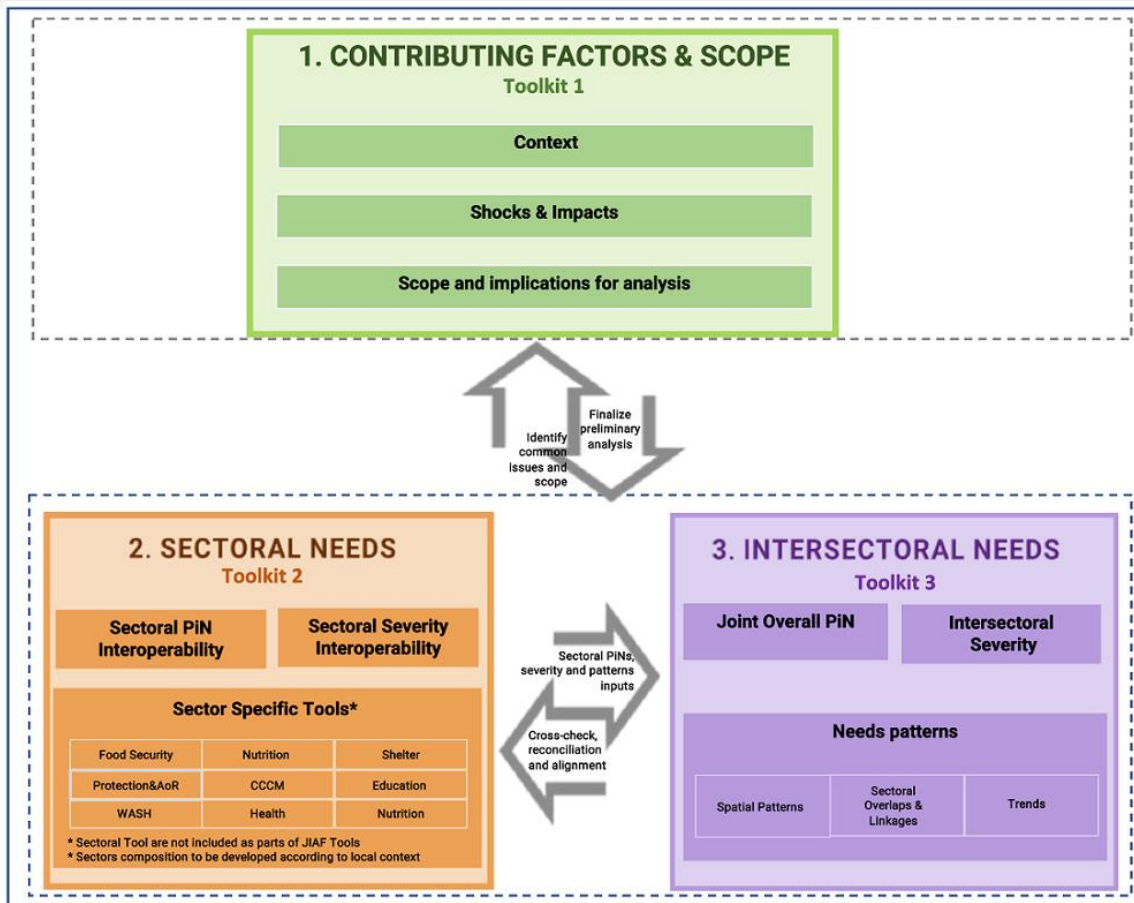

- Maintaining emergency preparedness and response capacities
- Using more cash based interventions/assistance and where markets are not available, resolve to in-kind assistance including for emergency response but with technical support despite the modality. Cash-based assistance for Shelter and NFIs will be conditional. However, for NFIs will be flexible to allow families buy the items they need
- Integrating the environment in all shelter activities to mitigate further negative impact using the NEAT+ tool
- Support transitional localized shelter solutions until durable solution is found for mainly protracted IDPs and those who are not willing to return.
- Support minor rehabilitation (cost \$1,200 - \$2,500 of houses in return areas to sustain returns and improve the living standards of the most vulnerable families
- Promote the centrality of protection including AAP in all shelter activities as well as inclusion (making shelter accessible)
- Promote the settlement or area based approach through integrated response with other clusters/sectors to generate shelter and protection outcomes
- Enhance data collection and analysis to support evidence-based response and programming
- Enhance coordination with development partners to support the Nexus towards sustainable solutions including linking cash for rent assistance to livelihood support
- Capacity building and localization
- Strengthening relationship with authorities
