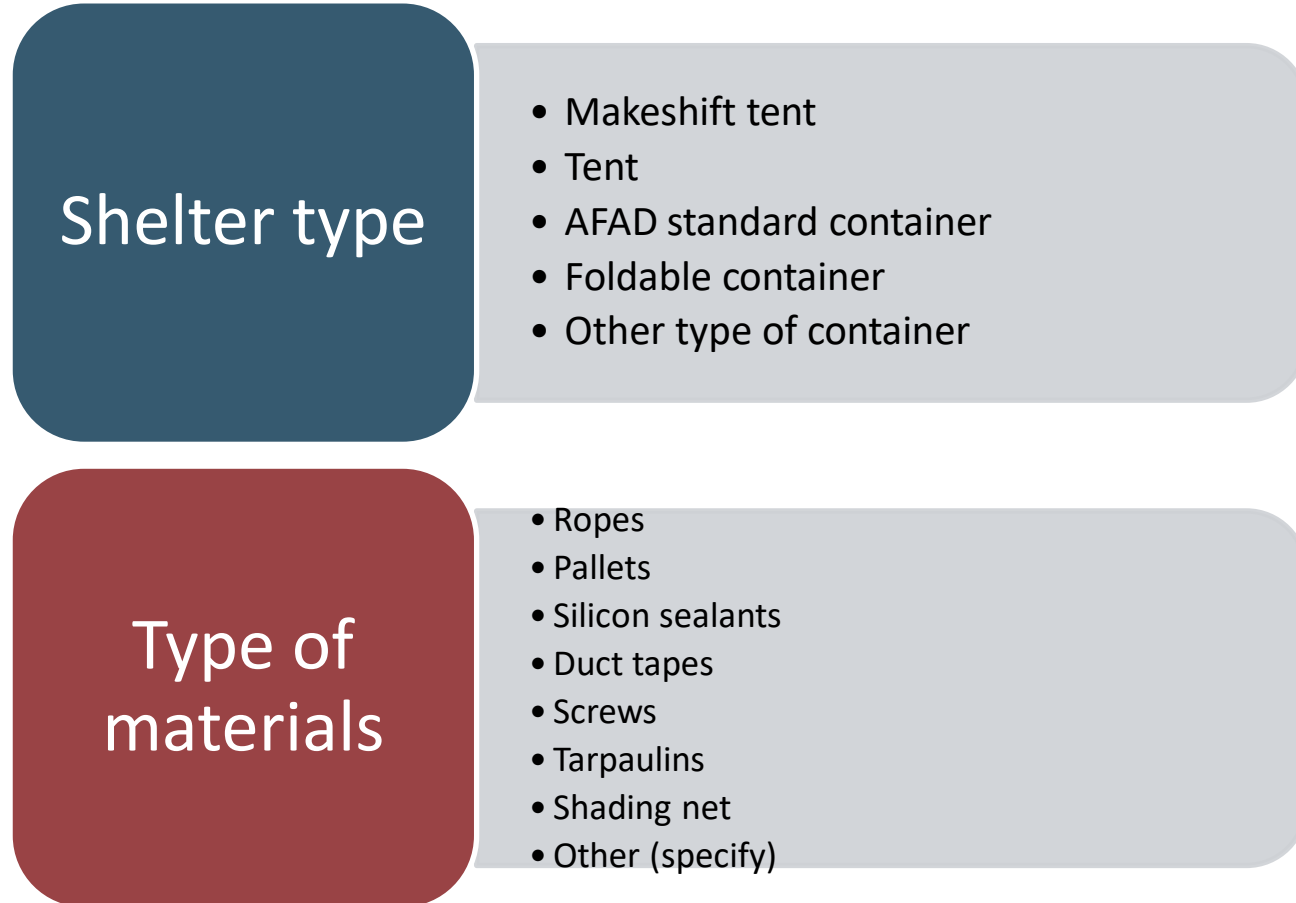

Importance of Planned Activities



Resource Allocation: Planned activities help in the efficient allocation of resources, such as funding, manpower, and materials.



