The RPA is a **community level**, survey conducted across North-West Syria. A key informant survey was conducted to

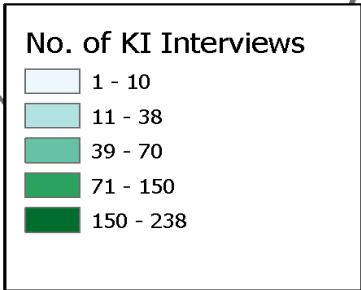
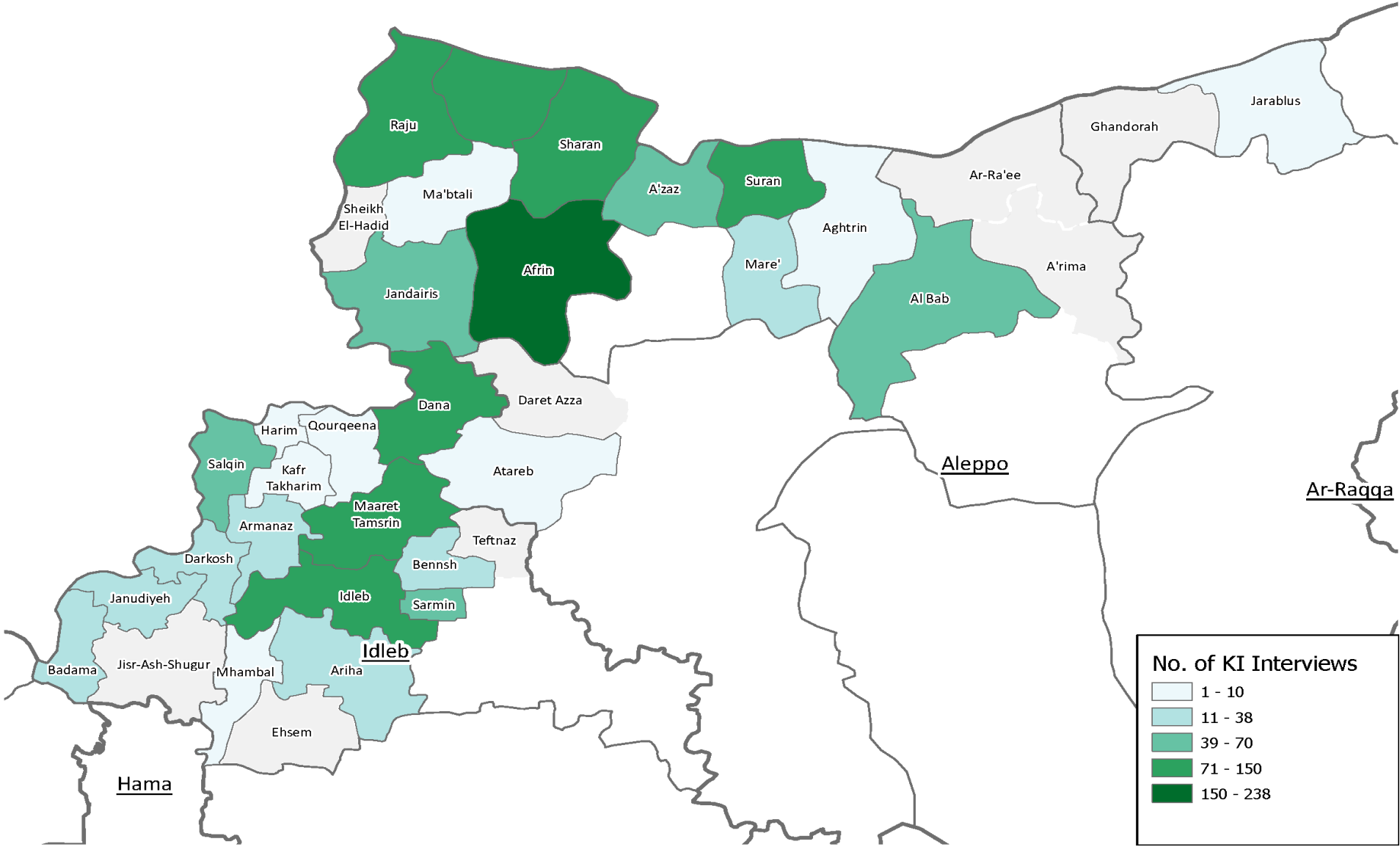
1. Identify emergent protection risks
2. Most affected population groups
3. Protection gaps

1579 key informant interviews were conducted in **259** communities across North-West Syria by **32** partners.

Sample methodology was blanket approach based on partner's capacity at the ground level. The interviews were conducted between **20 Feb 2023 to 3 Mar 2023** by protection cluster partners.