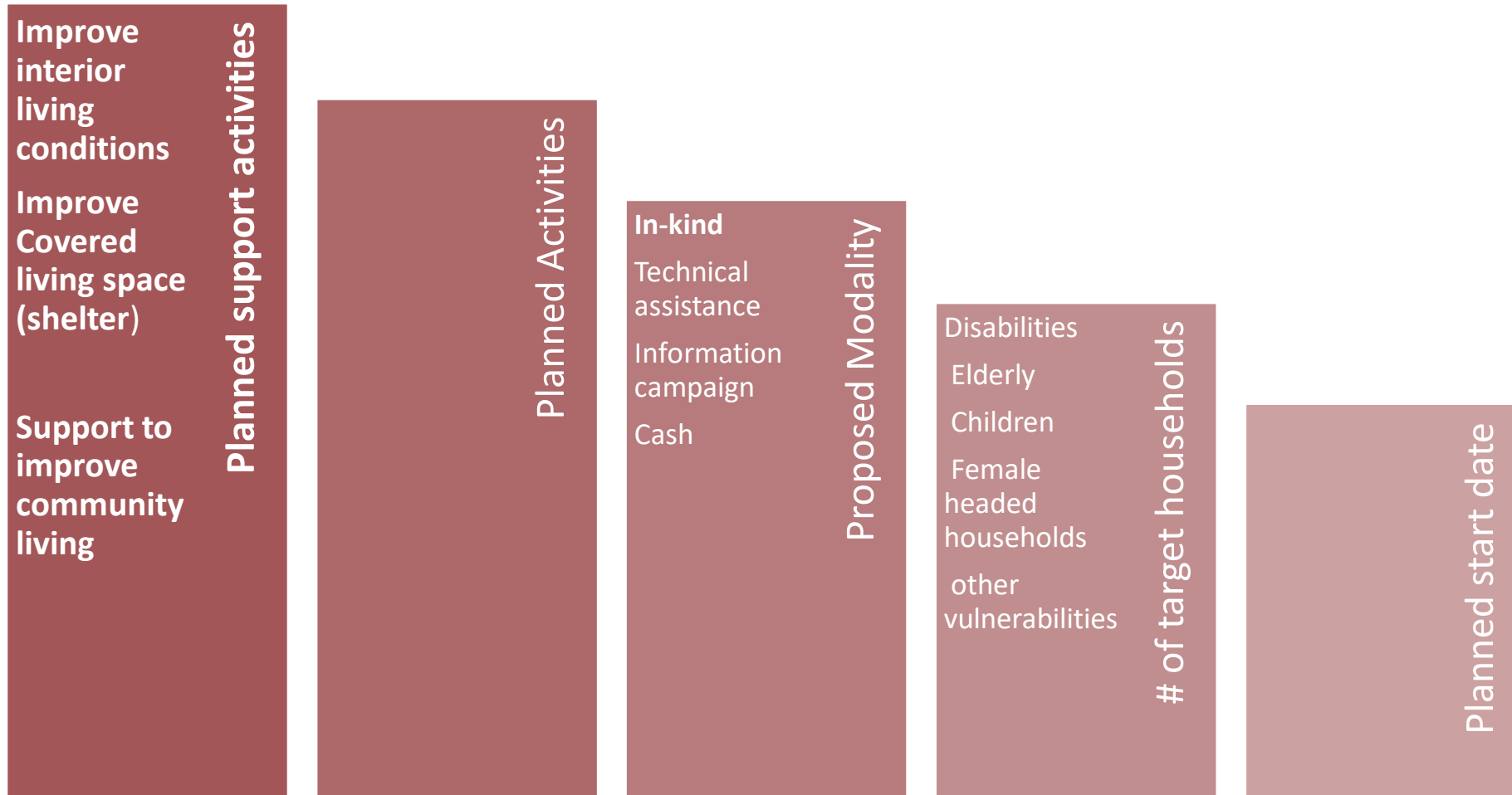
Coordination: Planning activities in advance enable better coordination among various partners, avoid overlapping and duplication.



Risk Mitigation: Planned activities can identify potential risks and provide opportunities to mitigate them.