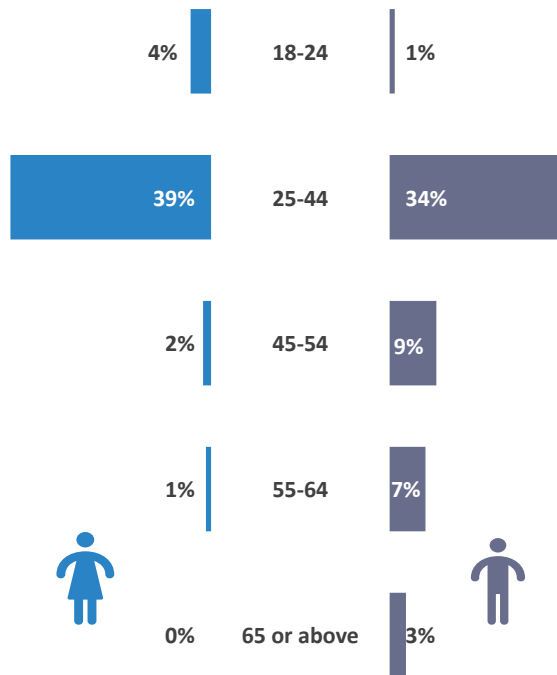

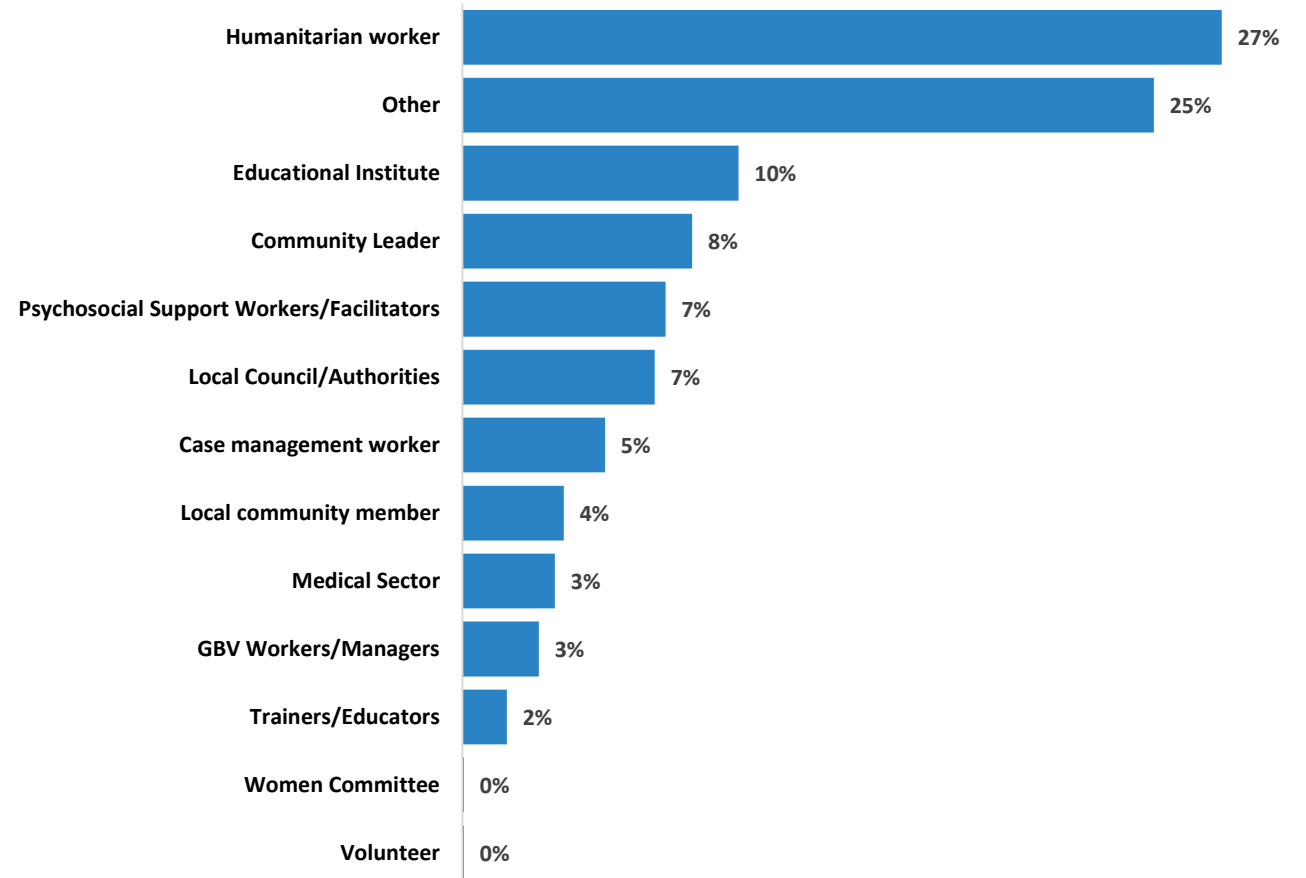

Key Informant By Roles

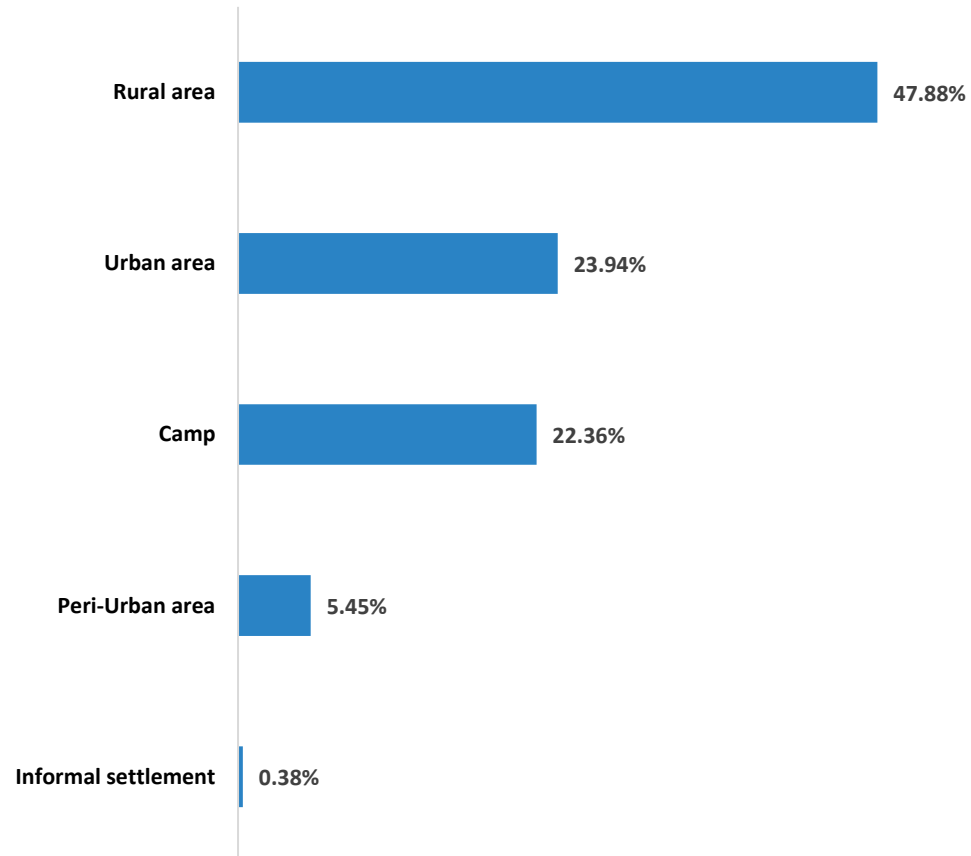

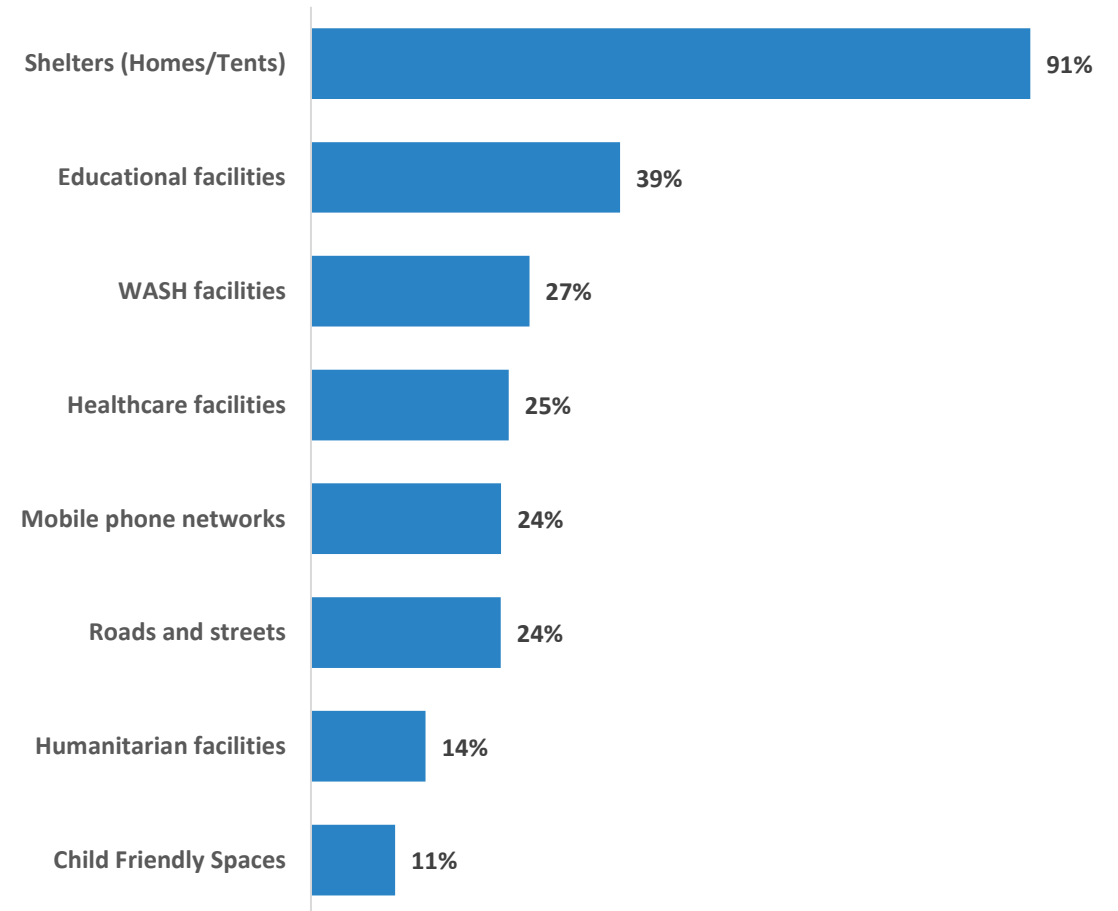

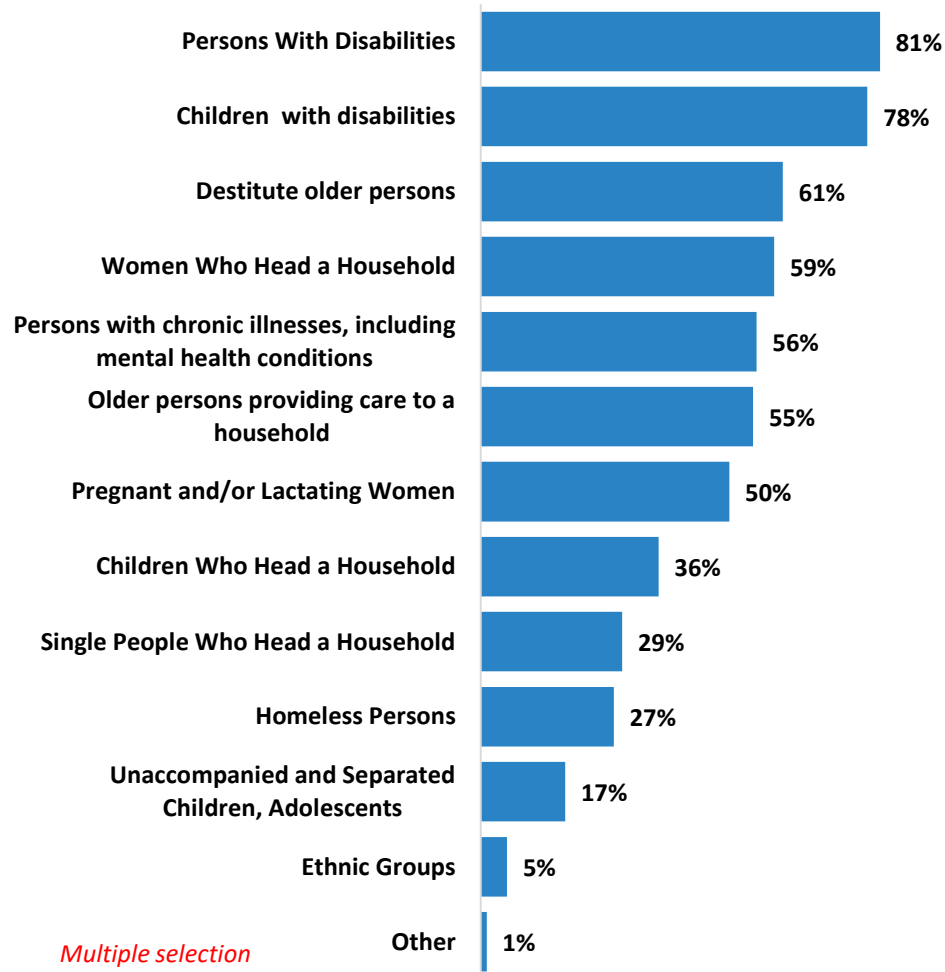