Registration and Access

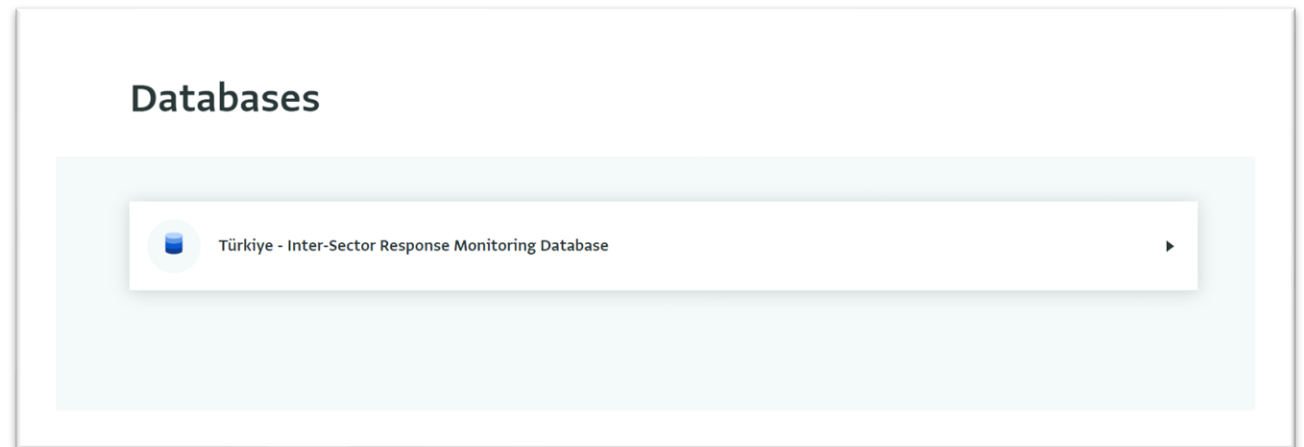
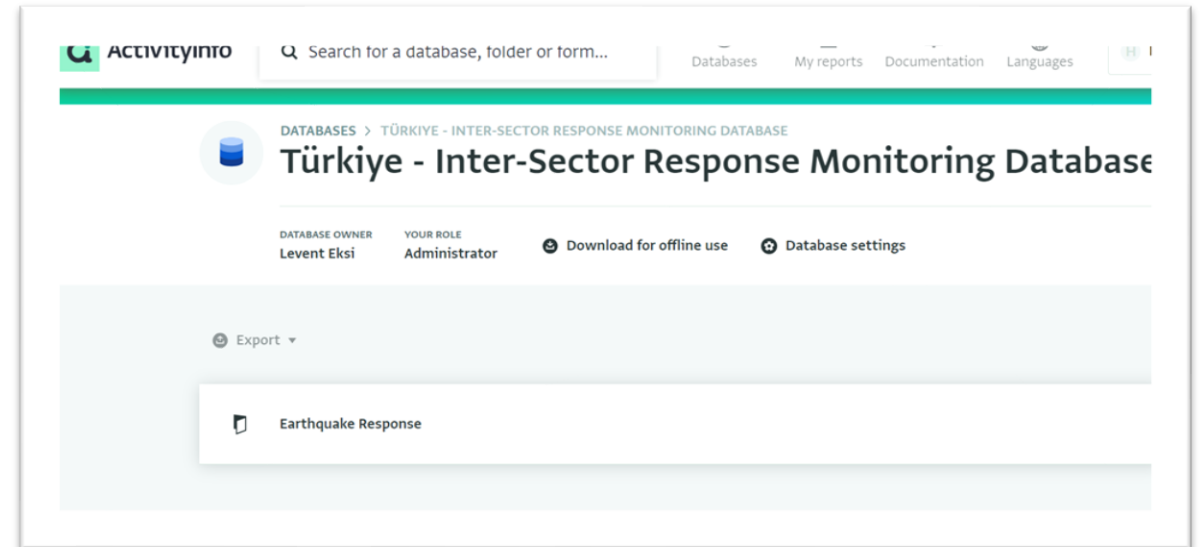
- To get started, partners need to register on ActivityInfo and request access to the relevant database for their activities.
- Each organization will have its own unique login credentials.

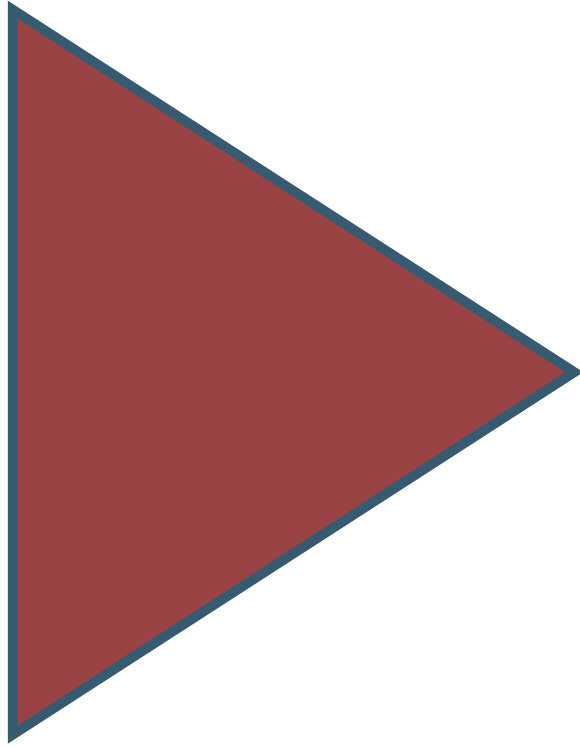