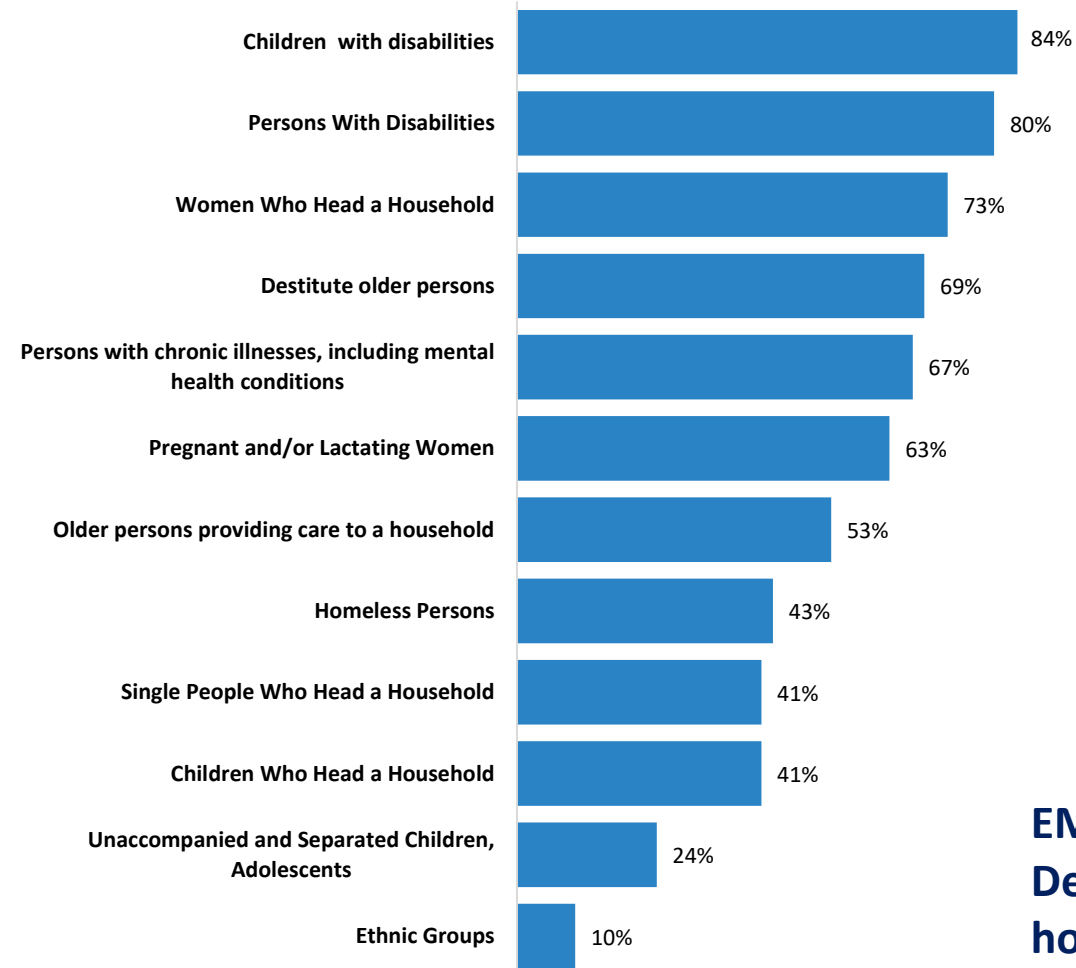

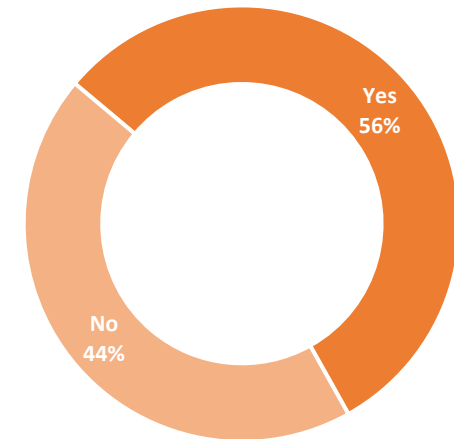

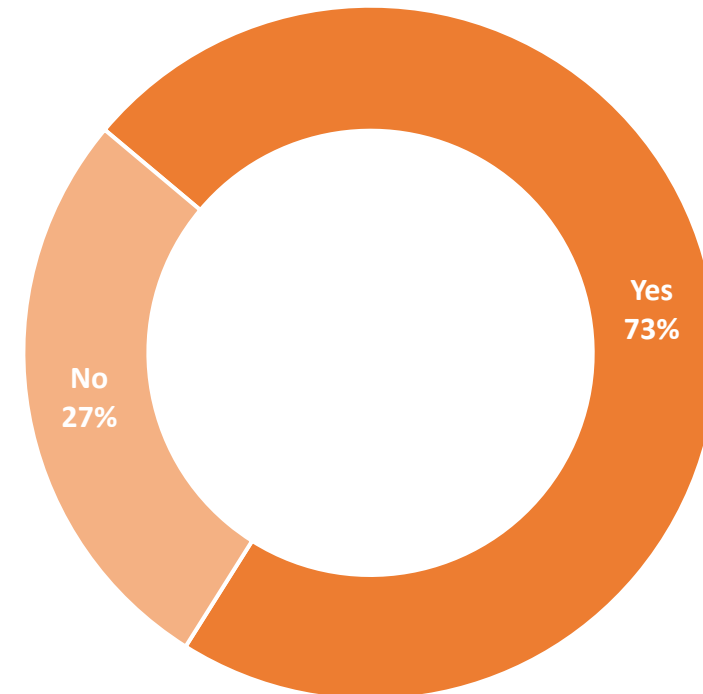

Are there any problems of housing, land and property, e.g. evictions, homelessness?

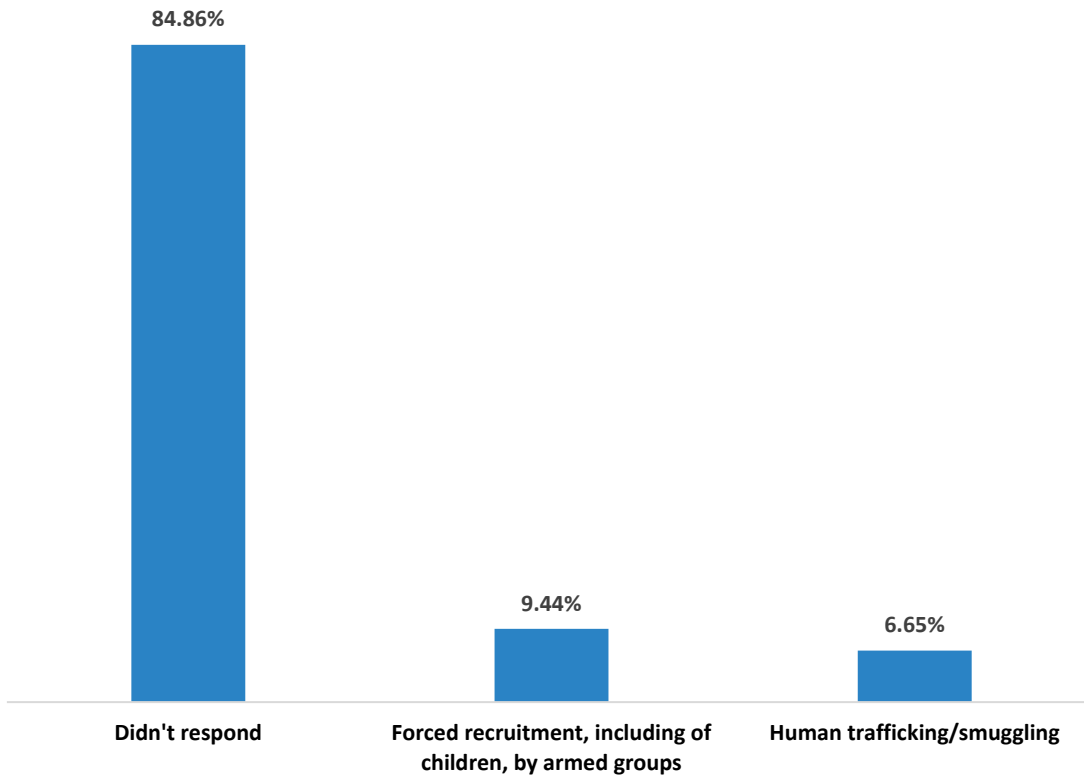

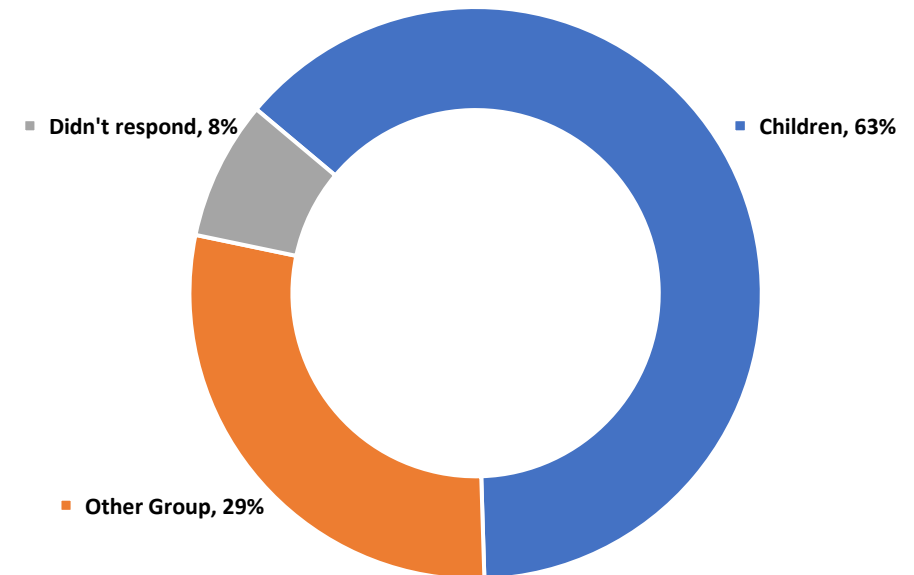

Population group affected by Forced recruitment

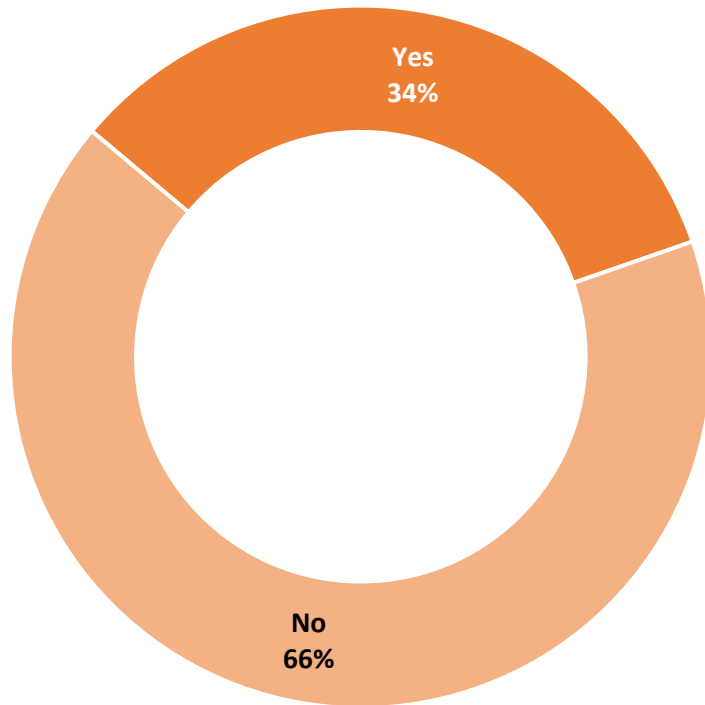

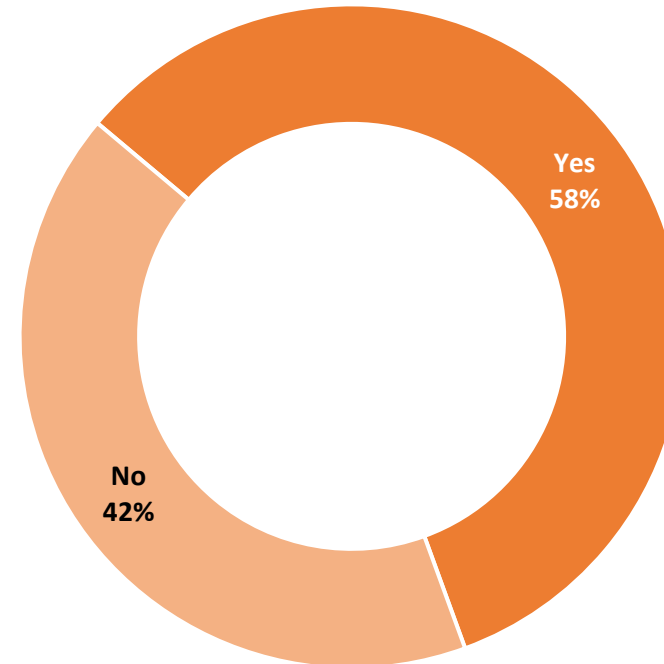

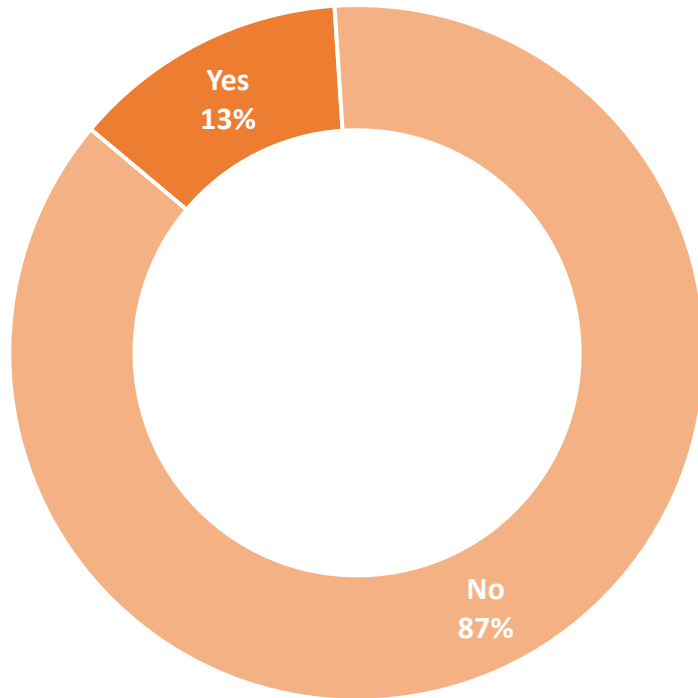

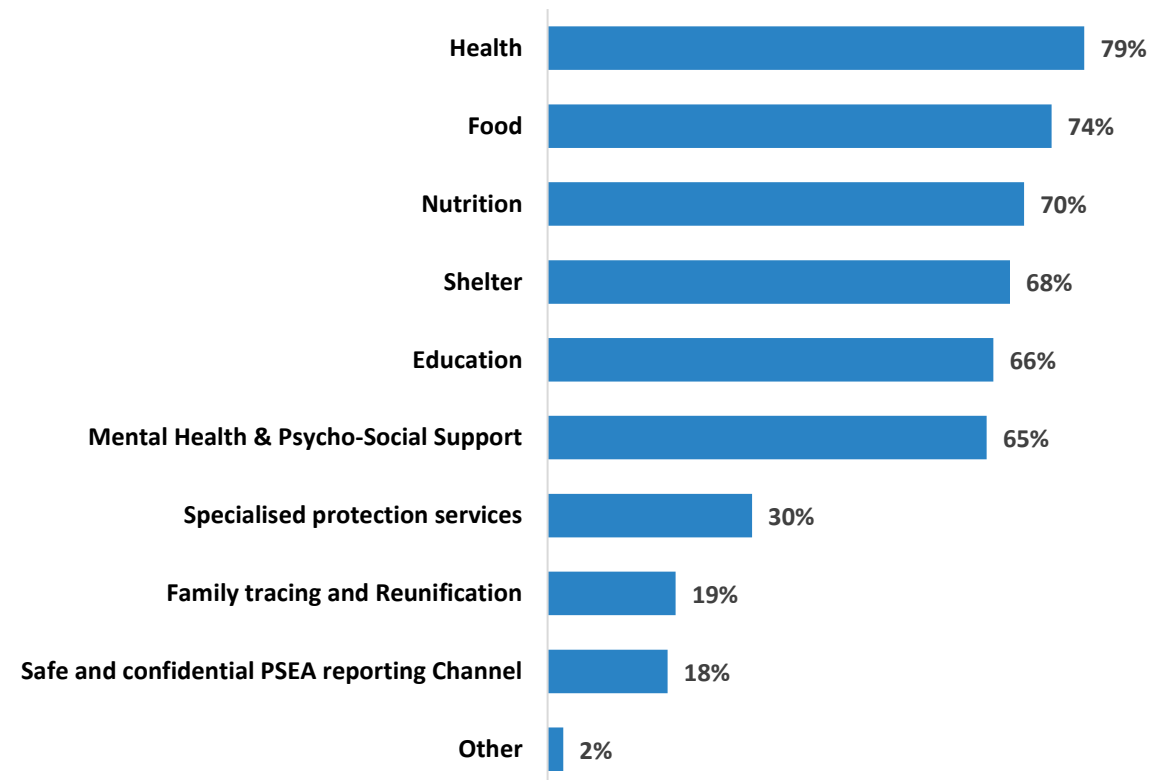

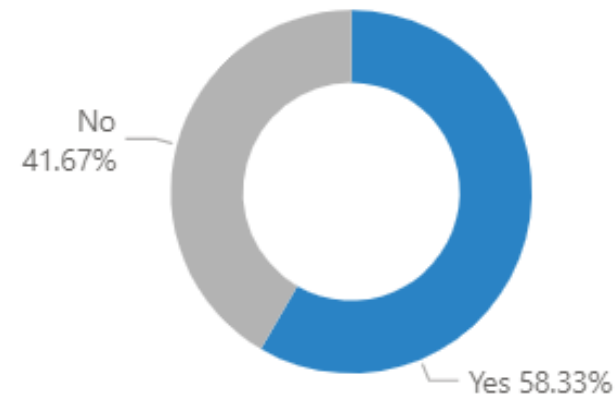

Rapid Protection Assessment – Key Messages



1. There are specific population groups facing disproportionate impacts. Persons and children with disabilities, women and children households, destitute older persons are amongst the most affected. Other emergent groups require tailored services, including homeless persons, youth and persons with chronic illness.
2. Even though some of the risks existed prior to the EQs, the current conditions of overcrowding, separated families, homelessness and lack of service provision and documentation create wider and adequate conditions to have exacerbated exposure to trafficking and forced recruitment, both risks are affecting children and other population groups.
3. Evictions, civil documentation and legal related issues are one of the main issues referred by KI's.
4. Assistance and protection services are presented as a significant gap in many of the communities, particularly linked to health, nutrition and shelter, as well as to the provision of tailored protection services.
5. Mainstreaming among cluster partners the identification of these issues can contribute to the implementation of protection risk mitigation strategies.
